RESOLUTION; AUTHORIZATION TO SUBMIT TO VDOT A REQUEST TO NAME A BRIDGE FOR DECEASED VIRGINIA STATE TROOPER LEO WHITT

WHEREAS, Trooper Whitt was a resident of Prince George County; and

WHEREAS, Trooper Whitt was hired by the Virginia Department of State Police on July 1, 1964 and served the citizens of the Commonwealth for 21 years and gave his life in defense of others; and


WHEREAS this Board wishes to memorialize the life and sacrifice of Prince George County resident State Trooper Leo Whitt; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Prince George County Board of Supervisors does hereby request the Commonwealth Transportation Board to name the Johns Road Bridge over Interstate 95 in Prince George County in memorial of Virginia State Trooper Leo Whitt; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the County of Prince George will assume the costs for the fabrication and installation of signs for this naming; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to place the signs on the bridge visible to both north and southbound lanes.
