

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Berryville, April 26, 1937.

On the morning of the 26th, the State Highway Commission convened at Berryville, Virginia, those being present were Messrs. Massie, Rawls and East, accompanied by Chairman Shirley, where a hearing was given in regard to the closing of a section of the old road and grade crossing thereon over the Norfolk and Western tracks at Gaylord, in Clarke County, Virginia. Messrs. Massie, Rawls and East sat as the Commission, petitioners being represented by Mr. Edward McC. Williams. After all testimony the Commission advised that they would make a final decision at a subsequent date.

After the hearing the Chairman called a special meeting of the Commission and the following business transacted.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project 1140 B1, Route 185, Bridge over Water Works Canal, to the low bidder, Virginia Construction Company, Fredericksburg, Va., at their bid of \$8,782.85, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 501D, Route 50, Intersection Arlington Edge Road-4.56 Mi. E. Falls Church, to the low bidder, W. H. Scott, Franklin, Va., at his bid of \$162,361.36, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$1,350.00 for pole lines and \$3,850.00 for moving car tracks, making a total of approximately \$184,000.00 chargeable to this project, charging deficit to unobligated balances. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 585 A1, Route 11, SCL Staunton 0.35 Mi. S. SCL Staunton, to the low bidder, R. W. Moore and Company, Box 503, Staunton, Va., at their bid of \$17,544.10, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$200.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$20,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project WPMH 585 M2, Route 11, 0.19 Mi. N. SCL Staunton-SCL Staunton, to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Company, Inc., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$16,773.80, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$22.00 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$19,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 620 H1, 37.6, Route 221, 5.7 Mi. E. ECL Floyd-1.4 Mi. E. ECL Floyd, to the low bidder, Cobb and Homewood Inc., and W. W. Tuck and Son, Chapel Hill, N.C., at their bid of \$122,610.69, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$368.00 for moving poles lines, making a total of approximately \$128,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project WPGM 1067 NBS, Route 220, RAW Underpass and Approaches on Franklin Road in Roanoke, to the low bidder, Walters and Prater, Merriestown, Tennessee, at their bid of \$79,233.80; that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$38,860.00 work by RR Company, \$6,330.00 by others and \$21,280.00 structural steel by Railroad, making a total of approximately \$154,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Morris, that the Commission award contract for the construction of Project FA 1115 A2, Route 299, 0.52 Mi. W. Intersection Route 27-Intersection Route 27, to the low bidder, Virginia Construction Company, Fredericksburg, Va., on their regular bid of \$11,242.88, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$13,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission award contracts on Plant Mixed Bituminous Materials on bids opened April 22nd to the low bidders as follows:-
