MINUTES OF MEETING OF STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

Richmond, Virginia

February 21, 1980

The monthly meeting of the State Highway and Transportation Commission was held at the Central Highway Office in Richmond, Virginia, on February 21, 1980, at 10 a.m. The chairman, Mr. Harold C. King, presided.

WHEREAS, the Highway and Transportation Commission is authorized to make certain payments to cities and towns for street purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Highway and Transportation Commission has selected certain streets within the corporate limits of the Town of Warrenton for such payments; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Warrenton has requested the Virginia Department of Highways and Transportation to make certain route designation changes on sections of relocated Routes 15 and 211 due to completion of construction of Project U000-156-103, C-501, within the town;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the route designation for Primary Route Extensions Alternate Business Routes 15 and 211 be relocated along Blackwell Road from Lee Highway to Alexandria Pike; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, also that the route designation on two sections of Old Primary Route Extensions Alternate Routes 15 and 211 (Alexandria Pike) from Lee Highway to Blackwell Road be deleted for the Warrenton Bypass and the remaining section revert to "Other Streets" status; and

WHEREAS, an adjoining landowner, Mrs. Ruby W. Sisson, has requested that the Commonwealth convey to har the land comprising a portion of the old right of way inasmuch as she donated the right of way in 1950; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Sisson also agrees to settle on the outstanding Certificate filed for land required from her on Project 0637-060-146, C-501; and

WHEREAS, the State Righway and Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the excess land containing approximately 0.15 acre and comprising the right of way of old Route 637 which lies to the north of relocated Route 637, extending from a point approximately 90 feet opposite approximate Station 266+40 (centerline relocated Route 637) to a point approximately 30 feet opposite approximate Station 267+70 (centerline relocated Route 637) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no Lougar necessary for the uses of the secondary system of State Highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the conveyance of the land, so certified, is hereby approved and the State Highway and Transportation Commissioner is authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth a deed of quitclaim to the adjoining landowner as partial settlement for an Agreement after Certificate, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 11, State Highway Project 287, now Route 83, State Highway Project 0083-097-101.

WW-201, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands, a portion of which lies outside of the revised normal right of way line. from U. S. G. Mead and Emilie D. Mead by deed dated November 8, 1923 as recorded in Deed Book 166, Page 55, in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Wise County; and

WHEREAS, under Route 83, State Highway Project 0083-097-101, RW-201, Route 83 was relocated in a western direction thus leaving the portion of right of way lying outside the normal right of way line no longer required; and

WHEREAS, the adjoining landowner has requested that the Commonwealth convey to him the land lying outside the revised right of way line in order that he may more fully develop his adjoining property; and

WHEREAS, the State Highway and Transportation Commissioner has certified in writing that the land lying on the west side of and adjacent to the west revised right of way line of old Route 83 from a point approximately 35 feet opposite approximate Station 17+30 (centerline old Route 83) to a point approximately 35 feet opposite approximate Station 18+50 (centerline old Route 83) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-149 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the conveyance of the land, so certified, is hereby approved and the State Highway and Transportation Commissioner is authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth a deed without warranty to the adjoining landowner for a consideration acceptable to the State Right of Way Engineer, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, in connection with Route 622, State Highway Project 0622-018-119, C-501, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands, portions of which lie outside the normal right of way, from Bertha L. Dixon, et al by deed dated July 14, 1977, and recorded in Deed Book 66, Page 155, in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Charles City County; and

WHEREAS, the adjoining landowners have requested that the excess land so acquired lying on the east side of Route 622 be conveyed to them; and

WHEREAS, the parcel of land lying on the east side of and adjacent to the east normal right of way limits of Route 622 from a point approximately 40 feet opposite approximate Station 74+25 (field revised centerline Route 622) to a point approximately 40 feet opposite approximate Station 75+38 (field revised centerline Route 622) does not constitute a section of the public road and is deemed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the secondary system of State Highways.

NOW, THEREFORE, the conveyance of approximately 0.10 acre of land, so cartified, to the adjoining landowners, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-154 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as smended, is approved and the State Highway and Transportstion Commissioner is hereby authorised to execute in the name of the Commonwealth a deed without warranty for a consideration satisfactory to the State Right of Way Engineer, subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisits.

WREREAS, in connection with Routes 297 and 460, State Highway Projects 6297-015-104, RW-201 and 6460-015-104, C-503, the Commonwealth acquired certain lands, a portion of which lies outside the normal right of way and limited access line, from Joseph R. Johnson, et al, by deed dated September 21, 1973 as recorded in Deed Book 484, Page 198 in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Campbell County and in Liber 472, Page 254 in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the City of Lynchburg and from James M. Ayers and Wellie M. Ayers by deed dated June 4. 1973 and recorded in Deed Book 483, Page 194 in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Campbell County and in Liber 471, Page 759 in the Office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the City of Lynchburg; and

WHEREAS, the Lynchburg Gas Company has requested a 30-foot permanent easement to construct, operate and maintain a gas line over, across and beneath the aforementioned land; and

WHEREAS, the State Highway and Transportation Commissioner has certified to the Commission that he deems it expedient to convey to the Lynchburg Gas Company such easement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.1-6 of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended, the State Righway and Transportation Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute a deed in the name of the Commonwealth, conveying a 30-foot permanent gas line easement to the Lynchburg Gas Company in such form and subject to such restrictions as may be deemed proper.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 128 of Title 23 - Highways, United States Code, and FHPM 7-7-5, a location and design public hearing was held in the Harrisonburg Electric Commission Building, Harrisonburg, Virginia, on December 5, 1979, at 7 p.m., for the purpose of considering the proposed location and major design features of Route 752 from 0.034 mile south of the south intersection of Route 734 to the intersection of Route 33 in Rockingham County, State Project 0752-082-160, C-501, B-633; Federal Project RS-1695(); and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given in advance and all those present were given a full opportunity to express their opinions and recommendations for or against the proposed project as presented. and their statements being duly recorded; and

WHEREAS, the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed project have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the location and major design features of this project be approved in accordance with the plan as proposed and presented at the said location and design public hearing by the Department's engineers and amended to eliminate construction of the connection at the south intersection of Route 734 and to shift the mainline alignment approximately 25 feet to the east at the north intersection of Route 734 to reduce property damage.

WHEREAS, on September 21, 1972, the State Highway Commission approved minimum State criteria by which gas, food, and lodging establishments may qualify for participation in specific information signing for travel services within Interstate rights of way: and

WHEREAS, on November 16, 1972, the State Highway Commission approved the gore of the first exit ramp in the direction of travel on the Interstate route at the interchange as the point of measurement in determining the qualification of gas, food, and lodging establishments; and

WHEREAS, experience with the travel services signing program on Interstate Route 95 has revealed a need to revise the criteria for food establishments to preserve the integrity of the program; and

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration Notice N5160.2 dated March 21, 1974, advises that the term "lodging" as used in the National Standards and Criteria for Official Highway Signs within Interstate Rights of Way Giving Specific Information for the Traveling Public shall be interpreted to include overnight camping facilities; and

WHEREAS, Federal Highway Administration Transmittal 38 dated July 2, 1974, establishes standards for specific information signing for gas, food, lodging, and camping facilities within Interstate rights of way; and

WHEREAS, considerable public interest has been shown in having overnight camping facilities identified on the travel services signing program on Interstate Routes 64, 81, and 95; and

WHEREAS, August 18, 1977, camping was added to the criteria; and

WHEREAS, we have a number of interchanges where there are no motels within three miles but are within six miles;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the minimum State criteria for loding establishments are revised to require the following:

- 6. Shall provide public telephone.

FOOD

- Shall be located not more than three miles from the gore of the first exit ramp in the direction of travel on the Interstate route at the interchange.
- Shall display a valid permit from the State Health Commissioner in accordance with Section 35-26 of the Code of Virginia.
- Shall have indoor seating capacity for at least 20 persons.
- 4. Shall be in continuous operation for at least 12 consecutive hours daily, beginning not later than 7 a.m., to serve breakfast, lunch, and supper, 7 days a week.
- Shall provide public telephone.

LODGING

- 1. Shall be located not more than three miles from the gore of the first exit ramp in the direction of travel on the Interstate route at the interchange, or not more than six miles if there is no lodging establishment within three miles, except that overnight camping facilities shall be located not more than ten miles from the gore of the first exit ramp in the direction of travel on the Interstate route at the interchange.
- Shall possess a valid permit from the State Board of Health in accordance with Section 35-22 of the Code of Virginia.
- Shall have not less than ten lodging rooms or space for not less than ten vehicular overnight camping units for rent or hire.
- Shall provide off-street passenger vehicle parking space for each lodging room or vehicular overnight camping unit space for rent or hire.

- 5. Shall be in continuous 24-hour operation, 7 days a week, except that overnight camping facilities may be closed to the public for not more than 120 consecutive days between Movember I and the following April 1, during which time all business panels associated therewith shall be covered or removed.
- 6. Shall provide public telephone.
