MINUTES OF THE EERTING OF THE STATE HIGHMAT COMMISSION OF VIROIDIA, HELD APRIL 7, 1927, RICHEMD, VIRGINIA.

On the morning of April 7, 1927, the State Highway Commission, commissing of Messre. R. G. Shirley, Chairman, Wado H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh S. Sproul, I. Walke Truxton, and H. G. Gilmer, and their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Senator Thos. J. Downing appeared before the Commission in behalf of Mr. J. G. Davenport, low bidder on Route 15, Project P-17111, Brey's York, 5.965 Miles West. He stated that Mr. Davenport pub down the wrong set of figures is his bid and if the contract was awarded to him it would mean that he would either have to forfeit his check for \$1,000.00 or would lose a good deal of money on the contract and he is a young man just starting out in the contracting business and this lose would very seriously cripple him. Senator Downing requested that the Commission do what they could for Mr. Davenport, either relieve him of the contract or reject all bids and reservertise.

Commission came before the Commission in regards to the proposed road leading from the New Arlington Memorial Bridge to the Lee Highway. He stated that the Lee Highway Association had requested his Commission to accept a 200 foot right of way which they had refused to do. It was the desire of their Commission to confer and advise with the State Highway Commission as to the route to be adopted but did not want to take any action that would in any way fix the route to be adopted. Historia Back Shoot No. 86-P Drawnt Workley Co. Stated that it was the opinion of the Commission's Attorney, that the State Highway Commission had no authority to secure more right of way then was needed for highway purposes and asked that if the State Highway Commission would accept an 60 foot right of way would it be possible for the Capital Park and Planning Commission to accept the additional width for parking purposes. Colonel Grant said he thought some such arrangement would be possible but that the Flanning Commission would not be in a position to make any improvements or make any expenditure in the near future.

The minutes of the meeting held March 11th, were read and it was moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Silmer, that they be approved. Meetion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that in the classification for Olerka the maximum salary be \$2100.00 and the maximum for stemographer-clarks be raised to \$1800.00. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the low bidder on Project F-171AA, Route 15, Brays Fork, West, J.G.Davehport, he awarded the contract at his bid or if he does not take the contract be penalized \$600.00 to cover the cost of readvertising, and that all other bids he rejected and work readvertised. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Truxtum, asconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F-47LB, Route 51, Rdanoke Hiver - North Carolina Line, to the low bidder, Hi-Way Construction Company, Statesville, North Carolina, at their bid of \$167,095.54, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$184,000.00 chargeable to this project, provided, however, that the Atlantic Paving Company of Statesville, North Carolina, will become a party to this contract and sign

with the Hi-Way Construction Company. Metion carried.
