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## Meeting of State Highway Commission of Virginia Richmond, Virginia February 15, 1962

The State Highway Counterion of Virginia met at the Central Highway Office, Richmond, Virginia, at 9:00 A.M. on February 15, 1962. The Chairman, H. H. Harris, presided.

Present: Chairman B. B. Harris, Hosers. E. P. Barrow, W. H. Chinn, Jr., S. S. Flythe, S. W. Bewls, Burgeds E. Welson, and Fucker C. Wattime, Jr. Mr. G. Wallace Carper and Mr. W. M. Sciater, Jr., were absent due to illness, At the invitation of the Chairman, Mr. Richard S. Holland, nawly appointed number of the Commission, also attended.
