NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$175,000 from the 1999-2000 Fiscal Year Recreational Access Fund be allocated to Project 1018-299-201,N501 to provide access to Shenandoah Park located off Route 602 within the Town of Shenandoah, contingent upon:

- the Director of the Department of Conservation and Recreation recommending the use of the Recreational Access Fund for construction of an access road and designating Shenandoah Park as a public recreational area;
- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Recreational Access Fund; and
- the payment of all ineligible project costs and all eligible project costs in excess of \$175,000 from sources other than the Recreational Access Fund.

Item 11:

Moved by Mr. Grubb, seconded by Mrs. Welsh, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund to "...be expended by the Board for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining, or improving access roads within counties, cities, and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing, or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed and to licensed, public-use airports"; and

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of Supervisors has, by appropriate resolution, requested industrial Access Funds to serve eligible parcels within the Thomas E. Lee Industrial Park located off U.S. Highway 15 south of the Town of Orange, and said access is estimated to cost \$450,000; and

WHEREAS, the current subdivision plat, dated January 28, 2000, provided by Orange County is referenced for delineation of eligible parcels; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the Intent of Section 33.1-221 and complies with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on industrial access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$375,000 (\$300,000 unmatched and \$75,000 matched) of the 1999-2000 Fiscal Year Industrial, Airport, and Rail Access Fund be allocated to provide adequate access to parcels #7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 17, 18, and 19 within the Thomas E. Lee Industrial Park located off U.S. Highway 15 south of the Town of Orange, Project 0780-068-180,N502, contingent upon:

- all necessary right of way, environmental assessments, and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth; and
- the execution of an appropriate contractual agreement between the County of Orange (County) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), to provide for:
- a. the design, administration, construction, and maintenance of this project.
- b. the payment of all ineligible project costs, and of any eligible project costs in excess of this allocation, from sources other than the Industrial, Airport, and Rall Access Fund:

- c. the provision of an appropriate bond or other acceptable surety device by the County to VDOT, not to expire before April 16, 2005. Such surety device shall provide for reimbursement to VDOT of any expenses incurred by the Industrial, Airport, and Rail Access Fund for this project's construction not justified by the eligible capital outlay of industries served by the project. If, by March 16, 2005, qualified industry has not expended or entered into a firm contract to expend at least \$4,500,000 of eligible capital outlay on parcels served exclusively by this project, than an amount equal to 10% of up to \$3,000,000 and 5% between \$3,000,000 and \$4,500,000 of eligible capital outlay will be credited toward the project's allocation. This surety may be released or reduced at an earlier date if qualified industry or industries have provided documentation of eligible capital outlay; and
- d. VDOT determining eligible capital outlay in accordance with current policy and procedure.

Moved by Mrs. Lionberger, seconded by Mr. White, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-75.1 of the Code of Virginia prescribes the annual allocation of state funds to provide an equivalent matching allocation for certain local funds designated by the governing body, to be placed in a special fund account known as "County Primary and Secondary Road Fund"; and

WHEREAS, this special fund account "...shall be used solely for the purposes of either (i) maintaining, improving, or constructing the primary and secondary systems within such county, or (ii) bringing subdivision streets, used as such prior to July 1, 1988, up to standards sufficient to qualify them for inclusion in the state primary and secondary system..."; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Henry County elected to participate in this program for Fiscal Year 1999-2000 and, with the Department, identified specific eligible items of work to be financed from the special fund account; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Henry County has, by appropriate resolution, requested these funds be reallocated to other specific eligible items of work, as indicated herein, and

WHEREAS, these items of work fall within the intent of Section 33.1-75.1 of the Code of Virginia, and comply with the guidelines of the Department for use of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby approves the reallocation of these funds as set forth and indicated herein.
