NINUTES OF THE WASTISS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION OF VIRUINIA, MALD AT RICHOUR, VIRGINIA, AUGUST 15TH, 1921.

The State Highway Consission with Wade H. Micrais, Chairman, Henry P. Seck, Secretary, Horace Hardaway, and James A. Hundy, Jr., in attendance met in the rooms of the

state Bighway Department, 116 South Third Street, Richmond, Virginia, on August 15th, 1981, at 10 A. M.

Commissioner Davie was absent on account of accetinued illness.

The minutes of the meeting of July 29th, 1921, held at Horfelk, Virginia, were read, and on motion of Mr. Hundy were approved as correct, and the Chairman authorized to eign the same.

The Highest Commissioner recommended the anald of the contract to W. C. Hodge for the building of a reinforced concrete bridge over Callahan's Creek, Route Sc. 10, Project No. 93, for the sum of \$4551.03, and his recommendation was approved by the Commission.

On motion of Mr. Mundy, the Mighway Commissioner was sutherized to award the contract to J. L. Pitts Bree, for all of the grading, and as much of the Maundam on Project No. 101, Route No. 17, between Healing Springs and Walling Springs as can be paid for from the present available funds.

On motion of Mr. Hardaway, G. C. Michael of Mount Oranford was granted a permit to plant poles and to string wires for the purpose of transmitting electricity on and along State Boad No. 3 in Reskingham County, Virginia, near Neumt Grawford;

This permit to be reveable at the discretion of the State Highway Commission, and all work in connection therewith to be natisfactory to the State Highway Commissioner.

On motion of Mr. Mundy, the Assertest Automobile Association was granted a posmit to erest and maintain signs and guide posts un and along Routes So. 1 and 21 of The State Highway Rystom near Mashington, D. U.; all work in sommestion with this posmit to be satisfactory to the Highway Conscissioner; and

The power to revoke this permit is hereby expressly reserved by the State Highway Commission.

On motion of Mr. Mundy, T. C. Cregg, C. R. Morrissette, R. Hudson Chesley, and K. L. Bowlee, were elected members of the State Traffic Police Power.

On motion of Mr. Hardaway, the application of the Board of Supervisors of Bedford County to be allowed to advance \$25,000, for construction work on Route Me. 10, Project Mo. 37, was approved, and the Chairman and Pacretary of the Highway Countsian were authorized and empowered to enter into the usual form of adromant with the Board of Supervisors of Bedford County, in the name and an behalf of the State Highway Countsian.

On motion of Mr. Mundy, the Charles of Commores of Danville, Virginia, were allowed to advance the num of \$28,500.

for construction work on Route No. 12, Project No. 144, between Denville and Handy River Bridge, and the Chalumns and Secretary were authorized and empewered to enter into the usual form of agreement with the Chamber of Conserce of Danville in the name and on behalf of the State Highway Commission.

Under proper enfoguards satisfactory to him, and with due regard for the State's interest under all eight extensions, the Highway Consissioner was given the privilege of complying with the request of the Denville Chamber of Conserve allowing the funds advanced by them to remain in the local bunks watil natually needed by the Highway Consissioner.

On metion of Mr. Hardamy, the Highway Conmissioner was authorized to contract with the Supervisors of Orange County for the construction of the necessary approach at the point where the Orange road connects with State Soud No. 7 near Wildersons Non in Spotsylvania County, the cost of this work being shared equally by the State with Orange County.

On motion of Mr. Mundy, additional allegations were made to the following massed projects as enumerated below:

After an inspection of both the Pewell
River and Fincastle Nontee, and the omeideration of
