Richmond District

This is a Regional Traffic Signal Contract to have traffic signals and any related equipment installed within each region's area quickly; with minimal or no plans. The expedited signal work can include new installations, partial modifications, complete reconstruction or vehicle accident hit concerns on all types of roadway systems. The Central Region contract will also include the installation of TOC Close Circuit Video (CCTV) cameras. These cameras are used to remotely monitor traffic progression through signalized corridors or to monitor traffic and incidents on freeways. The boundary for the Central Regional includes the following counties; Amelia, Brunswick, Charles City, Chesterfield, Dinwiddie, Essex, Gloucester, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, King George, King & Queen, King William, Lancaster, Lunenburg, Matthews, Mecklenburg, Middlesex, New Kent, Northumberland, Nottoway, Powhatan, Prince George, Richmond and Westmoreland.

Southampton County

This project repairs the existing CRCP pavement on Route 58 eastbound (Southampton Parkway) in both Greenville and Southampton County from 0.15 mi. west of ECL Emporia route 704 in Southampton County. The project will consist of patching the existing concrete pavement in the eastbound lanes, trench widening 1 additional foot on the left shoulder and then overlaying both lanes and both shoulders with 5 inches of asphalt pavement. The project will also include the installation of pavement markings, upgrading the existing guardrail to meet current standards and raising the existing unpaved shoulders to tie-in with the new pavement. This section of Route 58 is a rural primary roadway with many private and commercial entrances throughout the 8.5 mile length of the project and has a traffic count of 17,000 VPD. The existing roadway is made up of 2-12 foot wide lanes, a 3 foot wide inside shoulder and a 9 foot wide outside shoulder. Impacts to traffic and residents will be minor as 1 lane of traffic and all entrances will be maintained during construction.

Prince George County

This project will plane, cold in place recycle, shoulder widen, & overlay the existing pavement/concrete in order to maintain & improve the pavement conditions for ride quality & safety. The interchange with I-95 is within the project limits, but the ramps will not be closed or paved as part of this project, & the bridge over the Interstate be not be overlaid or affected by construction. There will be minor impacts to the motoring public due to lane closures. Single lane closures shall have no time restrictions. There is no significant affect expected on schools, businesses, or dwellings.

This project is to improve Route 460 to four lanes from Deel to Harmon Junction. Route 460 is being designed with four lanes, curb and gutter and sidewalk. Proposed Route 460 is being designed as a single project for right-of-way acquisition but will be divided into three sections for construction. The project adds two additional 1.8 KM long lanes through the Town with turn lanes. This section includes a new intersection with existing Route 460 and a raised median to accommodate turn lanes for this intersection. Also a new 6.3 meter long bridge will be built over Watkins Branch. There is considerable utility construction and signs, signals and street lighting. There will be 48 residences displaced, 60 businesses displaced and 7 non-profit organizations displaced.

City of Petersburg

This project consists of the reconstruction of the intersection at Route 109 and Route 460. On Route 460 the project will construct approximately 1500 feet of single lane for east bound traffic and convert an existing through lane into a dedicated left turn lane. This will provide two left turn lane from east bound Route 460 to north bound Route 109. The existing traffic signal will be relocated and updated to align with the new intersection location and configuration. To accommodate the second left turn lane the project will construct approximately 1700 feet of receiving lane on Route 109 that will end with a taper back to the original roadway approximately 800 feet north of the intersection of Jamestown Road. The entire portion of Route 460 will be milled, overlaid and will re-stripe the intersection for the new configuration and lane widths. The project is to include approximately 1500 of sidewalk for pedestrian accommodation. Impacts to traffic during construction are expected to be minimal. The construction along Route 109 will not extend beyond the existing 110 feet of right of way. There will be no impacts to the Petersburg's National Battlefield or the other property owners within this corridor.

This project will rehabilitate approximately 1.70 miles on I-195 of existing concrete pavement and all ramps within the project limits to improve ride quality & safety. The scope of work includes under drain installation, concrete patching, overlay with thin hot-mix asphalt, pavement marking, and guardrail upgrades both northbound and southbound lanes. This project includes the mainline pavement and 12 ramps.

Chesterfield County

This project consists of reconstructing 1.68 kilometers (1.01 miles) of Route 654 (Bailey Bridge Road), a two-lane undivided rural collector, from SR 9975 (entrance to Manchester High School) to Route 651 (Claypoint Road) for the purpose of improving vertical and horizontal sight distances. The project design consists of constructing two lanes of variable 5.2 meter (16 feet) width, which includes an unmarked bike path for each lane. Some portions of the existing roadway will be built-up. Some portions of the roadway will be newly constructed with a base of eight (8) inches of 21B stone and four (4) inches of BM2, overlaid with two (2) inches of intermediate asphalt 1M-1A and surface-coated with SM-2D. The project will include constructing a new 53.228 meter bridge across Swift Creek utilizing existing piers and constructing two new piers adjacent to the existing piers in the creek bed. The existing 53.2 meter bridge will remain open for traffic, while new piers and bridge deck are built. After traffic is moved to the new bridge, the existing bridge deck will be demolished and a new bridge built on existing piers. The southbound lane of the new bridge will have a cast-in-place concrete parapet (Jersey barrier), while the northbound lane of the new bridge will have sidewalk with aluminum piling guardrail. The project will include curb and gutter for the entire northbound lane with varying amounts of curb and gutter on the southbound lane. Sidewalk will be constructed on the northbound lane to include the bridge. Fronting on the project portion of Bailey bridge are several existing subdivisions, a high school, middle school, and an elementary school as well as a newly constructed church and one large subdivision.

This project upgrades the guardrail along the Interstates and Primary Roads throughout the Staunton District. Disruption to traffic will be minimal as a significant portion of the work will be done using shoulder closures. Lane closures will only be necessary during guardrail work done on the left hand lane of a multi-lane facility. All lane closures will be done in accordance to the Staunton District Allowable work hours. All work is to be performed within existing right-of-way.

The interstate will be patched & overlaid in the Ashland Residency (Henrico County) from SB MM 30.22 to MM 28.19. The interchanges with I-64 & Route 60 are within the project limits & will remain open to traffic during construction. Several bridges are within the project limits but will not be overlaid, patch, or otherwise affected by the construction. The pavement under overhead bridges will be replaced but not overlaid so as not to reduce the overhead clearance. This project also employed quantity based bidding.

The existing continually reinforced concrete pavement is 2-12' lanes in each direction, with adjacent shoulders of variable widths. This project also employed quantity based bidding.

This project will patch 9.545 miles of the existing continually reinforced concrete pavement on N&SB Rte 76 in Chesterfield County to improve the ride quality & safety within the existing right of way. There will be minor impacts to the motoring public due to lane closures. One lane at a time, including turn lanes, loops, ramps, and shoulders will be closed by maintenance work. Quantity based bidding was used. This is where the contractors bid on how many square yards of repair they can install for a fixed amount of money. Since the need for repairs is much greater than money available to make repairs, this method assures that all fund appropriated to this project get spent making repairs.
