

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, March 30, 1938.

On the morning of March 30, 1938, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, H. W. Rawls and J. F. Wycor, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that the minutes of the meeting of February 23rd be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that in any county where mileage is abandoned from the secondary system by order of the Board of Supervisors, the same or any portion thereof can be applied to new roads to be added during the calendar year. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that in controlling traffic over the roads included in the grounds of the various State Institutions, the authorities of the Institutions be authorized to make such rules and regulations as to promote the highest degree of safety on such roads, provided such rules and regulations are not inconsistent with State laws. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission appropriate \$500.00 per mile construction funds for the City of Newport News for the year 1938-39 to be applied to new construction on 54th and 55th Streets between Jefferson and Chestnut Avenues, Route 186. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission appropriate \$500.00 per mile construction funds for the City of Danville for the year 1938-39 to be applied to resurfacing pavement on Main Street Bridge over the Dan River, Route 29. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission appropriate \$500.00 per mile construction funds for the City of Richmond for the year 1937-38 to be applied to work on the Boulevard between the R.F.&P. Bridge and Westwood Avenue, Route 161, and on the section of Route 55 from New Bridge Road to the City limits. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission appropriate and set up a project for the \$500.00 per mile construction funds to the City of Lynchburg for the year 1937-38 to be expended on the improvement of Rivermont Avenue between Jones and Belvedere Streets, Route 501. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. East, that the request for permit by the Town of Front Royal, to erect traffic light on Route 3 at the intersection of 6th Street and E. Royal Avenue, be rejected. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the request for permit by the Town of Windsor to erect traffic light at intersection of Routes 160 and 158 in the Town be rejected. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wyszor, that the Commission appoint Mr. D. B. Fugate, Resident Engineer, Traffic Officer No. 308. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission abandon the 800 ft. of route leading west from Road No. 8 within the grounds of the Catawba Sanatorium and take in lieu thereof road No. 1, and add to the system 808 ft. or 1/8 of a mile on road No. 4 under the 2 1/2% Clause. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the sick leave of Colonel Thos. E. Marshall, Junior Draftsman, be extended 15 days in the month of February, with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wyszor, that whereas contract was awarded on December 11, 1937, to Bohels Bros., Staunton, Va., on Project FA 600 RIFB, Route 8, 3 Mi. W. Scottsville-Scottsville, and whereas this project was held up on account of difficulty in securing right of way and the time limit expired in which the contractor was compelled to take the job, and the contractor refused the same, the contract is hereby annulled. Motion carried.
