Minuté Bigle Stort No. 18-7 Everat Wackley Co. MINUTES OF THE MESTING OF THE STATE HICHWAY COMMISSION HELD IN PULLSKI, STREETCH, AND MORFOLK, VA., MAY 17, 18, & 19, 1917,

On the lith of May, Commissioners Shirley, Sproul and Massie, proceeded to Rosnoke, Virginia, where they spent the night and on the morning of the 17th proceeded to Pulsaki where they were joined by Commissioner Gilmer, and held a public hearing in the Court Rouse on the allocation of funds for the last half of the fiscal year 1927-28, for the Bristol and Salem Districts.

After all who wished to be heard had spoken, a large delegation from Polaski City and Palaski use Hontgomary Counties as well as from various towns in that section, requested that the Commission give them a bearing on the Old Rock Road and Route 10 between Pulaski and Radford.

Those representing the Old Rock Road were; D. C. Barton,
Senator Heell, D. K. Lacus, R. I. Roope, R. P. Johnson, George A. Collins,
H. T. Roberts, and J. W. Hollavock. They requested the Constanton to take
into the State Highway System the section of road leading from just east of
Endford to Ingles Ferry, knows as the Old Rock Road. They stated that this
would greatly shorten the distance between Radford and Wytheville, and requested that no large expenditure be made on Route 10 as now adopted but inprove the Old Rock Road, and a number of petitions were filed with the Conmission.

Those representing Route 10 between Radford and Pulsaki were; Mr. John S. Draper and Mr. R. G. Gilmer, who protested against the allocation of \$25,000.00 allocated to this road being diverted. 5-18-29 106.

Marte Bayle State My. 18-9 Revisit Walder Co. After this hearing the Commission proceeded to Staunton where the night was spent and on the morning of the 18th, the case sembers being procent, held public bearings on the allocation of funds to the Lynchburg. Staunton and Calpaper Districts.

After hearing all who wished to speak, the Commission held a regular business meeting.

The Mesting was called to order by the Chairmon.

The minutes of the meeting hold April 28th in Winchester were read and it was Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Cilmer, that they be approved. Botion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sprout, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Chappenenneic Creek, Route 31, Project 3-79, be swarded to the low bidder, The Southern Maryland Construction Company, Baltimore, Maryland, at their bid of \$12,876.40 and that 10% additional be not uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$14,000.00 chargeable to this project, with the understanding that the contractor is not to start work on this job watil after the colephation on the 28th is over. Notion carried.

Noved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of 3.33 miles of 18' bitumineus encedes, Route 23, Project 29341, Montgomery County, be awarded to the low bidder, Pendleton Construction Company, Mytheville, Virginia, at their bid of \$60,385.66, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$600.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$67,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Manele, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over New River South of Independence, Route 25 Project S4118, be awarded to the low bidder, Foster, Relson & Sattle, Elkin, North Carolina, at their bid of \$74,883.83 and that log additional be set geside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$83,000.00 phargeable to this project, subject to the approval of the North Carolina Righway Complesion. Motion carried.

Noved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of 2.4 miles soil road, Route 18, Preject 8-4871, North of Halifex, be searched to the low bidder, C. H. Oliver and Company, Docwell, Virginia, at their bid of \$23,079.29 and that low additional be set saids to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$1,200.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$27,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the following Permits be grapted under the Rules and Regulations of the Commission:

To N. A. Ashby, Fredericksburg, Virginia, to construct an entrunce into filling station on Route 31, Spotsylvania County,
