WHEREAS, in accordance with its needs and schedules for implementing its program objectives, the Department has determined that in order to perform the necessary activities to meet those objectives for geotechnical investigations, supplemental surveys, utility (water and sewer), landscaping, structure and bridge (to include design of three new bridges and four bridge widenings, deck evaluation on existing bridges, final plans, estimates, special provisions, review of shop drawings, consultation during construction, geotechnical borings and analysis and survey to locate borings), right of way and roadway construction plans on Route I-81 for Project 0081-080-110,PE105, located in Roanoke County, it is necessary to supplement its staff; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Department policy and State procurement procedures, a firm proposal has been received from Gannett Fleming, Inc. for said services; and

WHEREAS, careful review and consideration has been made of the scope of work and services required and just compensation has been established for these services and is set forth in a Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the execution of the Agreement with the firm of Gannett Fleming, Inc., which establishes a compensation of \$3,321,432.00 for services and expenses, plus a net fee of \$138,845.00, making the maximum total compensation not to exceed \$3,460,277.00.

The second phase will consist of providing final design and complete right of way, roadway and structure and bridge plans once an alternative has been selected on Project 0267-029-107, PE101; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Department policy and State procurement procedures, a firm proposal has been received from Sverdrup Civil, Inc. for said services; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Department policy and State procurement procedures, a firm proposal has been received from Earth Tech, Inc. for sald services; and

WHEREAS, careful review and consideration has been made of the scope of work and services required and just compensation has been established for these services and is set forth in a Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the execution of the Agreement with the firm of Earth Tech, Inc., which establishes a compensation of \$786,443.00 for services and expenses plus a net fee of \$26,448.00 making the maximum total compensation not to exceed \$812,931.00.

WHEREAS, in accordance with its needs and schedules for implementing its program objectives, the Department has determined that in order to perform the necessary activities to meet those objectives for the design of Traffic Control Devices and ITS elements for Route 81 in Roanoke and Botetourt Counties, it is necessary to supplement its staff; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Department policy and State procurement procedures, a firm proposal has been received from URS Greiner Woodward Clyde International Americas, Inc. for said services; and

WHEREAS, careful review and consideration has been made of the scope of work and services required and just compensation has been established for these services and is set forth in a Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the execution of the Agreement with the firm of URS Greiner Woodward Clyde International Americas, Inc., which establishes an actual cost of \$3,470,441.58, a net fee of \$248,181.36 and a maximum total compensation not to exceed \$4,063,032.46.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the statutes of the Commonwealth of Virginia and policies of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, a Combined Location and Design Public Hearing was held in the Nottoway Senior High School in Nottoway County, Virginia, on Tuesday, February 29, 2000, between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of considering the proposed location and major design features for Cellar Craek Road (Route 614) in Nottoway County, from 0.52 mile (0.84 km) north of Route 731 to 0.94 mile (1.52 km) north of Route 731, State Project 9614-067-174,M501; and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given in advance, and all those present were given a full opportunity to express their opinions and recommendations for or against the proposed project as presented, and their statements being duly recorded; and

WHEREAS, the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed project have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the location and major design features of this project be approved in accordance with the plan as proposed and presented at the said Location and Design Public Hearing by the Department's Engineers.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the statutes of the Commonwealth of Virginia and policies of the Commonwealth Transportation Board, a Combined Location and Design Public Hearing was held in the W. E. Cundiff Elementary School in Roanoke County, Virginia, on Thursday, March 23, 2000, between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m., for the purpose of considering the proposed location and major design features for Route 634 in Roanoke County, from the East Corporate Limit of the Town of Vinton to 0.10 mile east of the East Corporate Limit of the Town of Vinton, State Project 9634-980-309,C501,D688; and

WHEREAS, proper notice was given in advance, and all those present were given a full opportunity to express their opinions and recommendations for or against the proposed project as presented, and their statements being duly recorded; and

WHEREAS, the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed project have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the location and major design features of this project be approved in accordance with the plan as proposed and presented at the said Location and Design Public Hearing by the Department's Engineers.

Moved by Mr. Grubb, seconded by Mr. Martin, that

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Scott County dld adopt a resolution by which this Commonwealth Transportation Board was petitioned to designate the bridge over the Clinch River on Route 645 located at Hill Station off Route 65 in Scott County as a memorial to the late Mr. O. B. Damell; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Darnell was a respected businessman and operated a stock yard for many years at Hill Station; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Darnell was well known and held in high repute within the community as a good neighbor, citizen and friend; and

WHREAS, it is the desire of the Commonwealth Transportation Board to honor Mr. Darnell, now deceased.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board, in accordance with the authority entrusted under Section 33.1-250 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, does hereby declare that the bridge on Route 645 in Scott County as herein described, be named the "O. B. Darnell Memorial Bridge."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriate markers, as directed by the Department's engineers, be placed calling attention to this designation.

Item 11:

Moved by Mr. White, seconded by Mr. Grubb, that

WHEREAS, incorporated towns having thirty-five hundred inhabitants or less have two choices regarding the operation of their secondary system of streets, pursuant to the Code of Virginia, as amended (i.e. Section 33.1-79 and Section 33.1-82); and

WHEREAS, each such town was given the opportunity to select the specific statute under which it wished to operate; and

WHEREAS, it has been the long-standing policy of the Board that after the town makes its selection, it is in the best interest of the parties concerned not to make any change therein unless the town shows good cause to the contrary; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Haymarket chose to operate under Section 33.1-79 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, thereby limiting the mileage of roads that can be added to the secondary system of state highways to no more than one-quarter mile per year; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council, citing extraordinary growth within the town and having added all streets in the town that qualify for addition to the secondary system of state highways, pursuant to Section 33.1-79, now proposes the town be allowed to change its earlier selection; and

WHEREAS, by resolution dated the first day of May, 2000, the Town of Haymarket requests it be permitted to operate under Section 33.1-82 of the Code of Virginia, as amended; and

WHEREAS, it appears this request falls within the intent of the Board's policy regarding the operation of the secondary system of state highways in towns with a population of 3,500 or less.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the request from the Town of Haymarket to change its operation of the secondary system from Section 33.1-79 to Section 33,1-82 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any subsequent request for the addition of streets to the secondary system of state highways within the Town of Haymarket be considered under the provisions of Section 33.1-82 of the Code of Virginia, as amended.

Item 12:

Moved by Mrs. Weish, seconded by Mr. White, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-75.1 of the Code of Virginia prescribes the annual allocation of state funds to provide an equivalent matching allocation for certain local funds designated by the governing body, to be placed in a special fund account known as "County Primary and Secondary Road Fund"; and

WHEREAS, this special fund account "... shall be used solely for the purposes of either (i) maintaining, improving, or constructing the primary and secondary systems within such county, or (ii) bringing subdivision streets, used as such prior to July 1, 1988, up to standards sufficient to qualify them for inclusion in the state primary and secondary system..."; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Buchanan County elected to participate in this program for Flacal Years 1992-93, 1996-97, 1997-98, 1997-98 Supplemental, and 1998-99 and, with the Department, identified specific eligible items of work to be financed from the special fund account; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Buchanan County has, by appropriate resolution, requested these funds be reallocated to other specific eligible items of work, as indicated herein; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Loudoun County elected to participate in this program for Fiscal Years 1994-95 Supplemental, 1995-96, and 1996-97 and, with the Department, identified specific eligible items of work to be financed from the special fund account; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of Loudouri County has, by appropriate resolution, requested these funds be reallocated to other specific eligible items of work, as indicated herein; and

WHEREAS, these items of work fall within the intent of Section 33.1-75.1 of the Code of Virginia and comply with the guidelines of the Department for use of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby approves the reallocation of these funds as set forth and indicated herein.

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Item 13:

Moved by Mr. White, seconded by Mrs. Welsh, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221.1:1 of the Code of Virginia declares it to be in the public interest that access railroad tracks and facilities be constructed to certain industrial or commercial sites; and

WHEREAS, the Culpeper Town Council has, by resolution, shown support for application of \$35,000 in Industrial Access Railroad Track Funds for The Rochester Corporation; and

WHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1-221.1:1 and is in accordance with the provisions of the Commonwealth Transportation Board's policy on the use of Industrial Access Railroad Track Funds; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the funding formula established by said policy, funding may be allocated to this project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 935, Item 523.i.A.1, of the 1999 Acts of the General Assembly, funding is provided for Industrial, Airport, and Rail Access projects; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that this project is for the common good of a region of the Commonwealth and serves a public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves that \$35,000 of the Industrial, Airport, and Rail Access Fund be provided to rehabilitate the existing side track to serve The Rochester Corporation located in the Town of Culpeper contingent upon:

- 1. All necessary right of way and utility adjustments being provided at no cost to the Commonwealth.
- 2. All costs above \$35,000, which is allocated herein as an industrial rail access grant, being borne by The Rochester Corporation.
- Execution of an agreement acceptable to the Department of Rail and Public Transportation.
