**AUGUST 21,22, 1923** 

Back Short Mr. 86-P and Robby Co. CLINTWOOD, VA. AUGUST 21st & 22nd,1923.

The State Highway Commission, commissing of Messre.

H. G. Shirley, Massie, Sanders, and Truxtum, arrived at Pembroke,
Gilder County on the morning of August 21st and looked over the
two routes advocated between Hoges Store and Rewport, after which
they proceeded to Pearisburg Where a public hearing was given to
all interested in the location of Route 23 between Newport and
Hoges Store.

After the meeting they proceeded via Glenlynn and Princeton to Taxewell where a public hearing was given on the location of State Highway No. 111 between Glaypoole Hill and Grundy and especially the section where it crosses the boundarylines of Taxewell Russell and Buckman Counties.

After this hearing they continued to Lebenon where they spent the night.

AUGUST 22nd, 1923.

On the porning of the 22nd, the Commission proceeded.

from Lebanon via St. Faul and Coeburn to Clintwood where a public hearing was given on the location of Route No. 114 between Fremont and Hayel and after this meeting the Commission proceeded to Abingdon where they adjourned.
