**Title: “CPL Charles Ellsworth Bowen (U.S.A.) Memorial Bridge”
Commemorative Bridge Naming of State Route 624 Bridge over Cat Point
Creek, Richmond County.**

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2009 the Commonwealth Transportation Board named the bridge on State Route 624 over Cat Point Creek the “PFC Charles Ellsworth Bowen (U.S.A.) Veterans Memorial Bridge” per the request of Richmond County; and

WHEREAS, Richmond County has learned that Mr. Bowen’s rank was a Corporal rather than a Private First Class and has requested that the Commonwealth Transportation Board rescind the previous naming and rename the bridge the “CPL Charles Ellsworth Bowen (U.S.A.) Veterans Memorial Bridge;” and

WHEREAS, in accordance with §33.1-12(4) the Board of Supervisors of Richmond County in its resolution agreed to reimburse the Department for the costs associated with providing and erecting appropriate signs for this designation, as part of its resolution requesting this bridge naming; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Commonwealth Transportation rescinds its resolution of February 19, 2009 naming the bridge carrying State Route 624 over Cat Point Creek in Richmond County; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, pursuant to § 33.1-21(4), Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby names the bridge carrying State Route 624 over Cat Point Creek in Richmond County the “CPL Charles Ellsworth Bowen (U.S.A.) Memorial Bridge;” and directs the Department to erect appropriate signs to that effect and to invoice Richmond County for the related costs.

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
