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Meeting of State Highway Commission of Virginia Richmond, Virginia January 12, 1962

The State Highway Commission of Virginia met at the Central Highway Office, Richmond, Virginia, at 9:00 A.M., on January 12, 1962. The Chairman, H. H. Harris, presided.
