MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS OF THE STATE HIGHWAY  
COMMISSION AT PEARISBURG, TAKEWELL, AND  
CLINTWOOD, VA. AUGUST 21st & 22nd, 1923.

The State Highway Commission, consisting of Messrs.  
H. G. Shirley, Massie, Sanders, and Truxtun, arrived at Pembroke,  
Giles County on the morning of August 21st and looked over the  
two routes advocated between Hogs Store and Newport, after which  
they proceeded to Pearisburg where a public hearing was given to  
all interested in the location of Route 23 between Newport and  
Hogs Store.

After the meeting they proceeded via Glenlynn and Prince-  
ton to Tazewell where a public hearing was given on the location  
of State Highway No. 111 between Claypoole Hill and Grundy and es-  
pecially the section where it crosses the boundarylines of Tazewell,  
Russell and Buchanan Counties.

After this hearing they continued to Lebanon where they  
spent the night.

AUGUST 22nd, 1923.

On the morning of the 22nd, the Commission proceeded  
from Lebanon via St. Paul and Coeburn to Clintwood where a public  
hearing was given on the location of Route No. 114 between Fremont  
and Haysi and after this meeting the Commission proceeded to Abing-  
don where they adjourned.
