

{ Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, June 10, 1932.

On the morning of June 10, 1932, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, I. W. Truxton, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of April 14th, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the State Highway Commission approve of the Forestry Division taking over the following roads for maintenance in the Fort Valley region of the Shenandoah National Forest-

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Bath County Board of Supervisors be advised that it will be satisfactory for the county to proceed with the work on the Millboro Station Road leading from State Highway Route 17, at Asa Wright's Service Station to Millboro Station, after July first. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. East, that the sick leave of Mr. J. O. McGuffin be extended one month with pay. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the location of Route 44 from Daryville towards South Boston, be along the first survey, as shown in red on the plans. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the location of Route 28 from Charlottesville-North, follow the original survey, known as the straight line. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the following permits be approved under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to install 3-wire service crossover on Route 10 at a point approximately 3/4 mile north of Dixie Caverns

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Bluefield, West Va., to erect a 6.9 KV local distribution power line along the highway No. 10 in Wythe County.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Bluefield, West Va., to erect a 6.9 KV local distribution power line across Route 10 in Smyth County.

R. B. Ash, Jr., Woodstock, Va., to construct entrance to service station on Route 33 in Shenandoah County. The ditch in front of property to be bridged and the bridges not to cut down water area in ditch.

City of Danville, Va., to install eight and four inch gas mains on Route 14, extension of North Main Street, on Route 14.

Julian Dickerson, Floyd, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Route 25, 3 miles north of Floyd C. H.

H. E. Dugman, Hollins, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 35 between Cloverdale and Roanoke.

East Coast Telephones, Inc., Warrenton, Va., to move 7 poles from south to north side of Route 607, between Callao and Lottsburg.

West Tennessee Light & Power Co., Bristol, Tenn., to move 15 poles of the Three Springs Telephone Co. between Sta. 148 and Sta. 170, from the north to the south side of Route 10, also one pole near Sta. 123 from the south to the north side of highway, set one pole at about Sta. 117.

J. T. Grimes, Smithfield, Va., to construct double driveway to filling station on Route 10, 1/4 mile east of Smithfield.

Ernest Pettington, Elkton, Va., to build entrances to filling station on Route 17, two miles west of Elkton.

J. H. Phelps Water Co., Roanoke, Va., to install iron valve case on gate valve at edge of 30' one course macadam, Route 55, Roanoke County.

J. D. Posey, Portsmouth, Va., to lay 100 lin. ft. of 1" pipe in ditch line and construct entrance to filling station on Route 40.

G. W. Lewis, Franklin, Va., to grade entrance to filling station and install 72' of 6" pipe on Route 52 in Winister.

Roanoke County School Board, Salem, Va., to drive 60' of 2" Galvanized water line under 30' one course macadam road on Route 33.

Roselyn Gas Company, Clarendon, Va., to lay 3/4" gas service pipe into the home of Chas. Crerer, on Route 711.

Roselyn Gas Co., Clarendon, Va., to install 3/4" gas service pipe to the property of M. E. Bitting, 509 Glebe Road, on Route 26.

Roselyn Gas Company, Clarendon, Va., to install 3/4" gas service pipe into the property of C. D. Palmer on Glebe Road, between Alleova and Brookdale Ave., Alleova Heights, Va., on Route 26.

J. C. Stinson, Fairfax, Va., to move truck fleet from Fairfax to Washington, Saturday, the 4th inst., 10 A. M. Size of the fleet to be 10 feet wide and 15 feet long, same being built on a 1-½ ton Chevrolet truck, and to be used for the Daughters of Justice. Route 21.

J. T. Stinson, Barren Springs, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Routes 10 and 813, at intersection of the two routes.

U. S. Bureau of Fisheries, Wytheville, Va., to cross the State highway with one power line (6900 volts), 3 wires and 1 guy. Route 114 in Wythe County.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Norfolk, Va., to construct single phase 1,5 KV pole line between 146th St. and 158th St., on Route 500 near Cape Henry.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Petersburg, Va., to do work as shown on blue print. No poles to be farther than 2 feet from right of way line. Your Company to be held responsible for any accident that may be caused by doing this work. No trees to be uprooted in any way. No wires to be closer than 18' to crown of the road at their maximum sag. Route 51 in Chesterfield County.

V. P. I., Blacksburg, Va., to extend 2800v power line along Route 209; to erect 17 poles and 1 service crossing.

Virginia Public Service Co., Warrenton, Va., to install one 2M. 2800v #6 copper primary crossing over Route 709, between Ocoquan Creek and Manassas.

Virginia Public Service Company, Alexandria, Va., to install 3 guy wire crossings over Route 51 opposite substation at Fort Humphreys.

Virginia Public Service Co., Clarendon, Va., to install one 2-wire road crossing over Lee Highway at intersection of Greenway Blvd., Greenway Downs, approximately one-quarter mile west of Falls Church, Va.

F. B. Webster, Amherst, Va., to construct an approach to a proposed filling station; no drainage required. Route 15 in Amherst County.

F. H. Wilhelm & Son, Goshen, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Route 805 about 0.2 mile south of Goshen, and extend drain pipe.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that permit #11869, issued the Town of Falls Church, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that gates across the road over Lantz Mountain may be maintained until in the opinion of the Commission public convenience and necessity demand they be removed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that a permit be granted the Standard Oil Company, to lay a 6" water line and an 8" sewer from city limits of Richmond, on Route 39, easterly for 170 feet to the company's property. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that permit #8147, Henry County, issued the City of Martinsville, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that permit #11175, Prince George County, issued the Virginia Electric and Power Company, Petersburg, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Streets of Williamsburg be taken over for maintenance under the regular maintenance agreement as follows -

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Nichols, that it is felt not advisable, due to curtailment of funds, to have an exhibit at the Virginia State Fair this year. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that if the Commission cannot collect from the Great National Insurance Company the amount of damages assessed Mr. M. B. Hoyt, involving accident with Mr. Charles Goldberger, that Mr. Hoyt be not reimbursed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxton, that the petition with reference to relocation of Route 55, Lexington-Natural Bridge and Natural Bridge-Fancy Hill, be denied and work be started at once on this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Mr. J. V. Clarke and Mr. H. H. Holmes, Resident Engineers, be appointed Traffic Officers. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Chairman notify Mr. Rawls that the Commission desires a 50 ft. right of way on Route 12 between Franklin and Courtland. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that Route 525, Intersection of Route 34 near Bayview towards Kiptopeke, be extended 1.3 miles. Yeas - Messrs. Truxton, Gilmer and Massie; Nays - Messrs. East and Shirley. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Chairman of the Commission having certified that public safety and convenience require the elimination of the grade crossing of the Washington and Old Dominion Railway on Route 711, across Four Mile Run Valley, by the construction of an overhead bridge; that the total cost of the work will be \$22,700.00, of which \$15,250.00 is to be paid by the Railway Company and the balance by the State, and that after careful consideration of the Chairman's report and the traveling public's safety, do order that this work be done and the Washington and Old Dominion Railway Company be notified to proceed therewith. All in accordance with Chapter 215, Acts of 1928. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that whereas public notice has been given and no objections have been filed to the relocation of State Highway Route 10, between Moccasin Gap and Hilton Station, by placing the same to the south side of the Southern Railway Company's tracks, thereby eliminating for state highway traffic -

Crossing No. 1 just east of R. R. Mile Post 41,

Crossing No. 2 just west of R. R. Mile Post 41,

Crossing No. 3 west of R. R. Mile Post 42,

it is deemed that public safety and convenience require that these crossings be closed and it is so ordered. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the location of Route 318, from near Green Bay northerly towards Route 10 be via the ridge route. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for improving Route 10, be carried as far as it follows the present right of way and be cut off where the proposed relocation begins, on Project 562. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxton, seconded by Mr. East, that the following distribution of the last half of the Porter-Rhodes mileage be made -
