

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, June 21, 1933.

On the morning of June 21st, 1933, the State Highway Commission,
consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer,
and Wm. H. East, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Va.

The meeting was called to order by the chairman.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of the
Alley Construction Company for an extension of time on Project 744 B2, Route
50, Bridge over Pigg River, be granted and the \$140.00 liquidated damages
returned, as per recommendation of the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the request of
Hall and Mitchell for an extension of time on Project 2761B, Route 615, 0.2
Mi. S. Front Royal-1.1 Mi. S. Front Royal, be granted for 15 days, as recom-
mended by the Chief Engineer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the request of the
K. J. Grove Lime Company for an extension of time on Project F575 B2, Route
33, Bridge over Opequon Creek, be granted for 9 days, as per recommendation of

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Bridge over Hickory Creek, Route 19, Project 5680 31, to the low bidder, F. M. Arthur, South Boston, Va., at his bid of \$4,827.50 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$5,300.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that Mr. S. J. Mahaffey, Resident Engineer, be appointed a traffic officer. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the sick leave of Colonel T. R. Marshall be extended two additional weeks, taking him through May 21st. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that whereas the 50 ft. right of way, which has been secured on Route 215, Project 675C, in Page County, as shown on sheets 3, 4, and 5 of plans for the above project, is sufficient for road purposes, and whereas, it appears that no part of the old road lying outside of said right of way from Station 612/00 to Station 615/00, from Station 620/00 to Station 627/00, from Station 631/00 to Station 648/00, from Station 648/50 to Station 655/50, from Station 664/00 to Station 672/00 and from Station 673/00 to Station 674/52.2 + Station 676/44, will be embraced in the primary state highway system, said portion of the old road lying outside of said right of way between the above stations is hereby abandoned as a part of said system. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the work on Route 215, Pearisburg to Dublin, start at the Pearisburg end. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission approve of the erection of a traffic light at the intersection of Routes 25 and 31 in Arlington County, the light to be timed to give the open period on Route 31 twice as long as the open period on Route 25. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that as the plans for the construction of the bridge across Peak Creek in Pulaski have been approved by the Commissioner, that an additional \$500.00 per mile for highways approved within the city be granted for this work. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that if sufficient funds are left in last year's allocation to Roanoke County's secondary system, the amount the county spent on the roads after July first, 1952, previous to the State Highway Commission taking them over, be reimbursed to the county. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the effort to collect \$18,40 damages to guard rail on Route 31 in Dimmick County be dropped, as every effort has been made to collect without result. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the section of road leading to Grays Point in Middlesex County, be added to the secondary system. Motion carried.

Mr. Allan Jones, Mr. Raymond Bottom and Mr. John Ballard appeared before the Commission and requested a renewal of permit to the York River Bridge Corporation for the erection of the proposed bridge over the York River at Yorktown.

Mr. Channing Ward, Mr. Gramp and Mr. Schuyler also appeared and requested that permit issued to the Independence Bridge Company for the construction of the same bridge, be renewed.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that 500 ft. of road in the Suffolk District, leading to ferry slip at Harberton, be added to the system under the 2½ Clause; this mileage to be taken from the belt line around Norfolk. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission request the Executive Secretary of the American Association of State Highway Officials to carry U. S. Route 58 via Pennington Gap. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Court award of \$500.00 for material taken from the property of Mr. W. Archie Thompson, Tazewell County, be paid. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that a twelve months lease, with the right of renewal, be given to the Eastern Shore Ferry Corporation to use so much of the public landing at foot of county highway No. 207 in Middlesex County, not exceeding 75 ft., for the convenient and necessary use of the steamers. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that a permit under the form and conditions specified heretofore, be granted to any corporation, individual or company that within ninety days can secure proper financing of the York River Bridge. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of the Board of Supervisors of Augusta County, to add to the secondary system the road beginning at a point on C-4 about 0.6 mile south of intersection of C-16 and C-4 and 0.6 mile east of Crimora, thence easterly to C-15 one mile east of its intersection with C-208A, be approved, provided fences are moved back to provide a 50 ft. right of way. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that \$500.00 per mile additional for the 5.55 miles of approved state highways in the City of Harrisonburg, be granted the city for work as submitted in letter of June 19th. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the request of the Board of Supervisors of Appomattox County to add to the secondary system 2.0 miles of road from State Route 306 at Rose Bower to C-245, be disapproved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the request of the Board of Supervisors of Bedford County to make certain additions to the secondary system, be disapproved as follows-

Two ends to private road, with gate between points requested to be taken over; sections being between C-152 and C-208A.

From C-108 to C-5, 1.4 miles,
From C-18 to Big Otter River, 1.2 miles,
Extension of C-264A, 0.7 miles.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the request of the Board of Supervisors of Chesterfield County to extend C-257 from end of present road westerly 0.1 miles, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the request of the Board of Supervisors of Charles City County to make certain additions to the secondary system, be acted on as follows:

Addition of new road from point near Clarkton Bridge, northeast to intersection of C-22, a distance of 2.8 miles.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the requests of the Board of Supervisors of Fauquier County to add certain roads to the secondary system, be approved as follows:
