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MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA HELD AT RICHMOND, VIRGINIA, JULY 31, 1930.

On the morning of July 31st, 1930, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messre. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Wade H. Massie, Searstary, I. Walke Truntum, H. G.Gilmer, and Wm. H. Erst, held a business meeting at Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

The minutes of the meeting held in Chincoteague, Virginia, on July 1st, 1930, were read and it was moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Massle, that they be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the Bridge over Chappawamsic Greek, Route 31, Project \$7981, to the low bidder, Cobb and Homewood, Chapel Hill, N.C., at their bid of \$5,674.00 and that 10% additional be set saids to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$300.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this project. Notion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, esconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm the weard of contract, for the Bridge over Chappassnaic Creek, Route 31, Project 87982, to the low bidder, Cobb and Homewood, Chapel Hill, N.C., at their bid of \$6225.40 and that 10% additional be set a side to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$300.00 for detours, making a total of approximately \$8,000 chargeable to this project. Motion carried,

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the Bridge over Mattapani River at Wast Point, consisting of repairs to Fender System, Route 30, Project 3554Bl, to the low bidder, J. S. Bowers, Whiteville, N.C., at his bid of \$3109.50 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$4,000 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Truxtum, that the Commission confirm the award of contract on Route 26, Project 8598A, 6.9 Miles North of N.C.L. of Independence, to the low bidder, Jim Frank, Clinchport, Virginia, at his bid of \$16,993.26 and that 10% additional be set maids to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$19,000 chargeable to this project. Moved by Mr. Massie, assended by Mr.Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for Bridge over Merwick Summp, Route 52, Project S626B2, to the low bidder, Cobb and Homewood, Inc., Chapel Hill, N.C., at their bid of \$10,761.35 and that 10% additional be set aside to

Hoved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Bast, that the Commission confirm the award of contract on Route 315, Project 8628AD-B, 0.24 Mile Bast of W.C.L. of Stanley to Newport, to the low bidder R. W.Moore & Company, Staunton, Virginia, at their bid of \$111,768.34, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$500.00 for detours, \$4,762.45 for guard rail and \$11,849.20 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$140,000 chargeable to this project. Notion carried.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Project \$435A-1 and Project \$537A-B, Routes 23 and 216, respectively, 0.68 Mile No. of Marrows-Rich Creek to West Virginia Line, be awarded to the low bidder, M. T. McArthur, Johnson City, Tennessee, at his bid of \$64,532.66 and that 10% additional be set maide to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$2,648.36 for guard rail and \$9,124.60 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$83,000.00 chargeable to this project. Moved by Mr. Truxtum, asconded by Mr. Shirley, that permit #8526, issued to E. E. Shade, Winchester, Virginia, to lay a 6" sewer line, across Route 33, be cancelled. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Mast, that request of the Peninsula Transit Corporation to erect signs at Bus Terminal, be denied. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr.Gilmer, that the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, Petersburg Telephone Company, Postal Telegraph Company and Virginia Ricotric and Power Company, he requested to move back their poles on Route 31, between Bellwood and City Limits of Petersburg, adjacent to the property lines, and he allowed six months time in which to move back. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, accorded by Mr. Gilmer, that the request of the Virginia Electric and Power Company, Frederickeburg, Virginia, to creat one line processing, one head guy propering, and seventeen poles along the north edge of the State Right of May, overhanging came, be refused due to the narrowness of the right of way. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Truxtum, that Permit #6923, issued to Eanes and Company, 1305 Yest Main Street, Richmond, Virginia, June 4th, 1929, be cancelled as the work has never been done. Motion carried.
