## STRUTES OF THE MERCING OF THE STATE BIONWAY COMMISSION, HELD AT RICEMOND, VINCINIA, JULY 9, 1925.

On the merging of July 9th, 1925, the State Highway Councission consisting of Mesers. H. O. Shirley, Chairman, T. Walke Tructue, and i. J. Haff, not at their effice SiA State Office Suilding, Sichmond, Virginia, and the meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

The minutes of the meeting held May 25th and 26th, 1925, at Richmond, were then read and it was moved by Mr. Truxtum, ecconded by Mr. Ruff, that they be approved. Motion curried.

Mr. 7. D. Bolton of Clifton Forge, Virginia, then appeared before the Commission in regards to Moste 142. Finoustle-Eagle Book to Clifton forge. He manted to know if there was not some way possible for the construction of this bighway, either under the Robertson Act or by anaspropriation by the Commission. He stated that this was a very important road, corrying through traffic from the morth and wast going south via Rosnoke. He also stated that during last winter this road was in very bad condition. They had a bus line running over it but during the winter they were compelled to discontinue it. The worst section was between Finoustle and Bismons Ridge. Mr. Bolton was told that all the Robertson Act money for the years 1925 and 1926 had been taken up and also the allocations for 1925 had been made.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the action of rejecting all bids on Project 3554, Houte 23, Pearisburg-2.85 Miles west and readvertising same, be confirmed. Motion carried. Minute Book Short No. 99-7 Mapager Wadday Co. Moved by Mr. Haff, seconded by Mr. Trustum, that the action of rejecting all bids on Project F-402, Route 37, 1.5 Miles West of White Stone Church to 3.0 Miles East of Kilmarnock and doing the work with the State's our force, be confirmed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Haff, that the smard of the contract to the low bidder, Spotsylvania Construction Company, be confirmed as follows:

Route 12, Project 397, 1.013 Miles 18° somerate road, at their bid of \$28,285.90, setting axide 10% additional for contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$31,114.49, taking advantage of the epocial provision in the contract and extending this work at their unit prices for the amount of the allocation:

Route 31, Project 398A, Section 1, 2.311 Miles concrete, 18' rectary, at their \$14 of \$66,021.95, setting anide 10% additional for contingencies and engineering and \$2,000.00 for datours, meking a total of \$74,624.14:

Reute 31, Project 296A, Section 2, .34 Miles 39' concrete read at their bid of \$25,752.80, setting maids 10% additional to cover the most of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$28,328.08:

These contracts being awarded subject to the approval of the plans by the Bureau of Public Roads. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Shirley, assembed by Mr. Truxtum, that all bids be rejected for the construction of Route 114, Project 190A, 1.574 Miles 18' comcrate road, Gesburn towards Grapes Host Commissary, and the work to be done on a force account basis. Notion carried. 7-9-25 120.

Minte Book Steen No. 57-P Treatt Walkey Co. Hoved by Mr. Buff, seconded by Mr. Truztum, that the contract for the construction of .057 Miles 18' concrete road, Rouse 11, Project F344A, be awarded to the low bidder, Joskins Construction Company, Morton, Virginia, at their bid of \$43,525.16 and that 10% additional be not aside to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$47,877.67 shargeable to this Project, subject to the approval of the plane by the Bureau fof Public Roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, accorded by Mr. Buff, that the contract for the construction of Scate 23, Project F355A, Possisburg-West, to awarded to the low bidder, M. C. Miller & Company, Harrisburg, Pa, at their unit prices to the amount of \$40,000.00, setting aside \$10,000.00 additional for rights of way and other purposes and that the contract to not signed until all rights of may have been accord. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the contract for the construction of 1.913 miles of 15' concrete road, Route 31, Project 3798, South of Ritchies Store-South, be awarded to the low hidder, Southern Construction Company, Petersburg, Virginia, at their hid of \$45,854.00 and that 10% additional be set saide to cover the cost of contingencies and engineering, making a total of \$50,439.40 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Trustum, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the request of Mr. E. G. Shields, for permission to allow the overhang of his filling Station on Route 31 to remain, be refused as it is the policy of the Commission not to allow such entrophysics. Motion carried.

First: that a cartified about for \$2,000.00 be placed in the bands of the State Highway Commission as a guarantee that the read will be put in good condition after the laying of the pipe, came to be returned whenvert is approved by the District Engineer,

Second: that the pipe line shall be leid, on the suffaced sections of the rooms, at least six feet from the edge of the surface and the curth to be thrown many from the surface on the opposite side of the pipe line.

Third: that on the earth sections, the pipe line to be laid between the gutter and the property line and the earth to be threen towards the property line and not in the highway.

Moved by Mr. Ruff, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that an extension of time be granted John T. McKinney, on Project 1341, Scate 14, Lawyers Read-Scuth to February 1, 1925, charging liquidated damages after that date. Motion carriedl

Moved by Mr. Ruff, assembled by Mr. Shirley, that an extension of time be granted Roberts Contracting Company, on Project 118A, Route 33, South of Roamake, to April 1,1925, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullen. 7-9-25. 125.

Notion carried.

Ministratus Maria Ka. 45-P Resent Welley Co. Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Haff, that an extension of time be granted Allport Construction Company, on Project 146A, Route 10, Christiansburg-Radford, to natual date of completion, May 6, 1925, with no possibles, as per recommendation of Oniof Engineer Mullen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Huff, that an extension of time be granted the Walton Construction Company, on Project 1324, Route 10, Kumin-Biliston, to the actual data of completion, Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, accorded by Mr. Suff, that the following menbe appointed special traffic officers.

S. C. Cles, Mintenance Forente, Front Régal, Va. H. A. Lester, Resident Engineer, Danville, Virginia. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Tractum, that the request to nowe the highway leading from Bluefield, West Virginia, via Glenlyn, Parrows, Pearleberg, Dublin, Pulsaki and on South, The Coal to Cotton Highway? to tabled until after the Committee appointed by the Secretary of Agriculture to designate certain interstate and transcentinental highways has reported. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Town of Chilberts be notified that the Commission will lay the pipe and fill the open ditch along Route 10, if the Town will furnish the pipe, or if they prefer the Commission will construct a guard rail along this section. Motion carried.

The Commission them recessed for lunch.

Carpenter-Major Brothers of Clifton Forge, Virginia, appeared before the Commission in regards to their claim on Project 65-D, Route 33, Buffala 1-9-25.

Misste Buit Spac No. 20-P Provid Walkley Co. Creek-Fausy Hill. They stated that in their opinion the time limit given was too short in the first place and they were also tied up on rights of may which caused them to run into the minter months. They stated that every effort was made to complete this contract, two miles of it having been sublet to another contractor in trying to push it through but that after this sub-contractor failed it was necessary for them to take this work over. They claimed that on this contract they lost between twelve and fourteen thousand dellars and requested the Commission to allow them as much of this as possible.

Mesers. Oast, Devrice, and Sullivan than appeared before the Commission in regards to the claim of the Management Brick Corporation for desurrage on bergen sensed by the minking of a barge in the borth at the gravel pit of Mr. Devrice. The whole question revolved into whe was responsible for the minking of the barge. Mr. Shirley advised these gentlemen to try and come to some compromise and if some could not be reached, he would place the money in the hands of the court to be settled by legal action.

Moved by Mr. Buff, seconded by Mr. Truxtum, that Corporator-Major Brothers be notified that the Commission, after thoroughly considering the matter of their claim on Project 65-D, felt that the settlement previously offered was fair and just and that they bereby confirm same. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Virginia State Chamber of Commune be allowed to send out copies of the Virginia State Highway Map, the legend to be the same with the additional words "Courteey of the Virginia State Chamber of Commerce". Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Tractum, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the Chairman proceed immediately to condemn the property for new location of Houte 12, Courtland West, in view of the statement of General C. C. Yaughan, Jr. and associates that T-9-25. 127.

Moute Back Shop Fe, 95-7 Doubt Wolder Co. the cost of acquiring those rights of way will be borne by the citizens. Mo-

Moved by Mr. Tructum, seconded by Mr. Haff, that the recommendation of Mr. C. S. Mallen, Chief Engineer, for the increase in select of certain employees be approved, provided same can be baken care of in the Budget. Motion carried.

There being no further business, It was moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Huff, that the meeting adjourn, subject to the call of the Chairman. Motion carried.
