Marie Both Black Ka. 99-7 Bracell Webby Co. MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY CONCUSSION HELD AT DANVILLE AND RICHMOND, VA. MARCH 30 & 31,1725.

On the morning of Murch 30th, 1925, Commissioners Shirley, Massie, and Trustum met in Richmond and made on imprection tour through the Counties of Chesterfield, Amelia, Frince Maward, Charlotte and Helifax to Danwille, Virginia, where they were met by Countesioner Huff and imspected the roads leading out of Danville.

A quoting was held with the Chamber of Commerce, the Lyons, Notary and other Glubs representing the City of Denville and the adjacent Counties. At this meeting they were entertained by the Chamber of Commerce at a very delightful disper, after which talks were made by various persons discussing the road situation and problems in that section.

Upon the adjournment of this meeting the Commission held a business meeting at the Serion Hotel and transmeted the following business:

Moved by Mr. Trextum, escended by Mr. Massie, that contrast for the construction of 4.089 miles 18° bituminous measurement. House 33. Project 169A, including bridge over attents 6.8 miles cost of Treatville, be swarded to the low bidder, Pendleton Construction and Southwest Construction Company, Wytheville, Virginia, at their bid of \$115,186.59, setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$2000.00 for detours, making a total chargeable to this Project of \$128,705.29, with the understanding that the contractor must use MA-2 on this Project, as per bid, unless a letter is secured from the Marbor Asphalt Company stating that it is satisfactory for them to use other material, and also subject to the approval of the plans by the durant of Public Scade, the Commission agreeing to extend the

Moved by Mr. Massis, assembled by Mr. Haff, that the contract for the construction of a rainferend condrate bridge over Meherrin River at Exports, and approaches, Noute 24, Project 385, be awarded to the low bidder, Athieson and dillians, Spottsville, Virginia, at their bid of \$59,216.25, acting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$500.00 for detect, making a total of \$65,637.87 chargeable to this Project. Motion survied.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, assembled by Mr. Huff, that the contract for the construction of .566 Miles 18' bituminous massdam read, Houte 33, Project 1184, south of Romacks, be awarded to the low bidder, Warden Construction Co, Pulanki, Virginia, at their bid of \$11,780.00, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of continguacies and engineering, and \$150.00 for detours, making a total of \$13,108.00 chargeable to this Project, with the understanding that contract is not to be signed until the Constission has been notified that the money to be advanced by Romacke has been put up. Notion derried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Ruff, that the contract for the construction of 3.503 miles of 18° bituminous meadem read, Route 33, Project 118B. South of Rosseke, be awarded to the low hidder, Warden Construction Co, Palaski, Virginia, at their hid of \$65,090.20, and that 10% additional be set under the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$1100.00 for detours, making a total of \$72,699.22 chargeable to this Project, with the understanding that contract is not to be signed until the Commission has been put up. Noved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Tructum, that the contract for the construction of 4.376 Miles 18° bituminous meadam road, Route 33, Project 1180, South of Mosmoka, be awarded to the low bidder, Allport Construction Corporation, Grace American Building, Richmond, Virginia at their hid of \$96,075.84 and that 10% additional be set saide to cover the cost of contingencies and angineering and \$1100.00 for detours, making a total of \$106,793.42 chargeable to this Project, with the understanding that contracts are not to be signed until the Commission has been notified that the money to be advanced by Roanoke has been put up and with the further universaling that the contract must use MA-2 on this Project, as per hid, unless a letter in secured from the Barber Asphalt Company stating that it is satisfactory for them to use other material. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, accorded by Mr. Massic, that the contract for the construction of 3.514 miles of 18° concrete road, including bridge ever Mevletts Will, Route 35, Project 145DMF, be smarded to the low bidder Weighrenn and Carpenter, 1015 North 6th Street, Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$94,108.90 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$2500.00 for detour sless Section D at \$38,667.15 setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$2500.00 for detour sless Section D at \$38,667.15 setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering and \$2000.00 for detours on Section 7, making a grand total of \$150,553.65 chargeable to this Project. H. George, Jr. and Some, Michaeld, Virginia, at their bid of \$129,990.10 and that 10% additional be set a side to never the cost of contingencies and engineering, and \$6325.00

Minute Bank Bhart Ke, 30-4 Search Wolfey Co. for detours, making a total of \$149,314.11 caurgeable to this Project. Metion carried.

Moved by Mr. Traxtum, accomded by Mr. Manade, that the contract for the construction of 6.316 miles of grading and drainage, Route 17, Project 391, .5 miles west of Goshen to 6.79 miles west of Soshen, be awarded to the low bidder. Robert Martin Company, Salam, Virginia, at his bid of \$50,359.83, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and savgineering, and \$3,000.00 for detours, making a total of \$91,395.81 chargeable to this Project against the allocation of \$146,000.00 and the remainder be advertised for the construction of bridges over certain streams and approaches thereto and such grading as it will do. Motion carried.

The night was spent at Danville and on the morning of the 31st,

Considerioners Shirley, Massis and Truntum returned to Richmond, impresting

Routes 323, 10, and 31 arriving at Richmond about mean and in the efferences a

business masting was called.

Ur. W. P. Sullives and Mr. Fugh, representing the Manuschud Brick
Corporation, came before the Commission in regards to their claim for desurrage
on burges used for transporting gravel from the pit at Porell's Greek to Reids
Ferry and Buffolk and presented a bill amounting to \$1749.36. They stated
that their contract with the state called for the transporting of 200 tens of
gravel per day and their claim represents the actual time they were telayed.
They also submitted an itemized statement showing the sace movements. Mr.
Skirley requested them to separate their claim, showing the delay at the pit
and the delay at point of unleading. This they agreed to formish.

Mesers. Miller, Venuon and Mutile, of the Fidelity and Deposit Company of Maryland, then same before the Commission in regards to their bond on 3-31-25. 101.

Minete Beck Gloss No. 15-P Traint Walter Co. Project 48C, Soute 14, Sig Island-Snowies, Corson-Davis Contractors. Mr.

Miller stated that he wanted a thorough understanding as to the complaint the

Complesion had against his Company and why they had been departed from furnighing bonds is this State. Mr. Shirley explained to them that having reneived several letters from his company disclaiming may further responsibility

as to the bond, that the Commission did not care to do business with a company that the Commission would have to one to make them live up to their

terms. After discussing the matter thoroughly, Mr. Miller stated that his

Company would pay on this contract up to the possibly of the bond.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Fidelity and Depart Company of Maryland be notified that based on the statement made by their President, Mr. Miller, "That the Bonding Company would reimberes the State for all loss caused by the defaulting of Corson-Davis Company, contractors on Project 48e, Route 14, to the amount of the penalty of the bond, unpaid labor and material bills being included in the amount", that being Fidelity and Deposit Company be reinstated as a company asceptible to give bonds for State bighway work, provided that an official withdrawal of their communications of laguest 23rd and September 12th, 1924, be made. Motion carried.

The Commission than adjourned, subject to the call of the Chairman.
