MINUTES OF A SPECIAL RESPINS OF THE STATE HIGHMAT COMMISSION, HELD AT STAUNTON, VA. ON MANCH 16th, 1925.

On the morning of March 16th, 1925, Messra. Shirley and Trusten left Richmond by automobile, meeting Mr. Massie at Charlotteeville and them proceeding to Steunton where they were met by Mr. Sproul and hold a special business meeting in Mr. Sproul's office and transacted the following business,

Hevel by Mr. Massie, escended by Mr. Sproof, that the contract for the construction of 3.659 wiles bitemicous macedam road, 18° in width, Soute 33, Project 118-D, 14.51 Miles South of Roadste to 5.11 Miles Morth of Rocky Mount, be swarded to the lew bidder, Allport Construction Company, Richard, Virginia, at their bid of \$78,521.64, and that 10% additional be set unide to cover the cost of contingencies and organizating, and \$600.00 for detours, making a total of \$86,973.80 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massic, seconded by Mr. Sproal, that the contract for the construction of 2.21 miles 16° bituminous mesadam road, Route 113, Preject 8-327, Moorefield-Massim, be awarded to the lose bidder, R. H. Belling, Norton, Virginia, at his bid of \$31,704.76, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$34,875.23 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Sgroul, seconded by Mr. Massic, that the contract for the construction of a reinforced concrete bridge over Toots Creek on Route 15, Project 36, be awarded to the low bidder, M. G. Turner, Abbott, Virginia, at his bid of \$5,607.42, and that 10% additional he set uside to cover the cost Minute Berk Mass No. 47-7 Breests Weddey Co. of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$6,168.16 chargeshie to this Project. Notice carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the bids for hituminous application to smooden roads be exerted to the lew bidders but that for supplying cold patch naturall be rejected and that the Purchasing Department be authorised to purchase this unterial. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Spread, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission accept an advancement of \$150,000.00 under the Robertson Act from Alleghany County for the construction of the State Righway s in that County. Mation carried.

Moved by Mr. Tructum, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the allocation made for Moute 17 be expected from near Goeben in the direction of Millboro and that the remaining parties be used for the construction of bridges on the road leading to the west of Millboro Springs at such points as will do the most good. Motion carried.

The Commission them proceeded from Stauston to Rossole, imspecting the roads through Rockbridge and Retatourt Counties, where they spent the hight and on the next morning they proceeded from Resnake through Mosnoke, Montgomery, Palaski, Wythe and Smyth Counties to Glade Springs where they were joined by Counties inoff. From there they inspected the roads through Washington and Mussell Counties to Big Stone Cap in Wise County where the night was spent.

On the morning of the 18th, they proceeded through Lee and Scott Counties back to Brigtol and thence to Rozzoka, Countseloners Sproul and Minister Bereit (in. 15-P Briefest Kanning CoMassic continuing back to Staumton and the others to their because
