Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, July 29, 1938.

On the morning of July 29th, 1938, the State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, Wm. H. East, S. W. Rawls and J. F. Wycor, met in their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Moved by Mr. Rawls, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that the minutes of the meeting of June 1st be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that as provided by Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, section 1 shown on plat dated June 14, 1938, Project 166D, Route 360, in Hanover County, being no longer necessary for use as a State highway, the same be abandoned. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Wycor, that as provided by Chapter 212, Section 1, Act approved March 19, 1926, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner, section 1 shown on plat dated July 1, 1938, Project S 734 A, Route 231, in Albemarle County, being no longer necessary for use as a State Highway, the same be abandoned upon opening of the new section in lieu thereof. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that the State Highway Commission hereby set aside \$400,000.00 from the road funds for the year ending July 31st, 1938, to apply on the construction of an office building on property located on Broad Street, recently purchased by the Commission, and that the Chairman be authorized and directed to ask for a PWA grant of 45 percent towards the construction of this building. Further, that he proceed with the construction of the building and do all things necessary for its early completion. Motion carried.

Colonel Dan Porter, Dr. Glow, Senator S. Bernard Coleman, Mr. H.C. Bailey, Mr. O. B. Jones and a large delegation from Orange and Madison Counties appeared before the Commission and requested an allocation to improve Route 26 from Orange to Route 231 in Madison County.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. East, that due to the inability to secure right of way on Route 60, Project FA 1157 M2, 0.443 Mi. W. of WCL of Clifton Forge-0.104 Mi. W. of WCL of Clifton Forge, at Selma, the bids be rejected and the project dropped. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Wyszor, that due to inability to secure right of way on Route 58, Project 160 M2,3, Town of Holland, that the bids be rejected and the project dropped. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Rawls, that due to inability to secure right of way on Route 3, Project 606 C, 6.284 Mi. E. of Fredericksburg-6.808 Mi. E. of Fredericksburg, that the project be abandoned. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. East, seconded by Mr. Massie, that due to inability to secure right of way on Route 318, Project 1193 A, Int. of Route 15 at Tasley-0.077 Mi. N. of SCL of Parksley, in Accomack County, that the work be delayed and the survey extended to Guilford. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Wyszor, seconded by Mr. Massie, that due to the excessive cost of right of way through the Stone property on Route 168, Project S 699 E, Lee Hall-Williamsburg, that this section of the route be dropped and the condemnation case withdrawn. Motion carried.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned, subject to the call of the Commissioner.
