NIMUTES OF THE MERTING OF THE STATE HIGH-WAY CONSCIONION HELD AT RICHMOND, VIRGINIA, JANUARY 8th, 1926.

On the morning of January Sth, 1926, the State Highway Consission, consisting of Mesers. B. G. Shirley, Chairman, Made H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul, and A. J. Huff, met at their office, State Office Ballding, Michaele Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

The minutes of the meeting of the Commission held at Rossobe, Va., on December 9, 1925, and at Richmond, Va. December 17, 1925, were read and it was moved by Mr. Baff, semended by Mr. Shirley, that they be approved. Matter carried.

libred by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Muff, that the contract for the sometruction of 2.64 miles of comprete road, including two bridges, Route 31, Project F-182B, Headage Greek - Demoy's Greek, be awarded to the low bidder P. M. Jones, Roaneke, Virginia, at his bid of \$99,381.25 and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$2,202.47 for detours, making approximately \$112,000.00 chargeable to this project, subject to the approval of the plans by the Bureau of Pablic Roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, escended by Mr. Massie, that the contrast for the construction of 8.04 miles concrete road, including two bridges from 1.52 miles south of Massapones to Cedon, Route 31, Project F-3720, be awarded to the low bidder, Spotsylvania Construction Company, Highland Springs, Va, at their bid of \$291,522.15 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and sugineering and \$3,000.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$324,000.00 obergoable to this Project, subject to the approval of

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the plans by the Bureau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

March Book Meet No. 66-P Évanti Maider Co. Boved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that immunich as the contract for the construction of eight miles of concrete road has been awarded the Spotsylvania Construction Company (low bidder on Houte 31, Project F372C) and it is the Commission's opinion that this is as such work as this Company can complete during the coming working season, that the contract for the commission of 8.68 miles of concrete road from 8.1 miles morth of Dosmell to 6.64 miles north of Ashland, Route 31, Project F-378J, be awarded to the next bidder, C. S. Look & Sons, Richmond, Va. at their bid of \$294,496,15 (this being \$2,747.41 above the low bid) and also that 10% additional be set saide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$4,600.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$329,000.00 chargeable to this Project, subject to the approval of the plane by the Bureau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Hesers. Gresham, Brace and Jenes Hollen appeared before the Commission in regards to an option on the Gresham and West Point Bridges. Mr. Gresham stated be wanted to reach an understanding with the Commission and arrange for an option that will be satisfactory to both. He stated that the bridge cost \$67,700.00 plus \$3,000.00 for fill and \$1400.00 for a 100 foot strip of land one-half mile in length on the east side and two lots on the West Point side, plus interest at 6% during construction. The interest could not be figured on the gross amount as the money was only borrowed as needed, and he thought it would be about right to figure on 6% for one-half the time or one-half the amount of money at 6% for the full time. It required about eight months to construct this bridge. The bridge to be valued at present day prices.

Mr. C. W. Heahler of the Spotsylvania Construction Company, then appeared before the Commission in regards to amerding him the contract for both Project P-372C, near Massapones and Project P-358J North of Ashland. He stated

The Commission, however, advised his they did not went to run any chance of the work not being completed on time and were of the opinion that the eight miles amended to him was all he could complete and thought it advisable to search the contract to the second low hidder so they would have to deal directly with the contractor rather than a sub-contractor, and the next hidder was first entitled to consideration.

Moved by Mr. Buff, seconded by Mr. Massle, that the contrast for the construction of 2.17 miles of nonerate road, including bridge over Account tink Greek, Route 31, Project F71A, .5 miles north of Account to .21 miles north of Pohick Church, be swarded to the low bidder, Jonkins Construction Co. Norton, Va. at their hid of \$61,673.02 and that 10% additional he set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and angineering and \$4,500.00 for detours making a total of approximately \$95,000.00 chargeable to this Project, subject to the approval of the plans by the Bureau of Public Roads. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Ruff, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of 6.47 miles of Riturinous Manadam Road, including bridge over Brake Branch, Route 10, Project F-132D, Road from Elliston-6.298 Miles Rast of Christiansburg, be smarded to the low bidder G. P. Clay, Richmond, Va. at his bid of \$167,949.70 and that 10% additional he set saids to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$3750.00 for detours, making a total charge-able to this Project of approximately \$234,000.00 including the bridge ever Rosnoke River, plus one additional mile, with the understanding that the contractor will take the additional mile and bridge and construct same at his bid prices and also provided that he will associate with himself some person or

Morate Sock Short Mr. (p.) Eventt Weilder Co. firm who will join in the contract and guarantee its completion within the time specified in the specifications, subject to the approval of the plans by the Bureau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, associated by Mr. Huff, that the contract for the construction of 5.3 miles of massdam road, Houte 10, Project F-132E, 6.298 Mi. East of Christiansburg to 1.0 Miles Rawt of Christiansburg, be searched to the low bidder, Mobarta Contracting Co. Fulenti, Va. at their bid of \$146,420.77 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$3750.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$165,000.0 chargeable to this Project, subject to the approval of the plane by the Bureau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Project P-145HJ, Route 35, North of Homevalle to Sussez-Prince George County Line, be swarded to the Roberts faving Co., Clara, MM, at their unit prices bid to the excent of the General Allegation of \$150,000.00, including 10% for contingencies and engineering, overhead and detours. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Route 34, Project F-181, North of New to Sion Church, be awarded to the less bidder, Ford and Hervey, Lynchburg, Virginia, at their unit prices bid to the amount of the General Allocation of \$125,000,00, including 10% for contingencies and engineering, and detours. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Huff, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of A.42 miles graded road, Route 116, Project 354B, Wice-Lee Line Lan-Scott Line, be awarded to the low bidder, Jonkins Construction Company, Morton, Virginia, at their bid of \$42,267.51 and that 10% additional be set

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contrast for the surfacing with 8" Bituminous Massdam, Project F-375, Route 14, Grow Place-West Virginia Line, be awarded to the low bidder, Carpenter-Major Brothers, Clifton Forge, Virginia, at their bid of \$117,742.24, and that 16% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$2,000.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$132,000.00 chargeable to this Project, subject to the approval of the plane by the Bursau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the every of the contrast for the construction of 1.3 miles of graded road, Route 17, Project 391, 7,17 Miles West Gosben to .95 Miles West of Militoro Springs, to held up on account of right of way difficulties. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the following Permits be granted under the Bules and Regulations of the Commission:

- To G. P. Heard, Gulpeper, Tirginia, to erest one electric light pole on State Highest No. 37, Culpeper County,
- To Chesapethe & Potomac Telephone Company, Morfolk, Virginia, to erect four poles along Houte 39 between Hampton and Newport News,
- To M. E. Church, Palls Church, Virginia, to obnotruot a sever line and concrete shoulder for 150° along Moute 21, Fairfax County,
- To Department of Public Works, Bureau of Water, Norfolk, Virginia, to install to lead tup on Route 10 for residence of 0. 0. Fristell,
- To Floyd-Montgomery Matual Telephone Company, Alum Ridge, Va, to erect 100 poles along Soute 23 between William Pughe and the Top of the Mountain,
- To Inter-Mountain Telophone Company, Bristol, Yirginia, to erest 36 poles along Routs 10 between Bristol and Abingdon,

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that Permit #126 is seed the Form of Grange on Movember 30, 1925, be cancelled as the Form has decided not to make the connection covered therein. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Haff, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that if the Alexandria Light and Power Company, Alexandria, Virginia, does not move their poles are sted along Novte 251 at Falls Church under Permit #112, back of the ditch line as directed by the Chatrist Engineer of the Commission, within ten days, that said poles are to be removed from the highway entirely. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, percented by Mr. Buff, that the Commission accept an advancement of \$30,000.00 under the Robertson Act for constructing a section of State Righway No. 14 in the Youn of Altavista. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massic, that the Commission grant Mr. R. W. Curtis \$100.00 in payment of claim for damages sustained on the work in building the bridge at Clifton Forge, Route 14, Project 1894, As per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mulley. Motion carried.

Ministry Bank Blant No. 49-P Respekt Walsky Co. Hoved by Mr. Massie, assended by Mr. Sproul, that the Chairman be instructed to transfer the State Aid and Cas Tax Fund remaining in the Treasurry of approximately \$68,500.00 to the State Engineering Assendt. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the final location of State Highway Ho. 331 from Woodstock to the West Virginia Line, be from Woodstock to a point at or near Columbia Purance and thence running in the direction of Liberty to the West Virginia Line at a point to be determined on by the two Mighway Commissions. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sprowl, sesconded by Mr. Haff, that an extension of time be granted the Pendleton Construction Company, on Project 169, Soute 33, 3.17 miles south of Buckaman to 7.25 miles south of Buckaman, to Outuber 15, 1925, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mallen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Buff, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that an extension of time be granted C. S. Luck and Sons, on Project 126, Route 36, Rappahannock Annaemy - Moss Nock, to September 1, 1925, as per recommendation of Chief Nogineer Mullen. Motion carries.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Haff, that an extension of time be granted the Allport Construction Company, on Project 1180, route 33, 10.13 Miles south of Rouncks to 14.51 Miles gowth of Monnoke, to December 5, 1925, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mallon. Motion corried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that an extension of time be granted the Allport Construction Company, on Project 1188, Route 33, 14.51 Uties South of Roundse to 5.11 Miles Morth of Mocky Houst, to September 3, 1925, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullen. Motion carried. Propin Peris Shore No. 16-2 Propint Whitely Co. There being no further business, the meeting ad-
