

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, July 19, 1952.

On the morning of July 19, 1952, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Va.

The Meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the minutes of the meeting of May 25th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the minutes of the meeting of June 10th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Chairman be authorized to proceed with the work of surveying state highways and keep at least sixteen field parties on the same. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that \$2530.00 be transferred from the allocation on Route 33, Staunton-South, to Route 59, Staunton to Christians Creek, for beautification. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Chairman be instructed to make a report to the Commission in regard to the feasibility of an undergrade of the C & O Railroad, connecting Routes 17 and 905 at Goshen. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S448-B1, Route 50, Bridge over Mattaponi River, to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Company, Inc., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$9,930.25, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$11,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S448-B2, Route 50, Bridge over Polecat Creek, to the low bidder, Cobb and Homewood, Chapel Hill, N.C., at their bid of \$8,232.01, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$4,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F562-A, Route 10, W.C.L Roanoke-1.28 Mi. E. E.C.L Salem, to the low bidder, C. L. Tinsley, Roanoke, Va., for 2.649 miles of One Course Macadam, at his bid of \$30,951.92, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work: \$1,084.50 for guard rail; \$6,789.08 for surface treatment and \$157.50 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$43,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F-600-CH, Route 55, 12.2 Miles S. Rockingham County Line-NCL Staunton, 2.738 miles of One Course Macadam, to the low bidder, Clinch Valley Construction Company, Tazewell, Va., at their bid of \$82,048.24, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$423.50 for guard rail; \$5,015.27 for surface treatment and \$162.80 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$41,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project P637-B2, Route 17, Bridge over Lapaley Run, to the low bidder, W. C. Harvey, Lynchburg, Va., at his bid of \$5,482.68, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$4,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S-668-E, Route 39, NCL Newport News-.5 Mile E. NCL Newport News, to the low bidder, Brooks Construction Company, Inc., .585 mile of 18' concrete, at their bid of \$7,702.69, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$150.00 for grading outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$9,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S-699-12, Route 529, 5.52 Mi. N. NCL Newport News-Hick Creek Neck, to the low bidder, E. W. Grannis, Fayetteville, N.C., 6.809 miles of grading and drainage, at his bid of \$27,729.12, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$2,009.60 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$33,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S699-41, Route 529, 0.09 Mi. N. NCL Newport News-6.62 Miles N. NCL Newport News, 5.406 miles of grading and drainage, to the low bidder, E. W. Grannis, Fayetteville, N.C., at his bid of \$20,877.54, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$2,358.60 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$25,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project 479, Route 22, Bridge over Johns Creek, to the low bidder, B. F. Paxrott and Co., Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$8,897.76, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$10,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F526-CD, Route 10, 13.02 Mi. W. WCL Bristol-.7 Mi. E. Moonasin Gap, 12.87 Miles of gravel road, to the low bidder, East Tennessee Limestone Quarries, Johnson City, Tennessee, at their bid of \$16,808.52, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$2,343.00 for royalty on gravel, \$5,000.00 for guard rail and \$20,905.50 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$47,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F412-A2-528-A, Route 10, 4 Mi. W. WCL Bristol-13.02 Mi. W. WCL Bristol, 8.59 miles of gravel road, to the low bidder, East Tennessee Limestone Quarries, Johnson City, Tennessee, at their bid of \$11,681.00, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$1,850.00 for royalty on soil, \$4,000.00 for guard rail and \$14,655.50 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$34,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S366-C2, Route 10, 2.87 Mi. W. Ritchies Store-5 Miles W. Ritchies Store, .87 mile of soil road, to the low bidder, G. P. Clay, Richmond, Va., at his bid of \$2,585.74, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$120.00 for royalty on gravel; \$151.60 for guard rail; \$1,105.50 for surface treatment and \$871.00 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$5,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project 518-AB1, Route 110, 2.88 Mi. S. Holston River-.14 Mi. S. Holston River, 2.739 miles of gravel road, to the low bidder, Tazewell Construction Company, Richlands, Va., at their bid of \$30,075.46, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$600.00 for royalty on gravel; \$5,307.50 for guard rail; \$4,519.36 for surface treatment and \$546.75 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$45,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project F618-D, Routes 110, 0.84 Mi. N. Intersection Route 10-2.88 Mi. N. Holston River, 2.500 miles of gravel road, to the low bidder, Tazewell Construction Company, Richlands, Va., at their bid of \$28,051.51, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$644.00 for royalty on gravel; \$1,947.00 for guard rail, \$5,887.20 for surface treatment, and \$661.50 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$40,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project 8735-F, Route 57, 8.14 Mi. E. Chatham-6.88 Mi. E. Chatham, 1.288 miles of soil road, to the low bidder, W. W. Tuck and Son, Virgilina, Va., at their bid of \$7,575.02, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$78.65 for royalty on soil, \$366.60 for guard rail, \$2,045.85 for surface treatment and \$477.00 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$12,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project 8707-A, Route 611, Potomac Beach-7.8 Mi. E. Perkins Corner, 3.387 miles of gravel road, to the low bidder, C. S. Luck and Sons, Inc., Richmond, Va., at their bid of \$12,028.54, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$783.70 for guard rail; \$610.00 for royalty on gravel; \$5,588.55 for surface treatment and \$628.50 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$21,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project F-800-DEH4, Routes 53 and 612, Rockingham County Line-4.8 Mi. S. Rockingham County Line-connection with Route 612 and Bridge over Naked Creek, to the low bidder, H. W. Moore & Co., Staunton, Va., at his bid of \$88,270.13, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$4,284.50 for guard rail; \$12,513.55 for surface treatment and \$2,977.00 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$117,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project 8196-CNL, Route 22, .21 Mi. E. Craigs Creek-.14 Mi. W. Craigs Creek, 0.359 mile gravel road and bridge over Craig's Creek, to the low bidder, Hobbs-Peabody Construction Co., Inc., Charlotte, N.C., at their bid of \$10,355.90, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$286.50 for guard rail; \$80.63 for gravel rights; \$592.35 for surface treatment and \$18.00 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$13,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project 8711-D, Route 435, James River-Intersection Route 41, 1.063 miles of soil or sand clay road, to the low bidder, Kirkman Brothers, Inc., Mount Airy, W. Va., at their bid of \$3,662.84, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$197.94 for soilrights ; \$74.80 for guard rail; \$1,755.95 for surface treatment and \$415.00 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project S681-AE1, Route 228, 0.748 miles soil road and bridge over South Anna River, to the low bidder, City Building Corporation, Richmond, Va., at their bid of \$12,928.52, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$129.82 for soil rights; \$602.90 for guard rail; \$1,068.21 for surface treatment and \$144.00 for work outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$17,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission award the contract for the construction of Project 711G, Route 436, Boycewell Airport-James River, .661 miles soil or sand clay road, to the low bidder, City Building Corporation, Richmond, Va., at their bid of \$5,405.68, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$119.65 for soilrights; \$610.50 for guard rail; \$1,074.15 for surface treatment and \$115.86 for outside slope stakes, making a total of approximately \$6,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that all bids on Project S672-ACB1, Route 32, Brandy Station-BEL Culpeper, be rejected and the work readvertised. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the request of the Brooks Construction Company, Inc., Norfolk, Va., to withdraw as bidder on Project S688-E, Route 38, NCL Newport News-.5 Mi. E. of NCL Newport News, be granted, as the time limit had expired and right of way could not be cleared; and further that the state proceed with the work with its own forces to the property of the C & O Railway as soon as right of way can be cleared. Motion carried.

Report having been made by the Chairman of the State Highway Commission, under Chapter 212, Acts of 1926, that public convenience and safety require the elimination of the grade crossing of the C & O Railway Company's tracks, on State Highway Route 15, near Cookes, Virginia, and a tentative agreement having been reached with the C & O Railway Company, providing the closing of the present grade after the overhead structure has been erected and opened to traffic; It was moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that after carefully considering the request of the Chairman, and a study of the location and public safety, that the grade crossing be eliminated and notice be given that if there are any objections to the same that they be filed in writing in their office, in Richmond, Virginia, on or before twelve o'clock, noon, September first. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the following permits be approved under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

L. T. Barr, Middlethian, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Route 20, 17 miles south of Richmond.

J. R. Beauchamp, Lancaster, Va., to construct a drop-inlet on end of 16" pipe culvert and fill over to level up yard in front of mills on Route 37.

Town of Berryville, to run water pipe line across Route 37, about 150 yards from U. S. Route 540.

Town of Blacksburg, to cross Route 26 with water main in the Town.

G. F. Bissell, Bastian, Virginia, to construct entrance to filling station on Route 26, in Bland County.

J. L. Blizzard, Low Moor, Virginia, to construct entrance to proposed filling station on Route 14 in Low Moor.

H. W. Bodley and Sons, Wakefield, Va., to operate, under Chapter 342, Acts of 1952, trailers bearing state license tags 649, 1370 and 1447, to carry telephone poles of a greater length than specified in section 111, in the Suffolk District.

Edgar Brown, Routhel, Box 58, Wakefield, Va., to construct entrance to service station near Wakefield, on Route 52.

J. H. Burke, Manassas, Va., to lay sewer connection across Route 26 in the Town of Manassas.

The G. & P. Telephone Co. of Va., Clarendon, Va., to erect guy stab and anchor opposite pole 79¹/₂ on Route 58, between Warrenton and The Plains.

Morris Hunter, Richmond, Va., to drive a 5" conduit under Route 39 in Williamsburg.

Newport News Waterworks Commission, to cross Route 517 for service connection by driving 3/4" pipe under road.

Northern Virginia Power Co., Winchester, Va., to run three wires across Route 33 about two miles north of Winchester.

T. Temple Palmer Post No. 71, American Legion, West Point, Va., to install at crossing of 14th and D Streets in the Town of West Point one suspension type automatic traffic control signal, Route 50.

Roy W. Peery, North Taxewell, Va., to drive 6" sewer pipe under Route 112, 0.6 mile west of North Taxewell.

Petersburg Telephone Co., Petersburg, Va., to carry telephone poles of a greater length than specified in section 111, Chapter 342, Acts of 1932, on trailer bearing license #690, in the Richmond District.

Herbert Ramsey, Martinsville, Va., to cut soil surface and lay 3/4" pipe on Route 57, 0.15 mile from intersection of Route 12.

G. W. Richards, Hinton, Va., to construct entrance to filling station on Route 814, about 1.1 miles east of Rawley Springs.

L. T. Saunders, Ivor, Va., to construct entrance to filling station at intersection of Routes 52 and 508, placing tile in ditch line of Route 52 and drain pipe in ditch line of Route 508.

Jas. H. Sunday, Toms Brook, Va., to build entrance to filling station on Route 35, one mile from Toms Brook.

J. G. Thomas, Woodford, Va., to grade and gravel entrance to filling station on Route 50, threemiles south of Corbin.

Virginia Gas Distribution Corporation, Richmond, Va., to construct and operate 4" gas pipe lines, two, on south side of present 20" gas line under Route 39 in Augusta County.

David Wilson, Warrenton, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 21 near Amissville.

Town of Woodstock, to install traffic turning ball in center of intersection of Routes 35 and 824 in Woodstock.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Mast, that after holding a public hearing and carefully considering the objections raised to the proposed plan to construct a bridge across the James River at Eagle Rock and over the tracks of the C & O Railway, Route 17, closing the grade crossing now used and granting the C & O Railway Company permission to remove the present bridge over the river, as soon as the new bridge is opened to traffic, that the objections be overruled and the work be proceeded with. Motion carried. Mr. Shirley not voting.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the state highway routes through cities of over 3500 population be approved as follows, under Chapter 415, Acts of 1932, for the expenditure of \$1500.00 per mile per year for maintenance or construction of these highways or bridges -

Hunting Creek, over Patrick Street, Madison Street, Henry Street, to Four Mile Run; Washington-Alexandria Road from Mount Vernon Boulevard to Bridge over R. P. & P.; Franklin Street to Patrick Street, to Washington Street; Duke Street and Little River Turnpike from Washington Street to Fairfax County Line; King Street from Patrick Street, over the Alexandria-Leeburg Turnpike to Arlington County Line - 9.07 miles.

Western city limits, State Street, to Goodson Street, Piedmont Street, to Myrtle Street, Oakview Avenue to Abingdon; State Street, Front Street, Mary Street to Goodson; State Street, Goodson Street, Danville Avenue, Fairview Street, Massachusetts Avenue - 5.48 miles.

Buena Vista

Corporate limits, First Street, Magnolia Avenue, Park Avenue, Factory Street, Alleghany Avenue, Orchard Street, Beach Avenue, Twenty-Ninth Street - 3.40 miles.

Charlottesville

Corporate limits, Free Bridge Road, High Street, Second Street, Market Street, Preston Avenue, city limits; Monticello Road, Market Street, Second Street, to Main Street, to Jefferson Park Avenue, to city limits; Main and Twelfth Streets, Ivy Road to city limits; Rugby road from Ivy road to Preston Avenue - 6.18 miles.

Clifton Forge
