#### MINUTES OF THE MERTING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION, MELD AT RICHERO, VIRGINIA, MAY 25, 1925.

On the morning of May 25th, the State Highest Commission, consisting of Mesers. S. C. Shirley, Chairman, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, and A. J. Haff, met at their office 814 State Office Smilding, Richmond, Virginia, and the mosting was called to order by the Chairman.

Mr. W. H. Aston of Meadowrise, Virginia, same before the Commission and requested that the undistributed mileage under the 25 Clause for Mintension in the Bristel District of 2.4 miles, to mileasted to the read leading from Cedarville to Meadowrise Station. He stated that from Route 10 to the depot is a 14 feet bituminous meadom read and the belance to Route Mo. 12 is a 12 feet manadam read in fair condition, He also guaranteed a fifty feet right of way free of cost to the Commission.

Securior Parsons and Mr. Preston Davis then came before the Commission in regards to the road from Independence to the North Carolina Line and the proposed bridge scross New River. They wanted to advance sufficient money under the Robertson Act to pay for half the cost of the bridge and also the road if the Commission would accept that amount. They said that if the Commission would accept that amount, they would pledge themselves to reise the other half.

Mr. Shirley advised them that the Commission and already accepted the full amount allowed by the Legislature under the Robertson Act for the years 1925 and 1926, but that should anyone wish to withdraw their application which the Commission had accepted, they would accept sufficient money to construct half of the Bridge.

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Minerio Back Chane Mei, 197-P Transis Washing Co. Sounter Parsons also requested that the 2.4 miles of undistributed milesge in the Bristol District, be applied to the read porth of Independence.

The minutes of the sectings of the Commission held February 25th, 1925 at Richmond, Murch 16th at Stauston, Merch 30th and 31st, at Despite and Richmond, respectively, were read and it was moved by Mr. Haff, seconded by Mr. Hassie, that they be approved. Motion carried.

B. Hudgins and Company, Roznake, Virginia, at their bid of \$13,863.10 for A, and \$9,936.90 for B, setting axide 10% miditional for contingencies and sugginaring, making a total of \$26,180.00 chargeable against the General Allocation of \$25,000,00, be confirmed. Motion curried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Haff, that the roads leading to the Estimus Communica at Staumion and Fredericksburg to taken over for maintenance. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, assembed by Mr. Ruff, that the State Highway Commission approve of the bedget for the expenditure of the Forestry Money as set forth by the Sureau of Public Scade and that Scate No. No over Iron Mountain be included as a Forestry Road, Motion carried.

The Commission them adjourned until the next day, when they were joined by Commissioner Sproud and proceeded to Paraville where a public hearing was held on the location of Soute 32 from Faraville via Worsham to the Charlotte County line near Briery.

After this bearing the Commission inspected the roads through
Prince Edward, Charlotte, Mecklenburg, Brunswick and Oreensville Counties to
Emporia, where they mut the Kimanis Club and were entertained by the Club at
dinner, after which they bed a general discussion of reads in this section and
especially the Halifax Road. The Commission them returned to Richard where
the night was spent.
