## Title: Location Approval of the Pacific Boulevard Extension Project, Loudoun County

WHEREAS, in accordance with §33.1-18 of the *Code of Virginia* (1950), as amended, and policies of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, a combined Location and Design Public Hearing was held on April 1, 2014 at the Steuart W. Weller Elementary School, in Loudoun County, Virginia for the purpose of considering a project to extend Pacific Boulevard, the details of which consist of the design and construction of Pacific Boulevard from 1.1 miles north of Nokes Blvd to 0.1 mile west of Richfield Way as a four lane median divided roadway with curb and gutter, appropriate turn lanes, and a shared use path, including a bridge over Broad Run (Project 1036-053-074, P101, R201, C501); and

**WHEREAS,** proper notice was given in advance, and all those present were given a full opportunity to express their opinions and recommendations for or against the proposed project as presented, and their statements being duly recorded; and

**WHEREAS**, the Loudoun County Board of Supervisors endorsed project details as presented at the combined Location and Design Public Hearing on June 18, 2014; and
