

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, May 25, 1939.

On the morning of May 25th, 1939, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. E. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, S. W. Rawls, J. F. Wycor and Kenneth N. Gilpin, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of April 4th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the action of the Commissioner in cancelling the policy for insurance on motor vehicles, taking a short term policy for the month, and then awarding contract to the Lumbermans Mutual Casualty Company for one year, beginning May 1, 1939 and ending April 30, 1940, on the new rates, thereby saving \$6,581.51, be approved and confirmed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project FA 1198 AB1,2 - PAGE 1198 B3, 5 Mi. N. of NCL Martinsville-NCL Martinsville, to the low bidder, Nello L. Teer, Durham, N.C., at his bid of \$186,890.72, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$275.00 for work by the railroad, making a total of approximately \$183,800.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project FA 356 CWT,DWL, 2.4 Mi. W. NCL Hilton Village-5.49 Mi. W. NCL Hilton Village, to the low bidder T. E. Ritter Co., Inc., Norfolk, Va., at their bid of \$66,941.23, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$72,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Route 250 Association, asking that the Route be designated from Richmond to Old Point along the route now marked No. 60; that the allocation of \$100,000.00 on the section between Staunton and Waynesboro be used to construct a modern four lane road, and that the towns affected be not by-passed in the location of this route. Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wisor, that the following resolution be adopted: The efforts of the Associated Clubs of Virginia to make Virginia road sides the most beautiful in America should receive the full support of every one interested in the future development of the State. The plan embraces the country-side as seen from the highway, and to carry it out will require not only the cooperation of all State agencies but in a larger measure that of all property owners. The Highway Commission appreciate the valuable services being rendered by these clubs in this development, endorses their objective and will cooperate in every way possible for its successful fruition. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Chairman be authorized to put on summer students at the following rates:

Mr. Frank M. Wray, Mr. Blackburn Moore and a large delegation appeared before the Commission relative to the location of Route 60 at Boyce, and advocated an alternate route through the Town, requesting a resurvey.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the line for Route 50 at Boyce be adopted over the route on which the rights of way can be secured at a reasonable cost, namely the Waterloo Route. Motion carried.

Whereas A. H. Pettigrew, Right of Way Engineer, has submitted to Mr. Shirley a letter dated May 24, 1939, relative to a certain tract of land in Floyd and Patrick Counties on the Blue Ridge Parkway known as Government Tract 29, title to which is vested in the Commonwealth; and whereas the National Park Service agreed to purchase the said tract for the sum of \$3200.00; and whereas the said National Park Service has been unable to complete said agreement because it had no funds available for the purchase of this tract; and whereas the National Park Service has now agreed to make certain concessions in connection with the requirements for right of way on sections 1-L and 1-M of the Blue Ridge Parkway which will result to the advantage and pecuniary benefits of the Commonwealth in a degree exceeding the \$3200.00 above referred to; now, therefore, on motion of Mr. Wisor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, and unanimously carried by the Commission, the Commissioner is hereby authorized to convey by deed the said tract of land to the United States of America, subject to the approval of the Governor.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Chairman.
