MINUTES OF MEETING OF STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION RICHNOND, VIRGINIA

JULY 15, 1971

The monthly meeting of the State Highway Commission was held at the Central Highway Office in Richmond, Virginia, on July 15, 1971, at 10 a.m. The Chairman, Mr. Douglas B. Fugate, presided.

WHEREAS, the economic, social and environmental effects of the proposed project have been examined and given proper consideration, and this evidence, along with all other, has been carefully reviewed, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that the location and major design features of this project be approved in accordance with the plan as proposed and presented at the said location and design public hearing by the Department Engineers.

Moved by Mr. Duckworth, seconded by Mr. Glass, that

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-223 of the Code of Virginia sets forth that the General Assembly of Virginia has found and declared that it is "... in the public interest that access roads to public recreational areas and historical sites be provided by using highway funds ..."; provides \$1.500.000 from highway funds for such purpose; and further provides that "The State Highway Commission and the Commission of Outdoor Recreation are hereby authorized to make regulations to carry out the provisions of this section."; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of Outdoor Recreation and the State Highway Commission have adopted a joint policy to govern the use of recreational access funds pursuant to Section 33.1-223 of the Code of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of York County has by resolution requested the use of recreational access funds to provide access to the Waller Mill Reservoir Park, estimated to cost \$75,000; and

WHEREAS, this request has been considered by the Commission of Outdoor Recreation and has been found to comply fully with the provisions of Section 33.1-223; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of Outdoor Recreation has recommended the construction of the aforementioned access.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$75,000 from the recreational access fund for 1970-71 be allocated to provide access to the Waller Mill Reservoir Park in York County, Project 0645-099-123, C-501; 0737-099-124, C-501, contingent upon the right of way and adjustment of utilities being provided at no cost to the recreational access fund.

WHEREAS, Section 33.1-221 of the Code of Virginia provides a fund for fiscal 1971-72 of \$1,500,000 to "... be expended by the Commission for constructing, reconstructing, maintaining or improving access roads within counties, cities and towns to industrial sites on which manufacturing, processing or other establishments will be built under firm contract or are already constructed."; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddle County has by resolution requested the use of industrial access funds to provide proper access to the new facility being constructed by Keller Industries, Incorporated, just north of McKenney in Dinwiddle County, estimated to cost \$60,000; and

MHEREAS, it appears that this request falls within the intent of Section 33.1-221 and has complied with the provisions of the Highway Commission's policy on the use of industrial access funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that \$60,000 from the industrial access fund for 1971-72 be allocated for the purpose of constructing an access road to the new facility of Keller Industries, Incorporated, just north of McKenney in Dinwiddle County, Project 0748-026-175, C-501, contingent upon the necessary right of way and adjustment of utilities being provided at no cost to the industrial access fund.

Representatives of the City of Chesapeake, the Chesapeake Chamber of Commerce and the Portsmouth Chamber of Commerce appeared before the Commission to request that the designation of arterial route between Chesapeake and the North Carolina Line be changed from Route 17 to Route 168, since they felt Route 168 should be improved prior to upgrading of Route 17. WHEREAS, the Highway Commission has selected certain streets within the Corporate Limits of the City of Winchester for such payment; and

MHEREAS, due to annexation by the City of Winchester on January 1, 1971, and through a mutual agreement between the City and the Highway Department for the City to take over maintenance of the streets within the area annexed from Frederick County, effective January 1, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the City of Winchester has requested that these streets be included with those eligible for maintenance payment; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33.1-47 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, quarterly payments, at the annual rate of \$10,000 per mile on 3.77 miles of Primary Route Extensions within the area annexed by the City of Winchester, be included in the City's mileage for maintenance payments. The additional mileage eligible for payments is described as follows:

The mileage for the City of Winchester, due to annexation of the above Primary Route Extensions, is increased by 3.77 miles, to a new total of 10.74 miles eligible for maintenance payments at the rate of \$10,000 per mile annually, effective July 1, 1971, for the quarterly payment due after September 30, 1971; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 33.1-43 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, quarterly payments at the rate of \$1,100 per mile annually be made to the City of Winchester on the addition of annexed "other streets," totaling 21.97 miles and meeting standards required by this section of the Code, effective July I, 1971, for the quarterly payment due after September 30, 1971. The additional mileage of "other streets" eligible for payment is described and listed on attached tabulation Sheets No. 1-7 dated July 1, 1971.

These street additions, totaling 21.97 miles, will increase the total mileage of "other streets" eligible for maintenance payments in the City of Winchester from 34.15 miles to 56.12 miles of approved streets.

MOTION CARRIED

MHEREAS, under authority of Section 33.1-43 of the Code of Virginia of 1950, as amended, request is made by the City of Hampton for maintenance payments at the rate of \$1,100 per mile annually on additional streets meeting required standards; also for deletions of street mileage no longer eligible for maintenance payments;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the quarterly payments at the rate of \$1,100 per mile annually be made to the City of Hampton on additional streets totaling 9.75 miles and deletions of 0.25 mile for a net addition of 9.50 miles and meeting standards required by the aforementioned section of the Code effective April 1, 1971, for the quarterly payment due after June 30, 1971. The additions and deletions subject for payment are described on the attached tabulation Sheets No. 1-8 dated April 1, 1971.

The additions, totaling 9.75 miles and deletions, totaling 0.25 mile, will increase the total mileage in the City of Hampton from 281.56 miles to 291.06 miles of approved streets.

Route 66) does not constitute a section of the public road and is desmed by him no longer necessary for the uses of the State Highway System.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.1-149 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, the conveyence of the said land, so certified, to the adjoining landowner of record is approved and the State Highway Commissioner is hereby authorized to execute in the name of the Commonwealth a deed conveying same, without warranty, and subject to such restrictions as may be deemed requisite.

WHEREAS, additional guardrail is required beyond that estimated on the original plans; and
