Minutes of Special Meetings of the State Highway Commission held in the City of Richmond, Carter's Grove in James City County, and Charles City Court House, Virginia, June 14, 15, and 16, 1920.

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The State Highway Commission, Wade H. Bassie, Chairman, Henry P. Beck, Secretary, E. G. Davis, Horace Hardaway, and James A. Mundy, Jr., being present, met in the office of the State Highway Commissioner, Lyric Building, Richmond, Virginia, on June 14th at 10 A. M.

The minutes of the meetings of May 25, 26, and 27th were read and on motion of Mr. Davis were approved, and the Chairman authorized to sign the same.

On motion of Mr. Mundy the appeal of W. S. Jackson, O. S. Allen, J. C. Courier and other freeholders of Amelia County from the decision of the State Highway Commissioner in locating on the North side of the Southern Railway that portion of Route 20 between Amelia C. H. and Jetersville was rejected, and the judgment of the Highway Commissioner was sustained and made final. At his own request Commissioner Hardaway was excused from participating in these deliberations and was not present when the final vote was taken.

On motion of Mr. Davis and upon the recommendation of the Highway Commissioner \$30,000 was allocated for the construction of that portion of Route 20 from Goodes Bridge for eight miles towards Richmond, and placed to the credit of "Other

State Work".

On motion of Mr. Hardaway the following resolution was unanimously adopted:

RESOLVED, That Wade H. Massie, Chairman and Henry P. Beck, Secretary, of this Commission be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into agreements in the name of and on behalf of this Commission, in the matter of the anticipation of funds for the construction of sections of The State Highway System, with the following:

and the following, the amounts to be designated by the Boards of Committees:

Town of Franklin (for the construction of the streets of the Town) 5

✓ Town of Lawrenceville (for the construction of a bridge) 1

Special Road Committee of the Citizens of Danville (for the construction of a short section of road next to the City limits) 9

Norfolk County (for the construction of Route 27). 2-7

At this juncture the Commission adjourned and proceeded by the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway to Williamsburg, where they took automobiles and proceeded over that portion of Route 9 between Springfield and Malstead Point, thence to Yorktown and Lee Hall, where the night was spent.

On Tuesday morning, June 15th, the Commission, Wade H. Massie, Chairman, Henry P. Beck, Secretary, P. W. Davis, and Horace Hardaway being present, proceeded from Lee Hall to Camp Hustis, where they were met by General Granthite, General Hagedorn, and Colonel Hibold, and this party proceeded to make an inspection of Camp Hustis and of the road by way of The Grove to Camp Wallace. At the Grove Mansion an informal meeting was held, which was participated in by the military officers and prominent citizens and property holders of the vicinity.

After this conference the Commission proceeded to Williamsburg, thence to Morge, Toona, Barboursville, New Kent, Seven Pines and Richmond.

On Wednesday morning, June 16th, the State Highway Commission, Wade H. Massie, Chairman, Henry P. Beck, Secretary, Horace Hardaway, and P. W. Davis, being in attendance, proceeded in automobiles from the office of the Highway Commissioner in the Lyric Building, with a committee of citizens of Henrico and Charles City Counties, over Route 9 by way of Charles Neck, Malvern Hill, Shirley and Vestover to Charles City C. H., where a meeting of the citizens of the County was held and the wishes of the County made known as to the final location of Route 9. This meeting adjourned, and the Commission proceeded to Providence Forge, thence to Roxbury and Richmond, where the Highway Commission resumed its session in the office of the Commissioner in the Lyric Building.

On motion of Mr. Howard the following resolution making additional allocations was adopted:

RESOLVED, That we approve the additional allocation as made by the Commissioner of the following amounts:

ROUTE 1 - Coleman's Store to Richmond City Limits \$75,000.

ROUTE 5 - Franklin-Gourtland, Project 20-A \$26,214.00

ROUTE 12 - In the matter of the road from Danville west, Project 3-48, it was decided to undertake this construction with Convict Labor, by force account, to the extent of the estimated cost, \$18,000.

ROUTE 14 - Danville-North Carolina line, Project 83, \$22,950.
Harvie's Store towards Lawyers, Project 70 \$20,000.

ROUTE 7 - The bid on the Front Royal-Riverton road was rejected.

The Commission declined to change the Route now located between Springfield and Holstead Point and Yorktown so as to pass through The Grove from Lee Hall to Williamsburg, and upon motion of Mr. Davis the informal application of the military authorities of Camp Hustis, backed by a number of the citizens of James City County, was rejected for the reason that the Commission was without authority to make this change unless expressly authorized so to do by the legislature.

On motion of Mr. Davis the following employees of the State Highway Department and the State Convict Road Force were designated by the Commission, under Section 4, Chapter 31 of the Acts of 1919, as special police officers:
