RESOLUTION OF THE COMMONWEALTH TRANSPORTATION BOARD

Title: Discontinuance of Maintenance of the Segment of Route 636 from 0.98 miles West of Route 285 to 1.29 miles West of Route 285 in Augusta County

WHEREAS, pursuant to §33.1-150, *Code of Virginia*, 1950, as amended, the Board may discontinue Department services and jurisdiction over roadways, public landings, or crossings comprising the secondary system of state highways that no longer provide sufficient public convenience to warrant maintenance at public expense; and

WHEREAS, discontinuance of any such element of the secondary system of state highways causes jurisdiction over that portion, which remains a public road, to be returned to the local government of the county within which the facility is located; and

WHEREAS, due to a developer project for the Murphy Deming College of Health Sciences occurring on Route 636, there is a portion of the road that no longer warrants maintenance at the public expense; and

WHEREAS, the Augusta County Board of Supervisors has passed a resolution requesting discontinuance of a portion of this route based on the project changes; and,

WHEREAS, on behalf of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, the Virginia Department of Transportation held a public hearing on June 27, 2012, to discuss and receive the public's comments regarding the proposed discontinuance Route 636, also known as Goose Creek Road, from 0.98 miles west of Route 285 to 1.29 miles west of Route 285, a distance of 0.31 miles, and no objections were received at the public hearing; and,

WHEREAS, after considering all information available, this Board is satisfied that the Department has properly concluded that because of project changes, continued maintenance of the referenced segment of Route 636 is no longer warranted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to § 33.1-150, Code of Virginia, this Board hereby discontinues as part of the state system of secondary highways the segment of Route 636, also known as Goose Creek Road, from 0.98 miles west of Route 285 to 1.29 miles west of Route 285, a distance of 0.31 miles.
