

**Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway Commission  
of Virginia, Held in the Court House at Fincastle,  
and Court House at Staunton, July 18, 1933.**

The State Highway Commission of Virginia, consisting of Messrs. K. G. Shirley, Wade K. Masie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer and Wm. E. East, proceeded to Fincastle on the morning of July 18th, where they held a meeting at nine o'clock, to hear protests to the elimination of the grade crossing of the C & O Railroad and bridge across the James River, at Eagle Hook, on Route 17. All those who wished to be heard were given an opportunity and the Commission thoroughly considered the whole project.

After this the meeting adjourned and the Commission proceeded to Staunton, Virginia, by motor, where a meeting was held in the Court House at three o'clock, to hear those protesting the closing of certain crossings over the C & O Railroad on the old road between Craigsville and Goshen, Route 17. After all had been given an opportunity to express their views the Commission held a special called meeting and conducted the following business.

Moved by Mr. Masie, seconded by Mr. East, that permits #5661 and #6413, issued the Consumers Utilities Company for laying a 3" gas main on State Highway Route 33, from the city limits of Staunton to the city limits of Waynesboro, dated February 25th, 1931, and January 25th, 1931, respectively, be cancelled as per the request of this company, and that new permit #12376 be granted the Virginia Gas Distribution Corporation to cover the same pipe line. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Masie, that the Chairman be authorized to pay the salaries of two clerks to the Comptroller to the amount of \$8,000.00; these clerks to be used on the work of the State Highway Commission, provided that no further recommendations for transfers of road funds are made by the Comptroller and the Director of the Budget. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Masie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Chairman be authorized to pay all counties fifty percent of the cost of their equipment and give certificates of indebtedness for the second half to those requesting it, to be payable in 1935. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Masie, seconded by Mr. East, that the award of contracts to the Brown Paving Company, on Projects P678-F, Route 83, 4 MI. N. SCL Winchester-2.59 MI. N. SCL Middletown, and 478-B, Route 83, SCL Winchester-4.05 MI. S. SCL Winchester, be confirmed; and that whereas they are notified by the Brown Paving Company that they will not accept the awards, that their checks be forfeited and the work readvertised. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Masie, that the following permits be approved under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

R. W. Alvis, Woodford, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Route 59, near Corbin, Caroline County.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to install one 5-wire 110/220v service crossover at own pole #S-21, on Route 311, about one mile south of Martinsville.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to install one 5-wire service crossover on Route 10, about two miles east of Roanoke, at A.E.P. Co. Pole #W.E.-29.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to install one 5-wire service crossover on Route 22, about 5 1/2 miles south of New Castle, at A.E.P. Co. pole #N-498.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Roanoke, Va., to operate trailers, under Chapter 342, Acts of 1932, to carry light and power poles of a greater length than specified in Section 111, with license numbers TR 1144, TR 1143, TR 1145, and TR 840, in the Salem District.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Lynchburg, Va., to operate trailers bearing license tags 507 and 508 to carry telephone poles of a greater length than specified in section 111, Chapter 342, Acts of 1932, in the Lynchburg District.

Arlington County Board of Supervisors, Clarendon, Va., to install 3/4" water service connection to premises of J. P. Mann, Route 23, near Marsomi Avenue.

Arlington County Board of Supervisors, Clarendon, Va., to install 3/4" water service on Route 21 to premises of Lyon & Fitch.

Arlington County Board of Supervisors, Clarendon, Va., to install 3/4" water service connection to premises of Alex. Bullock, on Route 25.

Banks Service Station, Madison, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Routes 16 and 26, north corporate limits of Madison.

S. O. Barnes, Hillsville, Va., to grade entrance to proposed filling station on Route 12, Project 8061.

K. G. Bauserman, Arlington, Va., to install five gas pumps at S.E. corner of Columbia Pike and Globe Road, Route 711, ten feet back of property line.

Town of Bedford, to cross Route 14 west of Big Island with Transmission Line.

Town of Christiansburg, to lay 3/4" pipe service across Route 10.

Otis A. Cline, Warm Springs, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Route 894, about 0.7 mile west of Route 899.

Cook & Ages, Meadows of Dan, Va., to drive 3/4" water pipe under Route 12, to store.

J. R. Crosier, Elliston, Va., to grade driveway to roadside market building on Route 10, near Elliston.

Dominic Darpino, Portsmouth, Va., to install 18" drain pipe in ditch along Route 12 to service station in order to construct a driveway.

East Coast Telephones Inc., Warsaw, Va., to construct telephone line on Route 28, from Gloucester C.H. to Hayes Store.

Eastern Shore Public Service Co., Salisbury, Md., to erect poles and guys on Route 34 south of Maryland Line.

Town of Eastville, to erect electric caution sign at intersection of Routes 84 and 524 in Eastville. Should the flood light feature prove objectionable that part of light to be eliminated.

L. E. Gleason, Longdale, Va., to construct entrance to proposed filling station on Route 14, about 1.2 miles west of Longdale Furnace.

Levi Gochmour, Tom's Brook, Va., to build entrance to filling station in Tom's Brook on Route 23.

H. A. Hamrick, Staunton, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Route 33 about two miles south of Staunton, and lay drain pipe.

J. W. Thurston, Richmond, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Route 59, about one mile east of Seven Pines.

Titus Nursery Co., Waynesboro, Va., to grade entrance into place of business near Afton on Route 59.

Turner's Transfer Co., Greensboro, N.C., to operate tractor and semi-trailer to carry steel for the construction of an auditorium in Danville, of a greater length than specified in Section 111, Chapter 842, Acts of 1932.

Julian Updike, Front Royal, Va., to lay 3/4" water pipe under Route 816.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Suffolk, Va., to erect five poles on Route 18 to supply service to new filling station just west of Southern Railway.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of service wires over Route 494, about 1800 ft. west of Center Cross.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Williamsburg, Va., to erect a line over Route 510, in James City County.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  service wires over Route 18 about half a mile west of road to Robious.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  T&P secondary wires over Route 15 in Powhatan.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Petersburg, Va., to install two poles on right of way of Route 52 in Disputanta.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  T&P secondary wires over Route 430, about 100 ft. from Broad Street Road.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to carry telephone poles of a greater length than specified in Chapter 343, Acts of 1933, Section 111, on trailers carrying state license tags 380, 349, 348, 346, 345, 344, in the Richmond District.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to carry telephone poles on trailers of a greater length than specified in Section 111, Chapter 343, Acts of 1933; trailers carrying state license tags 342 and 340, in the Fredericksburg District.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to carry telephone poles on trailers carrying state license tags 343, 355, 337, 341, 339, 338, 336, 334, having a greater length than specified in Section 111, Chapter 343, Acts of 1933, in the Suffolk District.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  T&P copper service wires over Route 15 about 14 miles west of Middleham.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, Va., to erect a crossing of 3  $\frac{1}{4}$  T&P copper service wires over Route 15, about half mile west of Belt Boulevard.

H. F. Walker, Waverly, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Route 53 in Sussex County.

John B. Wygal, Dryden, Va., to cut macadam and install 1" water line at H.P. 51.1 on Route 11, Lee County.

T. S. Yeager, Clearbrook, Va., to construct entrance to service station on Route 55, between Winchester and West Virginia Line.

W.H. Youell, Fairfax, Va., to construct driveway to filling station on Route 21 near Willow Springs farm, about four miles from Fairfax.

J. H. Young, Accomac, Va., to grade entrance to filling station and install drop basin on Route 54 in Accomac County.
