MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGH-  
WAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD IN  
WYTHEVILLE, FEBRUARY 5, 1929.

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On the morning of February 5th, 1929, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul, and H. G. Gilmer, met in the Court House at Wytheville, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

The Commission gave a public hearing on the tentative allocation of funds for the Salem and Bristol Districts for the fiscal year 1929-30.

After all those who wished to be heard had spoken, the following business was transacted.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the following additions be made to the Federal Highway System:

Route 106, Big Stone Gap south to near Natural Tunnel to intersection of Route 10 near Clinchport;

Route 407, From Route 31 between Dutch Gap and Petersburg about 12 miles south of Richmond, southeast through Hopewell to a point on Route 10 near Garysville;

Route 13, Richmond, Powhatan Courthouse, Cumberland Courthouse, Buckingham Courthouse, Amherst to the intersection of Route 14 near Buena Vista;

Route 28, Lynchburg, Charlottesville to Calpeper.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission approve and recommend to the Governor that the salary of its Chief Engineer be increased \$500.00 per year, the salary of its Assistant Secretary be increased \$10.00 per month and the various other increases shown on list submitted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the allocations for the Bristol and Salem Districts be confirmed as follows and also the Million Dollar Gap Fund be confirmed:

To Ancarrow and Noble, Richmond, Virginia, to construct an entrance to filling station on Route 31 in the Town of Colonial Heights,

To Appalachian Electric & Power Company, Bluefield, West Virginia, to cross Route 126 with a power line about 600' S. of the N&W RR near Cedar Bluff,

To J. F. Burgess, Martinsville, Virginia, to grade an entrance into filling station on Route 33 south of Martinsville, Henry county,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company, Clarendon, Virginia, to erect one pole on Route 31 near the Fort Hunt Road,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company, Fredericksburg, Virginia, to construct a telephone cable line on Route 37 between Fredericksburg and Orange,

To Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company, Norfolk, Virginia, to place four poles on Route 34 north of Massawadox Station,

To S. L. Collins, Elk Creek, Virginia, to construct an entrance into filling station, store and mill on Route 26 one mile north of Elk Creek,

To Consumers' Utilities Company, Staunton, Virginia, to make a 1½" connection with existing 3" gas main on Route 39, 500' West of Staunton Corporate Limits,

To H. L. Cornwell, Remington, Virginia, to construct an entrance into filling station on Route 32 about two miles north of Remington,

To John T. Crowder, Fincastle, Virginia, to construct a driveway into filling station on Route 17 between Fincastle and Eagle Rock,

To Mrs. Florence A. Ellis, Hot Springs, Virginia, to cross Route 800 with 2" water main near Station 158/59, at property of M. E. Dunn,

To W. G. Ellison, Waynesboro, Virginia, and Princeton Development Co. Princeton W. Va. to place a 6" and an 8" water main on Route 39 for about 1 mile,

To G. W. Evans, Richmond, Virginia, to grade an entrance to store on Route 13, one-quarter mile from Richmond,

To Virginia East Coast Utilities Company, Irvington, Virginia, to erect an electric light and power line along Route 607 between Heathsville and Callao,

To Virginia Electric & Power Company, Suffolk, Virginia, to construct a pole line along Route 12 making 14 service crossings and 2 guys,

To Virginia Public Service Company, Charlotte C.H., Virginia, to cross Route 304 one mile northwest of Drakes Branch with 3 wires,

To Virginia Public Service Company, Alexandria, Virginia, to erect one guy pole and cross Route 31 with guy wire,

To Virginia Public Service Company, Culpeper, Virginia, to extend present power line from Culpeper west approximately 1200 feet,

To Virginia Public Service Company, Alexandria, Virginia, to erect one 30' stub and anchor guy and guy wire across Route 54,

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To Virginia Public Service Company, Alexandria, Virginia, to install 3 span lamps at intersection of Telegraph Road, Roth Street, Quaker Lane and Little River Turnpike,

To Virginia Public Service Company, Clifton Forge, Virginia, to erect one pole on Route 33 and make one primary crossing 200' south of Looney Mill Creek Br.

To Western Union Telegraph Company, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to erect a pole line along Route 34 south of Onley 1.15 miles towards Nelfa.

To El L. Wilson, Lawrenceville, Virginia, to grade an entrance to filling station on Route 12.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that Permit #3823 issued March 16, 1928 to Miss Frances T. Southall, Goochland, Virginia, be cancelled as the work was never done. Motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
