## Minutes of Meeting of the State Highway Commission

## of Virginia

Richmond, Virginia - January 5, 1961

The State Highway Commission of Virginia met at the Central Highway Office in Richmond, Virginia, at 11:50 A.M., January 5, 1961, with the Chairman, H. H. Harris, presiding. Present: Chairman H. H. Harris, Mesers. R. P. Barrow, G. Wallace Carper, W.M. Chinn, Jr., S. S. Flythe, Burgess E. Welson, S. W. Rawls, W. M. Solater, Jr., and Tucker G. Watkins, Jr.

On motion of Mr. Flyths, seconded by Mr. China, minutes of the senting of December 8, 1960, were approved.

Motion was made by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. Barrow, that paralits issued from December 9 to January 5, inclusive, as shown in records of the Department, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Chinn, seconded by Mr. Carper, that WHERMAS, Route 258 in Southmepton County, has been altered and reconstructed as shown on plans for Project 0258-087-006-007; and WHERMAS, two sections of the old road are no longer necessary as a public road, the new road serving the same citizens as the old; NOW, THEMPORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33-76.5 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, 0.83 mile of the sea road, shown in blue and designated assection 1 and 2 on the plat dated June 15, 1960, Project 0258-087-006-007, be shandoned as a part of the State Highway System. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Chica, seconded by Mr. Carper, that MERICAS, Route 121 in Wythe County, has been altered and reconstructed as shown on plans for Project 0121-098-101,B1, and MERICAS, one section of the old road is no longer necessary as a public road, the new road serving the same citizens as the old; NOW, THERROORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33-76.5 of the Code of Virginia of 1930, as enemded, 0.10 mile of the old road, shown in blue and designated as Section 1 on the plat dated September 19, 1960, Project 0121-098-101,B1, he shandoned as a part of the State Highway System. Motion carried.

Noved by Mr. Sciater, seconded by Senator Helson, that Mikkas, Section 33-26 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as emended, sutherises the State Highway Commission to add such roads, bridges and streets as it shall does proper, and to transfer from the Secondary System to the Primary System such roads, bridges and streets as it shall does proper, not to exceed fifty miles during any one year; and,

WHEREAS, it is requested by the County Board of Supervisors of Smyth Sounty, and recommended by our Highway engineers, to provide a Primary System highway between Chilhowie and Saltville; and, WHEREAS, it is estimated that 1,200 vehicles per day would use the road between Chilhowie and Saltville, if developed to Primary standards; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that under Section 33-26 of the 1930 code of Virginia, as amended, existing Secondary Route 636, beginning at an intersection with Route 11, in Chilhowie and extending northwesterly 5.91 miles to its intersection with Route 610 south of Saltville, be added to the Primery System of highways and designated as new State Route 107 effective the 5th day of January, 1961; and SE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intent of the Commission to extend State Route 107 from its above intersection with Route 610 on into Saltville to intersect with Route 91 over the proposed Industrial Access project when said project has been completed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Sclater, that WHERBAS, under authority of Section 33-113.2 of the Code of Virginia of 1950 as smended, request is made by the City of Williamsburg for payment 4t the base rate of \$300 per mile annually on additional streets meeting the required standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ERSOLVED, that quarterly payments at the base rate of \$300 per mile annually he made to the City of Williamsburg on additional attents totaling 0.65 mile that have been brought up to the standards required by this section of the code, effective Jamery 1, 1961 for the quarterly payment due on March 31, 1961, to a total approved mileage of 14.49 miles. Hotion carried.

MOVED by Nr. Rawle, seconded by Nr. Science, that WHEREAS, under authority of Section 33-113.2 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, request is made by the Town of Mytheville for payment at the base rate of \$300 per mile annually on additional streets meeting the required standards; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that quarterly payments at the base rate of \$300 per mile annually be made to the Town of Mytheville on additional streets totaling 0.51 mile that have been brought up to the standards required by this section of the code, effective January 1, 1961 for the quarterly payment due on Merch 31, 1961. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, accorded by Senator Melson, that WHEREAS, in accordance with provisions of Section 116 (c) of the Federal-Aid Highway Act of 1936, a public hearing was held in the Cave Spring High School in Rosneke County on December 12, 1960, at 10:00 A.M., concerning the construction of Projects 0119-129-101 and 0119-060-102 on Boute 119 from the intersection of Route 11 in Salam to the intersection of Route 221 near Cave Spring in Rosneke County, and Boute 221 from 0.6 mile S. intersection of proposed Route 119 to 0.2 mile M. intersection proposed Route 119, Project 0221-080-102, and

WHEREAS, the economic effects of the location and proposed improvements have been examined and given proper consideration and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed; now therefore,

HE IT RESOLVED, that the construction of the roadway along the location shown as Projects Oll9-129-101 and Oll9-080-102 from the intersection of Route 11 in Salem to the intersection of Route 221 near Cave Spring in Rosnoke County, along Line A, and proposed relocation of Route 221, as presented and shown on layout map, be approved. Motion carried.

Notion was made by Mr. Sclator, seconded by Mr. Flythe, that the Commission choose a Thursday in each month and have a regular meeting each month during 1961, the date to be set by the Chairman. Motion carried.
