

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway  
Commission of Virginia, Held in  
Richmond, July 28, 1937.

On the morning of July 28th, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls and J. F. Wycor, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that the minutes of the meeting of May 27th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project PA 620 H2, B9, Route 221, 1.43 Mi. E. ECL Floyd-ECL Floyd, to the low bidder, Cobb and Homewood, Inc., and W. W. Tuck and Son, Chapel Hill, N.C., at their bid of \$29,581.04, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$753.50 for pole lines to be moved, making a total of approximately \$34,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project PA 762 A3B2, Route 122, 3.29 Mi. N. Intersection Route 460-3.09 Mi. N. Intersection Route 460, to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Company, Inc., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$29,509.39, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$33,000.00 chargeable to this project, transferring \$4,000.00 balance on Project 520 H2 B9, Route 221, 1.43 Mi. E. ECL Floyd-ECL Floyd, to make up difference needed. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wycor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project WPGS 1154 H1, Route 506, O&O Overhead 1 Mile N. of Newport News, to the low bidder, McDowell and Wood, Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$54,857.80, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$3,950.00 for work by the Railroad, making a total of approximately \$65,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project WPGM 721 M2B2, Route 11, 0.3 Mi. S. NOL Buchanan-0.77 Mi. E. NOL Buchanan, to the low bidder, A. W. Campbell and Co. Inc., Lynchburg, Va., at their bid of \$170,998.29, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$742.50 for moving pole lines, making a total of approximately \$189,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commission confirm award of contract for the construction of Project S 1592 C, Route 620, Intersection Route 55 (Royal Avenue) in Front Royal-1.0 Mile W. WCL of Front Royal, to the low bidder, Lusk Construction Co., Richmond, Va., at their bid of \$24,256.88, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$748.00 for pole lines to be moved, making a total of approximately \$28,000.00 chargeable to this project; the work to be extended to three track road as far as entrance to the plant at unit prices bid, taking up just about the \$24,000.00. Finley, Roanoke, Va., at their bid of \$258,656.78, that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$2,680.00 for pole lines, making a total of approximately \$268,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Motion carried.
