- 2, the execution of an appropriate contractual agreement, with bond, between the City of Lynchburg (City) and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), to provide for:
- a. the design, administration, construction and maintenance of this project;

WHEREAS, the governing bodies of the counties electing to participate in this program for Fiscal Year 1997-98 have, with the Department, identified specific eligible items of work to be financed from the special fund account as indicated on "Attachment A"; and

WHEREAS, it appears that these items of work fall within the intent of Section 33.1-75.1 of the Code of Virginia, and comply with the guidelines of the Department for use of such funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commonwealth Transportation Board hereby approves the allocation of these funds as set forth in "Attachment A."
