WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Transportation Board is authorized under Section 33.1-41.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, to make payments to cities and certain towns for street maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, certain principal arterial road or local streets within the corporate limits of the City of Radford are eligible for such payments; and

WHEREAS, under authority of said Section 33.1-41.1, request is made by the City of Radford for maintenance payments on additions of principal arterial road and local streets meeting the required criteria. These additions are due to annexation effective July 1, 1986;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the location and major design features of this project be approved in accordance with the plan as proposed and presented at the said Location and Design Public Hearing by the Department's engineers from north of the Interstate Route 66 interchange to Route 7 including the separate interchange alternative for the Algonkian Parkway, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that design modifications will be made to relocate Braddock Road to an at-grade signalized intersection with Route 28 at Walney Road until completion of the Interstate Route 66 corridor study and the elimination of a connection from the proposed Barnesfield Road interchange to Centreville Road.
