Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission of Virginia, Held in Berryville, April 26, 1937.

On the morning of the 26th, the State Highway Commission convened at Berryville, Virginia, those being present were Messre. Messie, Rawle and East, accompanied by Chairman Shirley, where a hearing was given in regard to the closing of a section of the old road and grade crossing thereon ever the Morfolk and Western tracks at Gaylord, in Clarke County, Virginia. Messre. Massie, Rawle and East eat as the Commission, patitioners being represented by Mr. Edward McC. Williams. After all testimony the Commission advised that they would make a final decision at a subsequent date.

After the hearing the Chairman called a special meeting of the Commission and the following business transacted.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project 1140 Bi, Route 185, Bridge over Water Works Canal, to the low bidder, Virginia Construction Company, Prodericks burg, Va., at their bid of \$8,782.85, and that 10% additional be set suite to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this project. Mation carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission sward contract for the construction of Project PA 6010, Route 50, Intersection arlington Bidge Road-4.98 Mi. E. Falls Church, to the low bidder, W. H. Scott, Franklin, Va., at his bid of \$162,361.88, that 10% additional be set eside to cover the sect of engineering and additional work; \$1,350.00 for pels lines and \$5,850.00 for moving car tracks, making a total of approximately \$184,000.00 chargeable to this project, charging definit to unobligated balances. Notion carried.

Howad by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawle, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 585 Al, Route 11, SCL Staunton 0.55 Ml. S. SCL Staunton, to the low bidder, R. W. Moore and Company, Box 505, Staunton, Va., at their bid of \$17,544.10, that 10% additional be set acids to sover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$209.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$20,000.00 chargeable to this project. Notice service.

Moved by Mr. Hawle, seconded by Mr. Mast, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project WFM 585 M2, Route 11, 0.19 Mt. M. SCL Staunton-SCL Staunton, to the low bidder, Parkins-Barnes Construction Company, Inc., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$16,775.60, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional mork and \$22.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$19,000.00 chargeable to this project. Tuck and Son, Chapel Hill, F.C., at their bid of \$122,610.69, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$365.00 for moving poles lines, making a total of approximately \$136,000.00 chargeable to this project. Intersection Route 27-Intersection Route 27, to the low bidder, Virginia Construction Company, Fredericksburg, Va., on their regular bid of \$11,242.85, and that 10% additional be est aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$15,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawle, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission sward contracts on Plant Mixed Bituminous Materials on bids opened April 22nd to the low bidders as follows:
