## Background

- **50/50 matching program**
- **FY11 allocations stand at \$15 million state matching funds compared to past 3 previous years of up to \$50 million**
- **Open to Counties and Cities and Towns (Urban)**
  - **Application Deadline: June 18, 2010**
- **Max allocation of \$1 Million per locality**
- **Allocations provided via tiered approach**
  - **Revised tier-level approved in 2009 took effect with this program:**
    - Tier 1 – Project is Locally Administered
    - Tier 2 – Locality provides funding greater than required match
    - Tier 3 – Acceleration of existing project
    - Tier 4 – All other eligible requests
