

Minutes of the Meeting of the State
Highway Commission of Virginia,
Held in Richmond, Virginia,
February 17, 1938.

On the morning of February 17, 1938, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, L. Walks Truxton, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met in their office in the State Office Building, Richmond, Va.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the minutes of the meeting of January 21st be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the balance of \$23,891.45 on Route 12, Project 6X1A, 10.5 Miles W. W.C.L. Danville-Henry County Line, be transferred to Route 45, Project 700, Route 14-West. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that \$26,356.72 left on Route 14, Project 897, Buena Vista-South and West, be transferred to Route 300, Project 870A, Covington-North. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that permit #11017, Goodland County, Route 19, issued the Virginia Electric and Power Co., be cancelled as the work has been postponed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project S-88W, Route 31, A.C.L. Underrails and Approaches, to the low bidder, Robert G. Lassiter and Co., Norfolk, Va., at their bid of \$9,316.08, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$11,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project S-888-B6, Route 307, Bridge over Bent Creek, to the low bidder, Alley Construction Co., Bristol, Va., at their bid of \$6,870.92, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project S-692, Route 19, Old Route 19-New Route 19, between Columbia and Dixie, to the low bidder, Hall and Mitchell, Leesburg, Va., at their bid of \$5,092.20, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$470.35 for guard rail, \$567.90 for surface treatment and \$58.50 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project S-736-JB1, Route 57, 0.75 Mile E. Sandy Creek-1.16 Mi. W. Sandy Creek, and Sandy Creek Bridge, to the low bidder, Boston Construction Company, South Boston, Va., at their bid of \$20,510.69, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,183.06 for guard rail; \$3,181.50 for surface treatment and \$114.40 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$27,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project P-744-B1, Route 30, Bridge over Frying Pan Creek, to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Co. Inc., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$3,414.40, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$4,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project P-696-B2, Route 30, Bridge over Stinking River, to the low bidder, M. B. Hudgings, Bianchi, Va., at his bid of \$4,040.52, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$4,800.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project P-175-AB1, Route 31, Falling Creek Bridge and Approaches, to the low bidder, G. P. Clay, Richmond, Va., at his bid of \$15,445.06, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$18,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project P-696-B1, Route 30, Bridge over Georges Creek, to the low bidder, Blewett and Boykin, Brodhead, Va., at their bid of \$3,540.20, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$4,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that both the routes through Coalber and Augusta Streets, approaching Staunton from the North, be emphasized. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the following permits be granted under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

W. L. Altizer, Raven, Va., to build entrance to store and filling station on Route 126, 9 miles west of Grundy.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Lynchburg, Va.; to erect pole line west of Lynchburg on Route 14.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Bluefield, West Va., to erect about 150 feet of two wire street series line for street light on Route 23.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to erect 1 guy pole, 8 anchors and two house connections on Route 55.

J. H. Bowling, Liberty, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Route 112, between Broadford and Plum Creek.

Harry Briesmutter, Greer, Va., to grade and fill in old road bed between the new road and own property on Route 19.

E. F. Bryant, Amelia, Va., to construct entrance to filling station, 3 miles east of Amelia on Route 30.

Bureau of Public Roads, Washington, D.C., to lay wires across state highways in vicinity of Washington for investigating traffic. Wires to be so laid they will in no way interfere with or delay traffic.

C. & P. Telephone Co. of Va., Norfolk, Va., to erect poles, overhead crossings, lay conduit and place anchor guys on Routes 40 and 504, Norfolk Co.

C. & P. Telephone Co. of Va., Richmond, Va., to erect one pole and one guy at intersection of Routes 13 and 414 at Mechanicsville.

Town of Dublin, to lay 1/2" water line along N.W. side of Route 10. Pipe to be driven under pavement of Route 213.

Town of Fairfax, to install water connection to house owned by H. N. Clark and one owned by Wilson M. Parr, on Route 36.

W. P. Hendrick, Richmond, Va., to drive 1" pipe under Route 31 near Norwood Avenue.

W. J. Hellomi, Arden, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 12, Project 450A.

Holston Stone and Lime Corp., Damascus, Va., to place rock crushing plant partially on right of way of Route 12, 10 ft. from edge of hard surface, between Independence and Galax.

Halt Oil Company, Pocahontas City, Md., to install 100 ft. of 8" drain pipe and construct entrance to filling station on Route 54.

W. S. Lewis, Covington, Va., to construct entrance and driveway to residence on Route 14, 1.4 miles west of Covington.

Log Cabin Service Station, Alexandria, Va., to construct driveway to service station on Route 31, at intersection of Route 31 and Frasier Avenue.

Town of Luray, to place a three light traffic signal at intersection of Routes 31 and 515 in the Town.

M. E. Martin, Axton, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 12, 9 miles east of Martinsville.

C. H. Mathews, Williamsburg, Virginia, to install 2500 ft. of 1" water line on Route 39 west of Williamsburg.

Merchants and Farmers Telephone Co., Beaver Dam, Va., to make one telephone wire crossing on Route 39 near South Anna River.

Merchants and Farmers Telephone Co., Beaver Dam, Va., to make two wire crossings on Route 31.

W. H. Minter, Stockton, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 12, about six miles east of Martinsville.

Newport News Waterworks Commission, to cross Route 39 between Hampton and Phoebe about 535 ft. east of College Place, for service connection.

Old Dominion Gas & Electric Corp., Hopewell, Va., to excavate over gas main on Route 460 and run service to residence of Mr. Hastings, of Cedar Level.

Joseph B. Overfelt, Rocky Mount, Va., to grade entrance to filling station and garage on Route 35, between Rocky Mount and Roanoke Mill.

Petersburg Telephone Co., Petersburg, Va., to relocate about 50 poles on temporary location of Route 31, from near Ivy Memorial Church to Timberville Creek.

G. W. Roussey, Martinsville, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 35, 6 miles north of Ridgeway.

Richmond Engineering Company, Inc., Richmond, Va., to haul steel storage tanks from Richmond to Fredericksburg over Route 31, between midnight and 6:00 A.M.

Roslyn Gas Co., Clarendon, Va., to lay 270 ft. of gas main on Route 26 south from existing main.

Roslyn Gas Co., Clarendon, Va., to lay 80 ft. of 4" main on west side of Route 26 at the Lee Memorial Highway.

Roslyn Gas Co., Clarendon, Va., to lay 5" steel gas main under Route 711.

Roslyn Gas Co., Clarendon, Va., to install 5/8" gas service pipe to residence on Route 26, south of Corbett Street.

Lewis E. Smith, Remington, Va., to erect filling station and grade entrance to same on Route 52, about 1.5 miles north of Remington.

William T. Smith, Chilhowie, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 10.

Standard Oil Company of N.J., Baltimore, Md., to drive two 3" pipe lines under driveway on Route 12.

B. A. Turner, Arton, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 12, about 8 miles east of Martinsville.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ service wires over Route 13, about half mile east of Bea Air.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect anchor guy on Route 13, just east of Pennington River.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ secondary service wires over Route 19 just west of Goodland Court House.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to cross Route 43 with 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ secondary service wires just north of intersection of Dickens Road, opposite Spring Street Home.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Norfolk, Va., to erect two poles on Route 503.

Virginia Gas Distribution Corp., Richmond, Va., to construct 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " gas pipe line 3 ft. below surface of Route 600, and across same in two places.

Virginia Gas Distribution Corp., Richmond, Va., to lay gas lines along sections of Routes 52 and 21 in Warrenton for about 7540 feet.

Virginia Gas Distribution Corp., Richmond, Va., to lay 2" gas line along Route 21 just west of Warrenton for 2630 feet.

Virginia Gas Distribution Corp., Richmond, Va., to lay 3" and 4" gas line along Route 52 east of Warrenton for a distance of 2750 feet, making two crossings, these two crossings to be bored.

Virginia Gas Distribution Corp., Richmond, Va., to lay 2" gas line along Route 52 for 1160 feet just north of Warrenton.

Virginia Public Service Co., Clarendon, Va., to install anchors in line with and on poles, 127 west of McLean and 63 east of McLean, on Route 28.

Virginia Public Service Co., Charlottesville, Va., to cross Route 55 two miles west of Louisa with 110/230v service lines.

Virginia Public Service Co., Charlottesville, Va., to cross Route 55 with 6000v transmission line near Bruce Bluff.

Virginia Public Service Co., Charlottesville, Va., to cross Route 50 with 15,000v power transmission line.

Virginia Public Service Co., Warrenton, Va., to construct one three phase 6000v crossing over Route 55 in town of Marshall.

Virginia Public Service Co., Clifton Forge, Va., to erect 4 primary crossings, 3 secondary crossings and 4 guy wire crossings over Route 17 in Craigsville.

Virginia Public Service Co., Alexandria, Va., to cross Route 51 with 2-110v secondary wires south of Fort Humphreys.

Virginia Public Service Co., Alexandria, Va., to erect 11kv crossing over Route 25 near Fairfax Station.

H. B. Walden, Center Cross, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Routes 36 and 604 at Center Cross.

P. E. Walton, Winterpock, Va., to construct double driveway to filling station on Route 20, 8 miles southwest of Richmond.

C. D. Watson, Atkins, Va., to drive water line under Route 10, on Project 361.

Town of Waverly, to install swinging overhead four way traffic signal light over the intersection of Routes 46 and 52 in Waverly, on East Main Street.

Town of Woodstock, to erect electric traffic signal at intersection of Court Street and Route 55 in the town.

A. H. Lehner, McKenney, Va., to construct entrance to tea room on Route 51 at McKenney.

Motion carried.

There being no further business, the Commission adjourned,
subject to the call of the Commissioner.
