MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VINGINIA, HELD JUME SOUN, 1987, RICHHOND, VINGINIA.

The State Highway Commission of Virginia, consisting of Messre. E. G. Shirley, Comirmon, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul; I. Walks Truntum, and H. G. Gilmer, not at their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia, and the meeting was called to order by the Chairmon.

The minutes of the meeting held by the Commission May 17th, 18th, and 19th, were read and it was moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that they be approved. Motion carried.

ir. Berkeley D. Adams appeared before the Commission in regards to his claim for moving a house on Route 32 during the construction of
Project 1584. He stated that the house was located where the highway was to
be constructed and had been moved by him and that he would like for the Commission to reimburee him for the expense of moving same. He also requested
that the Commission oil Route 32 from the intersection of Route 12 as a bus
line had recently been placed over a section of read and the dust was very
bad.

At 10:00 o'elook the Commission reserved a delegation from Petersburg, Curson, Stony Creek, Jarrett, Sussex C.H. and Experie, and gave a public hearing on the location of State Highway No. 24 from Emperia north.

A delegation from Fermville headed by Mr. R. W. Sanford,
Mayor, also appeared before the Commission in regards to determining the
population of Fermville. They stated that recently Fermville had re-establinked its corporate limits, eliminating approximately 500 acres and 155
