Richmond, Virginia January 16, 1992 10:00 a.m.

The monthly meeting of the Commonwealth Transportation Board was held in the Board Room of the Virginia Department of Transportation, Richmond, Virginia, on January 15, 1992 at 10:00 a.m. The Chairman, Mr. John G. Milliken, presided.

Present: Massrs. Pethtel, Bacon, Candler, Davies, Hoffler, Howlette, Malbon, Musselwhite, Smalley, Waldman, Warner, Wells and Mrs. Kincheloe and Dr. Thomas.

Absent: Mr. Mastracco

On motion of Mr. Warner, seconded by Mr. Wells, the minutes of the meeting of December 19, 1991, were approved.

Moved by Mr. Warner, seconded by Mr. Wells that the Soard approve permits issued and canceled from December 1, 1991 through December 31, 1991, inclusive, as shown by the records of the Department.

Motion carried.

On Motion of Mr. Warner, seconded by Mr. Wells, the Board approved action on Additions, Abandonments or Other Changes in the Secondary System from November 18, 1991 to December 16, 1991, inclusive as shown by the records of the Department.

Moved by Mr. Warner, seconded by Mr. Wells, that

WHEREAS, by proper resolution, the Board of Supervisors of Stafford County has requested that a certain road which no longer serves as public necessity be discontinued as part of the Secondary System of Highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33.1-150 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, the Commonwealth Transportation Board finds the following section of road is not required for public convenience and is hereby discontinued as part of the Secondary System of Highways, effective this date.

Stafford County - Route 1160 - Section 1 of old location 0.06 Mi

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Warner, seconded by Mr. Wells, that

WHEREAS, Route 100 in Giles County has been altered and reconstructed as shown on plans for Project: 0100-035-105, C-503; and

WHEREAS, two sections of the old road are no longer necessary as a public road, the new road serving the same citizens as the old; and four sections of the old road are to be transferred from the Primary System to the Secondary System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33.1-144 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, 0.87 mile of old Route 100, designated as Sections 1 and 6 on the plat dated January 31, 1991, Project: 0100-035-105, C-503, be discontinued as a part of the State Highway System; and

BE IT FURTHER RESCLVED, that pursuant to Section 33.1-35 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, 1.00 mile of old Route 100, designated as Sections 2, 3, 4 and 5 on the plat dated January 31, 1991, Project: 0100-035-105, C-503, be transferred from the Primary System to the Secondary System of Highways.

Moved by Mr. Musselwhite, seconded by Mrs. Kincheloe, that

WHEREAS, the Henry County Board of Supervisors requested that old State Route 57 be retained in the Primary System and be renumbered; and

WHEREAS, the City of Martinsville's officials concurred in the renumbering of this section of old State Route 57; and

WHEREAS, the renumbering of said Route has been recommended by the Department's Engineers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that one section of old State Route 57 in Henry County and the City of Martinsville, between its intersection with existing State Route 57 east of Martinsville and existing State Route 57/U. S. Route 220 Business in Martinsville, shall be renumbered State Route 457.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Stafford County, Virginia did adopt a resolution requesting the Commonwealth Transportation Board to transfer a section of Frontage Road P-169 (0.42 mile), from Secondary Route 1445 to 0.45 mile south of Secondary Route 1445 in Stafford County, from the Interstate System to the Secondary System of Highways; and

WHEREAS, based on evaluation of this request the Department's staff has determined that this section of road could best be administered as a part of the Secondary System of Highways;

NOW, THERBFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commonwealth Transportation Board, in accordance with the authority entrusted under Section 33.1-53 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, does hereby declare that a section of Frontage Road F-169, as herein described, be transferred from the Interstate system to the Secondary System of Highways.

At this point, Mr. Jack Hodge, Chief Engineer, VDOT, gave a summary of actions taken to ensure, to the extent possible, that Virginians would be employed for transportation projects.

Mr. Richard Daugherity, Executive Vice-President, Virginia Road and Transportation Builders Association, was recognized and made comments assuring the Board that his industry fully supports hiring locally whenever possible.

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Department of Highways (KDOH) has proposed the multi-lane construction of Route 23 in the State of Kentucky from Jenkins to the Virginia State Line; and

WHEREAS, KDOH has recommended the completion of four lanes of Route 23 three tenths of a mile in Wise County, Virginia, with Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) engineers concurring; and

WHEREAS, the KDOH and VDOT have mutually agreed to include Virginia's roadwork which has an estimated total cost of \$2,558,000 in the Kentucky contract. The estimated total cost includes preliminary engineering, right of way and construction at Virginia's cost with VDOT acquiring the required right of way and adjusting and/or relocating utilities within the boundaries of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board has approved this project for inclusion in the Department's Six-Year Improvement Program for funding; and

WHEREAS, this Board reaffirms its commitment to fund Virginia's share of this improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-12(10), Code of Virginia, the Commissioner is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with KDOH to allow them to complete the four-lane construction on Route 23 in wise County, Virginia at: the Commonwealth's expense with the understanding that this Board will be notified of Virginia's cost of construction based on contract bid prices and permit it to concur in the cost prior to the award of the contract.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Musselwhite, seconded by Dr. Thomas, that

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) has proposed the multi-lane construction of Route 220 in the State of North Carolina from 1.0 mile south of the state line to the state line; and

WHEREAS, NCDOT has recommended the completion of four lanes of 0.5 mile of Route 220 in Henry County, Virginia, with Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) engineers concurring; and

WHEREAS, the NCDOT desires to execute an agreement to include Virginia's roadwork in their contract at an estimated total cost of \$750,000, including preliminary engineering, right of way and construction at Virginia's cost, with VDOT acquiring

the required right of way and adjusting and/or relocating utilities within the boundaries of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board has approved this project for inclusion in the Department's Six-Year Improvement Program for funding; and

WHEREAS, this Board reaffirms its commitment to fund Virginia's share of this improvement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-12(10), Code of Virginia, the Commissioner is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation to allow them to complete the four-lane construction on Route 220 in Henry County, Virginia at the Commonwealth's expense with the understanding that this Board will be notified of Virginia's cost of construction based on contract prices and permit it to concur in the cost prior to the award of the contract.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Smalley, seconded by Mr. Musselwhite, that

WHERRAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "...be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to publicly owned airports"; and

WHEREAS, the Alleghany County Board of Supervisors has, by resolution, requested Industrial Access Funds to serve the Alleghany County Industrial Park located off Route 1101 in Alleghany County, and said access is estimated to cost \$45,000; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1-221 and complies with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on the use of Industrial Access Funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$45,000 of the 1991-92 Fiscal Year Industrial Access Fund be allocated to provide adequate access to the proposed Alleghany County Industrial Park located off Route 1101 in Alleghany County, Project 1101-003-157, M502, contingent upon:

- All necessary right of way and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth; and
- The execution of an appropriate contractual agreement, with bond, between the Alleghany County Board of Supervisors (County) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), to provide for
 - The design, administration, and construction of this project;
 - The County bearing any ineligible project costs and all eligible project costs in excess of \$45,000;
 - c. The County bearing any portion of the project's cost to the Industrial Access Fund not justified by appropriate capital expenditures under the policy of the Commonwealth Transportation Board. If, by January 16, 1995, qualified industry has not expended or entered into a firm contract to expend at least \$450,000 for eligible capital outlay on eligible site(s) whose sole access to a road in the system of state highways is by virtue of this project, then an amount equal to 10% of eligible capital outlay and/or the eligible capital outlay under firm contract will be credited toward the project's allocation and the balance of any project costs over the amount so credited will be borne by the County; and
 - d. VDOT determining eligible capital outlay and eligible project costs in accordance with current policy and procedures.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Bacon, seconded by Dr. Howlette, that

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Article 3, Chapter 1, Title 33 of the 1950 Code of Virginia as amended, the State Highway Commission on August 28, 1958, did declare that section of State Route 73, State Highway Project 0073-043-101, C-1 between its intersection with the east right of way line of Route 1 in Henrico County north of Richmond and running thence eastwardly to its intersection with Interstate Route 95 be a Limited Access Highway; and

WHEREAS, on October 28, 1965, the State Highway Commission recommended that access be permitted to State Route 73 along its north Limited Access right of way line from a point opposite approximate Station 16+40 to a point opposite approximate survey Station 16+90, and authorized the construction of a connection between said Route 73 and Aberdeen Street as extended southwardly between the aforesaid survey stations with the conditions that it be made without cost to the Commonwealth of Virginia and provided that the County of Henrico acquire title to the lands lying between the present north right of way and Limited Access line of Route 73 and the present southwardly boundary of Aberdeen Street, and

WHEREAS, it has now been requested that the cost participation noted in the Commission approval on October 28, 1965 be revised to read that cost participation be mutually agreed upon between the Department and Henrico County subject to the Public Hearing process and Henrico County Board approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the October 28, 1965, State Highway Commission resolution be modified as noted.

Motion carried.
