MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE
HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, HELD
HARRISONBURG, VIRGINIA, JULY 18, 1928.

The State Highway Commission consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Hugh B. Sproul, and Wade H. Massie, held a business meeting in Harrisonburg, Virginia, on July 18th, 1928.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner and the following business transacted.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Cherrystone Creek, Route 14, Project S-527-B, be awarded to the low bidder, Haynes Construction Company, Chatham, Virginia, at their bid of \$6,018.10, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Hughes River near Peola Mills, Route 16, Project S-206-B, be awarded to the low bidder, T. A. Loving and Company, Goldsboro, North Carolina, at their bid of \$13,311.80 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$15,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of .164 Mile soil and Sand-clay road, Route 20, Project S-323-GF, East of Phoenix, be awarded to the low bidder, J. Ira Hicks and Bros. Evington, Virginia, at their bid of \$7,310.90, setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$500.00 for detours, and \$40.00 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$9,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of 3.47 Miles 18' bituminous macadam, Newport South to Shenandoah River, Route 251, Project S-422, be awarded to the low bidder, Pendleton Construction Company, Inc. Wytheville, Virginia, at their bid of \$46,560.00, setting aside 10% additional to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$52,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of 1.207 Miles 18' bituminous macadam, Route 105, Project 464-CDEB-2, be awarded to the low bidder, Rosenbaum Brothers, Inc. Parkersburg, West Virginia, at their bid of \$34,420.47, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$38,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Staunton River at Altavista, Route 14, Project F-259-B3, be awarded to the low bidder, T. A. Loving and Company, Goldsboro, North Carolina, at their bid of \$61,530.09, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$68,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over the Virginian Railroad at Altavista, Route 14, Project F-259-B4, be awarded to the low bidder, T. A. Loving and Company, Goldsboro, North Carolina, at their bid of \$38,681.52 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$43,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Robertson River, Route 16, Project 8206B1, be awarded to the low bidder, N. H. Clark, Blacksburg, Virginia, at his bid of \$14,175.87, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$16,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Chairman be authorized to investigate and see what can be worked out in regard to a quarry on what is known as the Netherwood Farm in Chesterfield County and report back to the Commission as to the availability of railroads and the cost of installing a quarry and also whether a portion of the farm can be purchased. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the Clarke County Horse and Colt Show Association of Berryville, Virginia, be granted a permit to hang banners across the various highways entering Berryville for two weeks before the show, advertising same, but at no other points. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the Commission award the contract for lubricating oil for the Eight Construction Districts to the low bidder, Harwood Brothers, Inc., at their prices submitted July 12, 1928. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award the contract for gasoline to the low bidder in the Lynchburg District, Power Oil Company, Lynchburg, Virginia, at their bid of .1974 per gallon as submitted July 12, 1928, and to the low bidder, Standard Oil Company, at their bid of 20¢ per gallon for the other seven districts. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Chairman.
