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MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGH-WAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, MELD IN RICHMOND, VINGINIA, JUNE 20,1929.

Om the morning of June 20th, 1929, the State Eighway Commission, condisting of Messre, H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Made H. Massie, Secretary, and Bugh B. Sproul, met at their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutesof the meetings of the Commission held in Richmond, April 11th and in Abingdon, May 17th, 1929, he approved. Metion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massin, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the Commissioner be instructed to proceed with condemning of the right of way on Route 501 from Virginia Seach to the State Rifle Range but due to those and other delays as to building across the Reservation, that the contractor be allowed to withdraw his bid, or if he so desired to proceed at his unit prices after rights of way have been secured. Motion parried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission comfirm the award of contract for the construction of Project P-567-A, Route 20, Approaches to Bridge over Appearation River, to the lew bidder, Marye and Blankenship, Masswille, Virginia, at their bid of \$11,569.03, and that 10% additional be set uside to sover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$13,000.000 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the Complesion confirm the sward of contract for the construction of Project F-350-3C, Route 505, Approaches to A.C.L. Overhead at Marmey, to the low bidder, Marye and Blankson ship, Shawsville, Virginia, at their bid of 48,755.86, and that 105 additional be set saide to cover the cost of esgineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Meved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sprewl, that all bids be rejected on Project 5-259-DMF, Moute 14, Approaches to the Virginian Overhead Bridge and bridge over Staumton River, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullen, proceeding with this work with State Scree. Motion service.

Moved by Mr. Syroul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project 575, Route 31, .702 Wiles North of North Corporate Limits of Richmond to the North Corporate Limits of Richmond, to the lew bidder, G. T. Carpenter, Chester, Virginia, at Mr. bid of \$16,504.20 and that log additional be set saids to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$19,000.00 charge-able to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F-568-A, Route 23, 5.356 Miles South of Blackeburg to Blackeburg, to the low bidder, Powell Paving Company, Winston-Sales, H.C. at their bid of \$118,880.80, and that 10% additional be set aside to sover the cost of angineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$131,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the Cummission reject all bids on Project F-589-AB, Route 33, Bridge over Cedar Greek near Strasburg as being tee high and that this work be readvertised. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contrast for the construction of Project 5-63, Boute 14, Danville - North Carolina Line, to the low bidder, McGuire and Relfe, Inc, Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of 669,111.30, and that 10% additional be est aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$1,000.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$77,000.00 shargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Cammission confirm the sward of contrast for the construction of Fraject 8-579-AB, Route 37, Bridge over Pope Grock at Potomac Mills, to the low bidder, J. M. Gawherd, Gordonsville, Virginia, at his bid of \$16,485.74 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$500.00 for detours, \$1163.69 for Guard Rail and \$2246.00 for Surface Treatment, making a total of approximately \$23,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion capried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massis, that the Commission confirm the everd of contract for the construction of Project F-527-40D, Moute 14, Bannister River to Chatham, to the low bidder Hayman Construction Company, Chatham, Firginia, at their bid of \$79,875.69 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$2000.00 for detour, making a total of approximately \$90,000.00 shargeable to this project, with the understanding that the State will have a right to cut off ene-half mile south of Chatham if rights of way cannot be secured and that the contractor gives assurance they can do this class of work. Motion carried.

Maved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that all bids be rejected on Project 8-576-A, Route 21, Cherrydale - Halls Hill, and that the work be readvertised. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Skirley, that the contract for the construction of Project 596-B, Route 39, Bridge over Whisky Greek, be an extract to the low hidder, T.J.Haymes, Sales, Virginia, at his bid of \$8,019.75, and that 10% additional be set aside to sover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$9000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that all bids be rejected on Project 581-A, Route 37, Berryville-Gaylord, as being too high and that this work be readvertised. Motion carrieds

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of Project 497-ADI, Route 10, West of Radford-New River, be awarded to the low bidder on regular bid, The Southern Asphelt Company, Richmond, Virginia, at their bid of \$4,108.75, setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$5.000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massic, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Project 602, Route 103, Wallens Greek-Tennessee Line, be awarded to the low bidder, M. T. McArthur, Johnson City, Tennessee, at his bid of \$36,300.00 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of enginsering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$40,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of Project 489-RE, Route 116, Approaches to Overhead at Sumbright, be swarded to the low bidder, Brown H. Criser, Appalachia, Virginia, at his bid of 46,730.20 and that 10% additional be set aside to sover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Messie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that all bids be rejected on Project 3-523-1881, South of Yerktown - South, and that some be readvertised. Motion carried.

A delegation consisting of Judge Martin Williams, Mr. M. S. Pefferberger, Mr. Young and others, came before the Commission in regard to the proposed toll bridge on Houte 23 at Glan Lyn and requested that the Commission ecoperate with them and five consideration to the fallowing:

- First Ten year period to date from completion of bridges for the operation of the bridges as tell bridges before the State would take them over.
- Second That the State request Congressional action on paralit for bridge over New River.
- Third That the State deal with the Virginian Reilway Company in regard to paying one-half of the cost of the overhead or undergrade crassing of their tracks.
- rourth- That the State take the road over upon its completion, except bridges, and the immediate approaches thereto.

It was requested that the Commission include as such of the read as possible as the approach to the bridges inamuch as the bridge company would sometrust a standard hard surface road for a distance over three miles leading up to the bridges and turn it over to the State free of cost.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the fellowing permit be granted to Mr. Mathan S. Poffenburgers

ik Sheet No. 25-P : Wadday Co. "Application having been made to the State Highway Commission, under Chapter 273, Asts of 1928, by Mathan S. Poffenburger, President, 1013 Kanswa Mational Bank Building, Charleston, West Virginia, to construct and operate toll bridges across New and Eget Rivers near Clem Lym in Giles County, Virginia:

The State Highway Commission hereby grants purmission to emid Mr.Poffenbarger to erect and operate such bridges at the points named, work to be gun within six months from the operate of permit and to be completed within twelve months from time the construction starts, under the following conditions:

- 1. That after a period of ten years from completion of bridges, the State Highway Commission reserves the right to take same over as provided by Chapter 273, Actsef 1928, paying only the cost of the two bridges and approaches as as shown on plans, but no portion of the three and a fraction miles of high-way:
- 2. That Mr. Poffenbarger will construct of hard surface Route 23 beginning at Rich Creek and extending via Olen Lyn to the West Virginia Line at his own expense under plans and specifications of the State Highway Commissions
- 3. That the State Highway Commission will take over upon its completion the road so constructed, except bridges, for maintenance.

All work done under this Permit must be in strict accord with its conditions and approvided under Chapter 273. Acts of 1928*

Motion cerried.

Mr. Hiden, his brother and Mr. Little, appeared before the Commission and requested the Commission to take into the State Highway System a short static of read of about one mile in Mansamond County leading to the bridges recently constructed, extension Houte 503. This mile of read would shorten the distance considerably as it outs straight across instead of winding around as at present. They stated that the Ben's Church out-off took from 90% to 95% of the traffic from Petersburg to Suffolk off of Route 10.

Mr. S. M. Hust, Mr. E. M. Rust, of the Rust Engineering Company, Mr. E. M. Hastings and Mr. Mordecai of the R.F.&P.R.R. and Mr. E. O. Fippin of the State Conservation and Development Commission, appeared before the Commission in regard to the spur track placed across Boute 31 between Washington and Alexandria under Fermit #2185, which had never been used, and also made application for another permit to cross Boute 31 at Occoquan Station (Woodbridge Post Office with a similar track for use in connection with a brick plant to be erected there.

It was stated that the spur between Washington and Alexandria had never been used due to their imbility to complete negotiations for a brick yard but that now everything was in shape and they wasted to proceed with their operations. They stated that at most there would not be more than two movements across the highway and they would be after midnight and before six in the moreing when traffic on this highway was at a minimum. They also stated that after

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massis, that \$180.00 liquidated demages on Project 366-MK, Route 10, Approaches to Underpase at Poole, be returned to the contractor, J. A. Marrow Construction Company, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, ecconded by Mr. Massie, that the total amount of the claim of R. L. Lipsconb and Company, on Route 112, Project 464-GD, Taxewell-North Taxewell, amounting to \$4647.89 be returned to the contractor, as per recommunication of Chief Engineer Mullen. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the offer of C. A. Ragland to reduce his price of overhaul on gravel for Project 566,AB2, Houte 12, West of Lawrenceville, be rejected. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, ecconded by Mr. Massie, that the work on Route 36, Project 534-G, between Chambersville and Winchester, be continued accutioned in latter of May 20th, 1929 from Chief Engineer Mullen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that Soute 12, Project 429-4, be completed from Courtland to Emporia, putting in a free labor force to supplement convict labor. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the following transfer of funds in the Bristol District be made:

\$34,200.00 left from the General Allocation of \$587,000.00 be applied to the overhead crossing at Sunbright and widening the two wooden trestles of the Southern Railroad;

From the \$140,000.00 on Boute 11, Lebanon-Dickensonville, transfer \$6,000.00 to Route 212 through Hayel and \$6,000.00 to Moute 11 to replace bridges west of Morton and Powell Rivers:

The \$43,000.00 on Route 10 at Gate City, be transferred to the same Route to surface Brishel - West.

Motion carried.

Meved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Mansie, that the location of Soute 16 be from a point approximately two miles east of the East Corporate

Limits of Bristol in Washington County, over what is known as Euclid Avenue through Lee Beights into Bristol, as provided for under Chapter 123, Acts of 1926, approved March 9th. Motion carried.
