#### MINITES OF THE MEETING OF THE STATE HIGH-WAY COMMISSION OF VIRGINIA, RICHMUND, VIRGINIA, AUGUST 15th, 1929.

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The State Highest Commission of Virginia, consisting of Mesers. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Made H. Massie, Secretary, Hugh B. Sproul, I. Walke Truxtum, and H. G. Gilmer, met at their office, State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia, August 15th, 1929.

The meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the minutes of the meeting held June 20, 1929, be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Houte 12, Project 3-396-AG, Damasous towards Houte 10, be awarded to the low bidder, Calhoun and Sproles, Clinchport, Virginia, at their unit prices bid to the amount of the allocation of \$100,000.00 Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Truxtun, that all bids on Route 33, Project F-585-CD, Staunton - South, be rejected as being too high, and that this work be readvertised. Motion carried.

Hoved by Mr. Sproul, seconded by Mr. Massle, that the contrast for the construction of Route 34, Project 221-E, South of Keller, be awarded to the low bidder, Brooks Construction Company, Inc., Norfolk, Virginia, at their bid of \$51,110.84 and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work and \$141.68 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$57,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the contract for the construction of Boute 55, Project S-416-AC, Streets of Streeburg, be awarded to the low bidder, Brady Brothers, Prostburg, Maryland, on their alternate bid for bituminous macedam, of \$33,093.28, and that 10% additional be set uside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$37,000.00 chargeable to this Project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtun, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the contract for the construction of Route 13, Project F418A, Repphannock River-Brays Fork, be awarded to the low bidder, J. M. Cownerd, Gordoneville, Virginia, at his bid of \$11,735.97 and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, \$2,500.00 for Deteurs and \$1444.52 for Guard Rail, making a total of approximately \$17,000.00 chargeable to this project. Moved by Mr. Massis, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the bid received on Fouts 54, Project 8-580-K, East Corporate Limits of Berryville to 3.99 Miles West, of Shenandoah River, be rejected as it was too high and only one bid was received, and that the Commission do the work with its own force. Motion carried.

k Sheet No. 45-P Wadday Co. Mr. J. Brooks Lapp and Mr. Whealton of Accomma County, came before the Counission in regard to the valuation of the Chinquteagus Toll Road and Bridges. They filed a paper with the Counission setting out the actual cost of of the Bridge at the time of construction and the amount spant for several years just after its construction due to the continuous settlement. They stated that they had had a cash offer for the road and bridges amounting to \$300,000.00 and they would not assept it, but that they would be willing to sell to the State for considerably under that amount as the tells would be removed. After thoroughly discussing the matter it was agreed that the Chinceteagus Toll Road and Bridge Company would employ an engineer to make a valuation of their property, after which the State Highway Commission and the Company would try and arrive at a proper value.

A delegation from Fairfax and Loudoun Counties, headed by Mr. George F. Harrison, and Mr. Robert N. Harper, appeared before the Countseion in regard to the location of the road through Mr. Harper's property. Mr. Harper stated that at the time the old road going straight across his property was closed he thought he had taken every legal step necessary. He presented a plan which had been a proved by the Heard of Supervisors of London County, provided it met with the approval of the State Highway Countseion, whereby the curves could be flattened somewhat. He stated that he would give the necessary land for this change and bear the expense of putting down the base for the proposed change, but he was not willing to pay the \$7,000.00 requested by the Countseion.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Sproul, that the Commission adhers to their former plan of flattening the curve through Colonel Harper's property, but reduce the amount required to be furnished by Colonel Harper from \$7,000.00 to \$5,000.00, and to shift the line to miss the shade trees. Notice carried.

Moved by Mr. Truxtum, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that liquidated damages amounting to \$470.00 on Route 34, Project 221-D, and 296-C, Keller-Shadyside, be returned to the contractor, Robert G. Lassiter and Company, as per recommendation of Chief Engineer Mullen. Motion carried.
