### **RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD**

**Title: Through Truck Restriction for Trucks in Excess of Forty (40) Feet –  
Route 620 and Route 97 (Lambsburg Road)  
Carroll County**

**WHEREAS**, in response to a formal request by the Carroll County Board of Supervisors that Route 620 (Lambsburg Road) and Route 97 (Lambsburg Road) in Carroll County between Route I-77 Exit #1 and Route 775 (Chance Creek Road) be considered for restriction of through traffic by trucks in excess of forty (40) feet pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the Code of Virginia, this matter has been carefully reviewed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Carroll County Board of Supervisors has conducted a public hearing on this requested restriction; and

**WHEREAS**, the routes in question traverse a non-commercial area; and

**WHEREAS**, a restriction on the proposed routes would not present any undue hardship; and

**WHEREAS**, proper notice was given by posting signs and publishing notices advising the public of the proposed restriction and requesting written comments; and

**WHEREAS**, careful consideration has been given to the recommendations received, the available alternate routes and the past practices of the Commonwealth Transportation Board,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, pursuant to the provisions of Section 46.2-809 of the Code of Virginia, that Route 620 (Lambsburg Road) and Route 97 (Lambsburg Road) in Carroll County between Route I-77 Exit #1 and Route 775 (Chance Creek Road) be prohibited to through traffic of trucks in excess of forty (40) feet.
