### **RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD**

### **Title: Addition of the Hot Lanes Parking Study to the Revised Six-Year Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2009-2014**

**WHEREAS**, Section 33.1-12 (9)(b) of the *Code of Virginia*, requires the Commonwealth Transportation Board (Board) to adopt by July 1 of each year a Six-Year Improvement Program of anticipated projects and programs and that the Program shall be based on the most recent official revenue forecasts and a debt management policy; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board is required by *Code of Virginia* Section 33.1-12 (9) and (11) to administer and allocate funds in the Transportation Trust Fund; and,

**WHEREAS**, Section 33.1-23.1 of the *Code of Virginia* requires the Board to allocate funds for the construction and improvements on the Interstate, Primary, Urban and Secondary Highway Systems, which was accomplished at the February 13, 2009 meeting; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Fredericksburg Metropolitan Planning Organization, at its meeting held on December 15, 2008, approved the use of \$100,000 in CMAQ funds for the Hot Lanes Parking Study; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hot Lanes Parking Study project was not included in the FY2009-2014 Revised Six-Year Improvement Program adopted by the Board on February 13, 2009;

**WHEREAS**, the Board recognizes that the project is appropriate for the efficient movement of people and freight and, therefore, for the common good of the Commonwealth.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Commonwealth Transportation Board that the Hot Lanes Parking Study project is added to the Revised Six-Year Improvement Program of projects and programs for Fiscal Years 2009 through 2014 and is approved.
