On January 15th the Commission, consisting of Mr. H. G. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, I. Walke Traxton, H. B. Sproul and R. K. Sanders, met at Portsmouth, Virginia, and held a public hearing in the Court House, to determine the location of State Highway No. 27, from Morfolk to the Borth Carolina Line.

On Jarmary 16th the Commission hald a public rehearing at Goodhand C.H., those present being Mr. H. G. Shirley, Chairman, I. Walke Truxton and R. K. Sanders, to review the location of Route 19 from Goodhland to Mixie.

On Jamery 17th, the Consideron held a business meeting at their office, 10th and Marshall Streets, those present present being Mr. H. G. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, R. K. Sanders, H. B. Sproul and I. Walke Truxton.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman and the minutes of the last meeting read and approved.

Mr. Brownlow, City Manager of Petersburg, appeared before the Commission and discussed the building of the Bridge over the Appointton River, stating just what the City would agree to do in this matter end cutlining the position of the Hailroad Commission advised Mr. Brownlow that they would participate in gair Mari Ro. 66.7 agu Tháing Co. this bridge to the extent of \$75,000.00 and the northwest approach fill, if the City would agree to advance this amount under the Robertson Act. The Commission having no fundational immediately available for this purpose.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that
the bid of Auttershill and Goods, Virgilina, Virginia, be scoopted on Project 78-4, Route 15, St. Pauls Church towards Mangain,
at their bid of \$19,885.70 and that an additional 10% be set
seide for contingencies and engineering, making a total of
\$20,888.67, chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Senders, that the bid of Battershill end Goode, Virgiline, Virginia, on Project 171, Route 18, St. Paula Church to Braye Fork, be soccepted at their bid of \$26,285.05 and that an additional 105 be not saide for contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$88,911.55, chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproal, that the Gommission accept the bid of Allport Construction Company, Richmond, Virginia, of \$10,601.16 on Project 171, Boute 15, Bridge over Piscataway Creek, and that an additional 10% be set aside for contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$11,851.86 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Senders, seconded by Mr. Massie, that bid of C. L. Hottel and Company, St. Paul, Virginia, be ascepted on Project F-197, Route 10, Buff to Old Slade, the amount of the bid being \$82,641.04, and that an additional 10% be set saids for

Josh Floot No. 18-7 rate Whiteley Co. contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$58,906.15. chargeable to this Project. Equino carried. Mr. Hottel to be furnished with a convict camp.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the bid of F. L. Grant & Company, Clarksburg, West Va., be secepted on Project 205, Route 1, Bridges over My River and Massaponer Greek, between Spotsylvenia C. H. and Prederiskeburg, at their bid of \$10,455.40 and that an additional 10% be set saids for contingencies and sogimeering, making a total of \$11,500.94 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Franton, seconded by Mr. Sanders, that hid of Allport Construction Company, Richmond, Va., on Project 186, Route 12, Sandy River to 6.28 miles west, be accepted, the assumt of the hid being \$180,880.27, and that an additional 10% be set saids for contingencies and engineering, making a total chargeable to this Project of \$198,988.89. Notice carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Senders, that the bid of Parace-Gillespie Company, Pairfax, Virginia, be accepted on Project SS, Route 6, 0.84 miles between Fairfax C. H. and Chentilly, at their bid of \$14,659.40 and that an additional 10% be added for contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$16,185.54 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sunders, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that bid of C. L. Hottel and Company, St. Penl, Virginia, be secepted on Project 208, Route 11, Grooketts Store to Claypool Hill, at their bid of \$276,220.25 and that an additional 10% be set saids hole Mark Ro. 18-2 all Robby Co. for contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$508,748.56 chargeable to this Project and that a special allocation of \$127.742.56 be unde to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that bid of Q. M. Wangh, Records Ford, Virginia, he accepted on Project 185, Routes, Wildersess Tavern-Lignum, 8.44 miles gravel read, at his bid of \$49,517.77 and that an additional 105 be set acide for contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$56,469.54 chargeable to this Project. Notice corried.

Moved by Mr. Sproal, accorded by Mr. Sendere, that bid of the Rosnoke Iron and Bridge Works, Rosnoke, Virginia, on Project 298, Rosto 7, repairs to bridges over Merth Fork of the Shenandock River and the South Fork of the Shenandock River, at their bid of \$85,605.00 be accepted, and that an additional 10% be added for contingencies and engineering, unking a total charge-able to this Project of \$85,956.50. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the following rehearings be set:

Mr. R. Gray Williams appeared before the Countseion and requested that the Northern Virginia Power Company be granted a permit to place poles and string wires on the right of way of the Velley Pike between Stephens City and Straeburg in Frederick and Shenandonh Counties, Virginia.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that permit be granted the Northern Virginia Power Company to erect poles and lack Mout He 447 els Traffer Co. string wires for a transmission line along the Valley Pike, known as State Highway No. 5, between Stephens City and Stranburg in Producial and Shemendoch Counties, under the usual rules and regulations of the State Highway Commission. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the date for the rehearing on the location of the road between Glade Springs and Saltville be changed from February 6th to March 28th at 10:00 o'clock at the Court House at Abingdon, Virginia. Motion earned.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that an appropriation of \$400.00 be made for the detour on Project 192-A, Route S, Greenville-Pairfield, as per recommendation of Commissioner Coleman. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. franton, seconded by Mr. Sanders, that an appropriation of \$8560.00 be made for the maintenance of the detox on Project SSB. Route 9, Haydensville-Sion, as recommended by Commissioner Colemn. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Senders, seconded by Mr. Massie, that an sadditional appropriation of \$4,000,00 be made to Project 75, Route 10. Parchase to the Lee Sounty Line, on account of alides and unforseen conditions in neveral sate, so recommended by Gaussianianer Coleman. Motion exprise.

Mr. J. G. Smith, Gommonwealth's Attorney of Dickenson Gownty appeared before the Commission and requested that the Gommission make an allocation to a section of Boate 11, near Glintwood, this section of road being in most of attention. Dark Mark No. 16-2 min Welkly Co. The Commission advised Mr. Smith that there were no funds available at the present time but that when the allocation of the funds for 1925 was made, this would be given consideration.

A delegation from Hangamond County headed by Hon. H. L. Brewer and Mr. Birdsong, appeared before the Counts sion and requested that Boute 18-W from Suffolk to the North Carolina Line he located by the western route which is the longest but which will best acree the local needs.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Truston, that the road from Suffelk to the North Carolina Line be immediately savertised as located by the western route as requested by the delegation from Names and County. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Senders, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the road from Dixie to Goodhland C. H. be as formerly located, namely to run from Secondend C. H. to Seorge's Tavern and from George's Tavern over the new location to Columbia and from Columbia to Dixie. Motion sarried.

Mr. James R. Caskie, appeared before the Commission and presented a number of petitions from the Citisens of Bedford County requesting them to build the road from Heald's Cate near Perest Depot via Perrosville, Cifax, Bernatt's Farm to Bedford.City this being a section of State Route No.10. The Commission pointed out to Mr. Caskie that at the present time there were no funda available but when the allocations for 1925 were unde, this important project would be given consideration.

tock Klass (Sp. 96-7) pp Wedday Co. A committe from Arlington County appeared before the Commission and requested them to take over for maintenance certain roads in Arlington County after they were constructed by the County due to the heavy tourist traffic which they carry. The Countsion informed them that they would be advised so to what setion was taken.

Mr. O. S. Inch and a delegation from Hamover County
appeared before the Commission and requested that the location of
Boute 9 be from Negro Foot to Askland to connect with Route 1 and
from thence over Route 1 into Richmond. The Commission informed
the delegation that there had been a request for a rehearing on the
location of Route 1 from Solomon's Store to Spotsylvania C. E.,
but they would advertise the proposed connection as requested.

Mr. F. W. Smith, representing Judge Jones and others, of King and Queen County, appeared before the Commission and requested that the read from King and Queen C. H. to common with State Kighmy No. 15 be located by the central route to St. Stephens Church, The Commission adviced Mr. Smith that notice would be given within the next few days as to the location of this route.

Moved by Mr. Tranton, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the resolution passed at the meeting on December 16th swarding contract to the Spotsylvania Construction Company, for the construction of a section of the road between Fredericksburg and Spotsylvania C.K. to the amount of \$285,000.00 be resointed.

Protest beving been under by the General Contractors
Association that it was unfair to let a portion of this read and

Bysk Stine St. 4.5 188 Tolky Oc. not the whole, for the end near Predericksburg could be built much cheaper, due to the short hand, than the far end, and that the contract for the entire distance be let to the Spotsylvania Construction Company at their bid of \$505,570.71, and that an additional 10% be set saide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering. Also that an allocation be made to cover the total cost of this Project. Motion carried.

Mr. D. H. Pitts of J. H. Lame and Company, appeared before the Commission and stated that when the contract for Project No. 115, Route 6, Fairfax-Alexandria, was awarded to his Company, that their original bid was \$2.50 per eq. yd. for operate but that after disconning this matter with Mr. Colema, he agreed to set his price to \$2.40 per eq. yd., it being thought that there was good local gravel, but an execut of not finding any quantity of gracel in a number of places and further due to labor conditions he was losing money on this contract and requested that the Commission restore his original price of \$8.60 per eq. yd. of comorete surface.

A delegation from Page County appeared before the Commission and maked for an additional allocation to construct the State Highway through that County. The Commission advised than that although there was an allocation for that County it only became available on December 1st and that the work would scon be ready to advertise for bids. When the Commission makes the allocation of the 1985 funds this important road will be given consideration, but even though an allocation is made, the funds

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that ingusts County be reinbursed to the amount of \$1,000.00 for money spent on maintaining a detour while the road through West ingusts was be constructed, as per recommendation of Countesioner Colemna. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the agreement with the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County to advance \$50,000.00 under the Robertson Act be causelled so per request of the Board of Supervisors. Notice carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that a permit be granted O. H. Gish, of Rosnoke, Va., to place a spar track across the State Highest No. 10, between Remote and Villamont, under the named rules and regulations of the Commission. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Messie, ecconded by Mr. Skirley, that the present grade crossing of the Seabcard tracks, Moute 1, Project 175, Falling Crock-Dutch Cap Road be maintained until such time as the traffic demands on the Seabcard are sufficiently increased to necessitate changing their grades and climinating curvature, at which time an underpass or overhead could be constructed. Metion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that due to increased width of 4 feet in the road, Project 128-A, Noute 25, Giles County, that the contractor, Marden Construction Company, be granted an increase of 15¢ per square yard for the additional

tick that No. 66-P all Hothy Ob width over 18 feet, the original contract price of \$1.40 to remain as stated in the contract and also that the convict camp be increased to 50 or 55 men, provided the contractor will complete this Project during the year 1925. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission accept the application of the Board of Supervisors of Brunswick County to edvance \$100,000.00 under the Robertson Act for the construction of State Highway No. 1 between the intersection of Routes 1 and 12 near Edgerton and the southern boundary of Laurenceville. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Skirley, that a permit be granted P. H. Unmp to erect and maintain a pole line along the right of way of State Highway No. 18-Y between Franklin and Smith's Perry in Southeapton County, under the usual rules and regulations of the State Highway Commission. Notice service.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that an additional allocation of \$45,407.58 be made to Project 125, Houte 12, Galax-Woodlawn, as per recommendation of Commissioner Colomna. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Sproul, it having some to the attention of the State Highway Commission, that dertain members of firms of contractors doing work for the Department are members of the General Assembly and it is the opinion of the State Highway Commission that such is detrimental to yablic interest and should be discontinued. Motion agried.
