MINITES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE RIGHMAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, MESA JAMPIAT 17, 1988, RIGHNORD, VIRGINIA.

On the morning of Jenuary 17th, 1928, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Mesors. H. O. Shirley, Commissioner, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul, J. Walke Truxtum, and H. G. Gilmer, and at their office, State Office Smilding, Richmond, Virginia, The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

The minutes of the meeting held January 5th, 1928, were read and it was moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that they be approved. Motion corried.

Noved by Mr. Trustum, seconded by Mr. Sprond, that the Commission confirm the following milespended to the State Highway System under the Sp Clause, as the following counties have complied with the conditions imposed by law:

Appointter Extension of Houte 104 to a point 8. of Appointter 2.0 Mi.

Les Extension of Houte 1010 to a point South 4.0 M

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Gilmr, that incomes as the District Engineer reports that he confirms his previous statement that the socident on Route 14, in which the car of Mr. Payns was damaged, was no fault of the foreign or the truck driver, the Commission is unable to make any charge in their former decision. Motion carried.

A delegation from Yorktown appeared before the Commission in regard to the survey of Houte 391 and requested that the line be shifted sufficient to miss the old foundation of the Helson house and also fellow the old eighty foot road as nearly as possible before making the tangent.

Mittale Back Short Mr. H.P. Donnik Walder Co. Moved by Mr. Treatum, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that immunich as the Board of Supervicers of Arlington County and their engineer Mr. Ann M. Phillips, have been repeatedly instructed to put the choulders of the State highways in Arlington County in condition where pipe lineshave been laid, and as some was not done in accordance with instructions, that the Commission has no other course to person them to use the \$5000.00 guarantee check for this purpose. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the following paralle be granted under the Rules and Regulations of the Countesions

To Mine Ridge Stone Corp, Romoke, Yirginia, to lay 15" drain cipe along Route 10, making entrunce into new commissary building just I. of Mine Ridge Quirry,

To M. A. Dudley, Charlottesville, Virginia, to grade and pave entrusce into filling station on Boute 39, Albemirle County,

To Distance Restric Company, Abingson, Virginia, to orms over Roste 105 at 3 points and over Roste 10 at 1 point in Washington county with electric line,

To J. T. Fretvell, Paraville, Virginia, to commetrat a commette driveray and guiter into filling station on Route 10, one-half mile from Faraville,

To four of Culax, to make a house sower connection with main sower under Route 19 and Main Street,

To C. O. Gill, Leesburg, Virginia, to make commection to sever in coster of Route 32 in the Town of Leesburg.

To W. E. Graves, Mineral, Tirginia, to grade and concrete entrance into service station and garage on Roste 39.

To W. C. Lewis, Lecaburg, Virginia, to repair connection to water line in center of Route 33 in the Town of Lecaburg,

To B. A. Mordion, Morfelk, Virginia, to lay 150° of pipe is ditch and construct an entrance at S.W. corner of Houte 10 and Court House or Thomas Corner,

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Sprowl, that whereas these were objections filled to the closing of the grade crossings on Route 323 be twose Victoria and Kambridge as follows:

At Mile Post 118.58, Permanently closed, At Mile Post 115.18, Except as private Grossing, At Mile Post 115.68, Except as Farm Grossing,

That the Commission hereby gives notice that they will hold a public hearing at the Court House, Lunesburg, Virginia, on the 18th day of March 1928, to hear all those who wish to present such facts and information pertenent thereto. Notice carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that whereas the Commission having given notice that the grade crossing of the Horfolk & Western Sailrond on Route 10, between Bedford and Thanton pear Villamont, at Mile Peat \$420265.5 would be permanently closed as soon as the underpass has been completed and opened to traffic, unless there were objections filed, in writing on or before Japany 15th, and whereas there were no objections filed, eath greening will be closed as above. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Silmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the State
Eighney Commission having given notice that certain grade crossings of the
Virginian Sailway on Soute 14 north of Altevista, will be personently closed
unless there were objections filed in writing on or before January 18th, and
whereas no objections were filed, the grade crossings at Mile Post 949-40 and
Mile Post 4453-11 will be closed as above. Metion carried.

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Monte Heat Start No. 161.p Proper Publicy Co. Moved by Mr. Trusten, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the statement enginised in the report of the Highway Committee of the Eastern Share of Virginia Chamber of Commerce, copy of which was pent in by Mr. A. A. Rickard, Secretary, Juneary 10, 1928, "that the completion of the main State Highway through the two counties was prevented by the action of the State Highway Commission" is not, to our mind, in keeping with either the facts or records in the case. Notice carried.

Noved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Goundaelan aid to Route 101 to the Gity Limits of Norfolk 5.55 miles under the high Olause of the law. Mytion carried,

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Gilmor, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Wolf Greek, Boute 26, Project 8406, be awarded to the low bidder, Maymon and Lewrence, Salem, Virginia, at their bid of \$20,034.20 and that 10% additional be not uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$22,000,00 chargest able to this Project. Mation carried.

Moved by Mr. Officer, seconded by Mr. Sproal, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Ogla Greek, Boute 14, Project 539184, be exerted to the low bidder, M. B. Rudgins, Scaneke, Virginia, at his bid of \$9,122.25, esting saids 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried,

There being no further business the meeting adjoursed, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
