MEETING OF STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION SUSSEX, RICHMOND, VIRGINIA

JUNE 7,8, 1923

COMMISSION HELD JUNE 7th & 8th, 1923, AT SUBSEX AND RICHMOND, VIRGINIA.

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On the morning of June 7th, Commissioners Shirley, Massis, and Sanders not at Richmond, Virginia, and proceeded to Peters-burg where they inspected the Route leading from Petersburg to Stoney Creek to Sussex C.H. and on to the Southempton County Line and thence back to Sussex C.H. where theywere joined by Commissioners Truxtum and a public hearing given to all interested in the Route to be established from Southempton County Line to Petersburg, known as State Highest No. 5, now 35.

After a largely attended meeting held in the Court Rouse yard, Commissioners Massie, Shirley and Sanders imspected the road from near Homeville to Petersburg, returning to Richmond that night, Commissioner Truxtum returning to Norfolk.

On the morning of the 8th, Commissioners Shirley, Massie and Sanders held a business meeting at their office in Bichmond.

Moved by Mr. Massie, a seconded by Mr. Sanders, that the request of the Mayor of the Town of Halifax to return the \$50,000, advanced by the Citisens of Halifax, under the Hobertson Act for the construction of the Streets of Halifax, be granted and that the Chairman be authorized to return such funds. Notice carried.

Moved by Mr. Sanders, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the location of the Route between \$7 and \$3 be from Stranburg via Water-lick to Riverton. Motion carried.

Mili Bart He 18-P vil Waldey Co. 2 Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirisy, that if the Pittsburgh DesMoines Steel Company will pay the \$350.00 additional cost the State was put to due to their failure to enter into the contract for the commtruction of the Bridge over the Appointtox River, Project 215, Route 13, their name will be restored to our mailing list and their company put in good standing. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley that the recommendation of Mr. C. S. Mullen, Acting Commissioner, that the following employee be appointed traffic officers be accepted:

Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that contract for the construction of 4.4 miles of concrete road between Richmond and Machanicaville, Project F-247, Route 13, be awarded to C. S. Luck and Some, Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$169792.26 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$186,771.43 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that contract for the construction of 11.05 miles of concrete read between DiesBack Blait St. 663 att Tabley Co. cond Bridge and Providence Porge, Project F-157, Route 39, be awarded to Baker-Royer Company, Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$372,146.00, and that 10% additional be set seide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$409360.60 chargeable to this Project, provided the contractor will not start work on this contract until the plane have been approved by the Bursau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that all bids be rejected on Project 8-65-D, Route 13, Buffalo Creek-Yancy Hill, and that this work be immediately rendvertised. Motion carried,

Hoved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Project S-285, Route 20, Burkeville-Keys ville, be awarded to Perkins and Barnes, Blackstone, Virginia, at their bid of \$53,518.06, provided the route is not contested and a hearing demanded. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that all bids be rejected on Project F-227, Route 10. Bridge over Speen Creek near Crits, and that this Project be immediately readvertised. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that contract for the construction of Project S-196, Route 32, Bridges over Graig Creek, be awarded to the Roanoke Iron and Bridge Works.

Roanoke, Virginia, at their bid of \$22,904.44, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the opet of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$25,194.84 chargeable to this Project Motion carried.

Beck (See Mr. 16-7 mit Kinkley Co. Hoved by Mr. Thirley, seconded by Mr. Massia, that contract for the construction of Project P-166-D. Route 13, Mechanicaville towards Pamunkey River be awarded to Baker-Royer Company, Richmond Virginia, at their bid of \$245,741.55 and that 10% additional be set as ide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$270,315.70 chargeable to this Project, provided the contractor will not start work until the plane have been approved by the Bureau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Noved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the informal bid of Lasson Construction Company, on Project 271B, Route 11. Claypool Hill-Resedate, be rejected and that this contract be awarded to Soott and Trinkle at their informal bid of \$204,796.65, and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$225,276.31 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Mannie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the following permits be granted under the usual rules and regulations of the State Highway Commission:

To the Shemandean River Light and Power Corporation, to cross the Los Highway, one mile west of Luray with secondary wire corrying 110 volts.

To Mr. J. I. Wise, Middletown, Virginia, to string wires across State Highway No. 33 to his residence,

To the Petereburg Gas Company, Petereburg, Virginia to lay a 4% gas main under and along State Highway Roll 31,

To Mr. E. L. Sandridge, Croset, Virginia to place a pipe

Back Mari Jie. 16-2 ark Making Co. line under State Highway No. 39, at Omoset, Virginia.

To the Chesapeake & Potomao Telephone Company to reconstruct the pole line along State Highway No. 32, between Less burg and Oatland.

to the Chesapeake & Potomac Telephone Company to commtruct a two duct tile conduit under State Highway No. 30.

To the City of Charlottes ville to erect a pole line on State Highway No. 28 from the City limits to the city pump station.

To the Rosslyn Gas Company, Clarendon, Virginia, to lay two 2" gas pipes under State Highway Ec. 21.

To V. C. Hundy, Chatham, Virginia, to place a pipe line under State Highway No. 14, Fittsylvania County.

To Dr. J. C. King, Radford, Va. to place a water pipe across Radford Bridge State Highway No. 10. Motion carried.

Line, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days, and a public potice being given that objections to this location be filled in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21st, 1923, at 12:00 chalcok mean, and whereas, there were no objections filled, to the location so advertised, - It was moved by Mr. Massie, accorded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission hereby declares the routs so advertised to be an established State Highway between the points designated and to be known as Routs Fo. 40. Motion cerried,

Rysk Marie Me. 16-7 1918 Whillier Co. Whereas, the road leading from Charles City C.H. over what is known as the River or New Market Road, towards Richmond for approximately 18 miles; having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21st 1923, at 12:00 o'clock moon, and whereas, there were no objections filed, to the location so advertised - It was moved by Mr. Shirlay accorded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission hereby declares the Route so advertised to be an established State Highway between the points designated and to be known as Route So. 51. Notion carried.

Whereas, the road leading from Morven in Amelia County, to Boute 13 at or near Tobaccoville in Powhatan County, over what is known as County Roads 1 and 7 respectively, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21st, 1923, at 12:00 o'clock noon, and whereas, there were no objections filed, to the location so advertised, — It was moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission hereby declares the route so advertised to be an established State Highway between the points designated and to be known as Route Mo. 132. Motion carried.

Whereas, the road leading from Gross, south to the West Va. State Line, over what is known as County Road no. 14, Alleghany

Motion carried,

Thereas, the read leading from a point at or near Moocasin Gap, ever what is known as County Road No. 3, to the Tennessee State Line, in Scott County, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to the location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21, 1923, at 12:00 o'clock noon, and whereas, there were no objections filed to the location to advertised - It was moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission hereby declares the route to advertised to be an established State Righway between the points designated and to be known as Route No.102. Motion carried.

Whereas, the road leading from Poplar Hill to Dublin, over the most direct route, in Giles and Pulaski Counties, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21st, 1923, 12:00 o'clock noon, and whereas, there were no objections filed to the location so advertised. It was

Beck Mast Ho. 98-2 mit Thirtie Co. moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the Commission hereby declares the route so advertised to be an established State Righway between the points designated and to be known as Route Ro. 109. Motion carried.

Thereas, the road leading from Lessburg by way of Mamlin to Purcellville, over what is known as County Road No. 4, Loudoun County, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21st, 1923, at 12:00 o'clock noon, and whereas, there were no objections filed to the location so advertised, - It was moved by Mr. Shirley, escended by Mr. Massic, that the Commission hereby declares the route so advertised to be an established State Highway between the points designated and to be known as Route No. 325. Notion carried.

County Road Hell, for a distance of approximately 10.0 miles, Orange County, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice having been given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission on or before May 21,1923 at 12:00 clock noon, and whereas, there were no objections filed to the location so advertised - It was moved by Mr. Massie, accorded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission hereby declares the route so advertised to be an established State Highway between the points designated and to be known as Route No.374. Motion carried.

Seek Short Ht. 44.P cat. Shokke Cit. Whereas, the read leading from State Highway No.10 at Virginia Beach, north for a distance of approximately three and one-half miles towards Fort Story, in Princess Anne County, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Counts ion, on or before May 21, 1923, at 12:00 o'clock meen, and whereas, no objections were filed to the location so advertised - It was moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie that the Counts ion hereby declares the route so advertised to be an established State High—tay between the points designated and to be known as Route No.101, Motion carried.

Whereas, the road leading from Sum Tree to Contesville, over what is known as County Road No. 21, Hanover County, having been advertised in accordance with law for a period of thirty days and a public notice being given that objections to this location should be filed in writing in the office of the State Highway Commission, on or before May 21,1923, at 12:00 o'clock noon, and whereas, there were no objections filed to the location so advertised, It was nowed by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission here by declares the route so advertised to be an established State High way between the points designated and to be known as Reute No. 312 Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, accorded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission transfer \$40,000.00 advanced under the Roberts on Act for the commission of the George's Fork Road in Diskups on County to the Book Cheel Mr. 16-P . and Thirdley Co. Road from Clintwood C.K. to the Forks of the Coeburn-George's Fork Road, this money to be refunded to the Georgen Fork Road as soon as it is needed for its comstruction, as requested by the Board of Supervisors of Dickerson County who are advancing the \$40,000.00. Motion carried.

There being no further business before the Commission, the meeting adjourned.
