

Minutes of the Meeting of the State Highway
Commission of Virginia, Held in
Richmond, August 12, 1931.

On the morning of the 12th of August, 1931, the State Highway Commission of Virginia, consisting of Messrs. H. G. Shirley, Commissioner, Wade H. Massie, Secretary, H. G. Gilmer, and Wm. H. East, met in their office in the State Office Building, Richmond, Virginia.

The Meeting was called to order by the Commissioner.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the minutes of the meeting of July 24th and 25th be approved. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Commission confirm the award of contract for the construction of Project S716-A, Route 604, Intersection Route 13, Millers Tavern-Intersection Route 58, Carter Cross, to the second low bidder, Samerson Son, Cartersville, Virginia, at their bid of \$25,946.42, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work; \$3,415.50 for guard rail and \$16,897.65 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$50,000.00 chargeable to this project. The bid of J. A. Marrow Construction Co., of \$25,466.16, being low bid, was not accepted because he now has five contracts with the State Highway Department, several of which are not on time, and the Commission felt it would be illadvised to give him any additional work. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the contract for the construction of Project F641-HI, Route 39, 3.35 Miles E. of ECL Waynesboro-1.77 Miles E. Christians Creek, be awarded to the low bidder, Meadowview Construction Co. Inc., Meadowview, Virginia, at their bid of \$31,712.56, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, and \$3,488.25 for surface treatment, making a total of approximately \$39,000.00 chargeable to this project; the work to be so arranged that it will not interfere with the hauling of apples over the present roads. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Piney River near Lowerville, Route 513, Project S636-B, be awarded to the low bidder, M. S. Hudgins, Roanoke, Va., at his bid of \$7,366.40, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$9,000.00 chargeable to this project, subject to rights of way being secured. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. East, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Stevens Run, near Oaklie, Route 15, Project F656-B4, be awarded to the low bidder, Perkins-Barnes Construction Co., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$6,010.00, and that 10% additional be set

aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$7,000.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the contract for the construction of Bridge over Creek Kill Branch, Route 15, Project #659-13, be awarded to the low bidder, Perkins-Barres Construction Co., Blackstone, Va., at their bid of \$3,529.00, and that 10% additional be set aside to cover the cost of engineering and additional work, making a total of approximately \$3,880.00 chargeable to this project. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the Commissioner be instructed to make a close study of the surveys and estimates on Route 17, through Eagle Rock, and then adopt the location that in his judgment will be the most feasible and suitable. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the straight line for the location of Route 48 be adopted. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the Commission take over for temporary maintenance the road from Newport to Mountain Lake, Route 234 in Giles County. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the excess mileage on Route 58 in Pocahontas County, be transferred to the same route in Prince William County, a distance of .14 mile. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that permit #10046, James City County, Route 31, issued to R. C. Curtis, Lee Hall, Virginia, be cancelled as requested. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Shirley, that the Town Officials of Lebanon having requested the State Highway Commission to take over Route 11 within the corporate limits, under proper ordinance, it is hereby ordered that it be taken over as a State highway under Chapter 54, Acts of 1930. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Shirley, seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the State Highway Commission lease that portion of the slope that it is not using at the present time on State Highway Route 31, just north of the Creek Run Bridge, to Mr. Wesley Edwards, for a distance of 10 feet in front of his lot for ten cents (.10¢) per month, with the understanding that at anytime the State Highway Commission needs this right of way the lease will be revoked. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that the following permits be granted under the rules and regulations of the Commission:

Alleghany County Board of Supervisors, to construct walkway on west side of Route 200 through Dry Run just north of Covington.

American Oil Company, to build entrance to filling station near Hermon Brooks on Route 31A.

W. A. Anderson, Emporia, Va., to construct entrance to filling station just east of Emporia on Route 12.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Bluefield, West Va., to erect a 2300v power line over and along Route 28 at Firestone.

Appalachian Electric Power Co., Bluefield, West Va., to erect a 2300v power line along Route 203 at Firestone.

Arlington County Board of Supervisors, to install 1" water service connection to premises of Victor L. Lewis, Route 25.

E. E. Laird, Petersburg, Va., to grade entrance to filling station on Route 66, three miles from Biggins.

W. J. McRae, Roanoke, Va., to connect filling station with Route 23, opposite Blacksburg Airport.

Blacksburg, Town of, to dig into Route 46 from the north side to make water connection from main to service a residence.

Bunting & Hodges, Elkins, W. Va., to move gas shovel from Elkins, over Route 17, to Swift Run Gap, and to cross as bridge.

Bowling Green, Town of, to install water mains, fire hydrants and curb connections in the Town on Main Street, from its intersection with Milford Street 1000 ft. south and 1500 ft. north; on Milford Street from its intersection with Main Street, 1000 ft. west.

Burfleet Brinkley, Cypress Chapel, Va., to construct driveway to filling station on Route 306.

G. R. Brooks, Dumbarton, Va., to build entrance to filling station, Route 31, near Dutch Lane.

C. & P. Telephone Co., Norfolk, to construct pole line with an overhang on right of way of Route 514 of cross arms and wire to furnish service to Federal Park Commission at Yorktown.

R. L. Davis, Williamsburg, to grade right of way of Route 39 and cover with cinders as entrance to filling station.

- Hart County Telephone, Inc., Warren, to erect telephone line from Central Garage, intersection of Route 18, to Martin's Store on Route 30, relocating 262 poles and placing 173 additional poles.
- M. Freedman, Roanoke, to pour the area between present concrete and curb line in front of own property on Route 34.
- Great Realty Corporation, Marshall, to lay 150 ft. of 4" pipe under ditch line of Route 36 in town of Marshall.
- George Gilmer, Charlottesville, to drive a 3/4" water pipe under Route 36 near city limits of Charlottesville.
- Gerry Hallerbeck, Fredericksburg, to construct gravel entrance to filling station at Four Mile Park on Route 31.
- J. D. Hopkins, Stuart, to cut trench and install 4" sewer line across Route 18, 5 miles west of Stuart.
- Lanceen Water Co., Rustburg, to extend pipe line on Route 18 from Rustburg to Lynchburg and build fill over same to level of present grade.
- Lynchburg Gas Co., to lay 3" gas main on north side of Route 14 from intersection of Gholson Drive and Trout's Ferry Road to 435' east.
- Lynchburg Gas Co., to dig ditch across Route 18 to lay gas service.
- S. S. McRae, Hampton, to place concrete on right of way of Route 39 as entrance to two stores.
- Nelson County School Board, to cross Route 18, about .8 mile E. of Lexington with an 8" sewer line from new High School buildings.
- Newport News Waterworks Commission, to cross Route 39 with 8" water main by tunneling under concrete in to the property of the Mariners' Museum.
- R. Olson, West Point, to erect 24 light poles and lines on Route 625, from Route 36 to Fort Richmond Airport.
- Edward L. Olson, Lightfoot, to grade entrance to filling station on Route 36.
- Poco Power Co., Lurey, to construct single phase 5500w light and power line across Route 31 about .9 mile south of Washington, Va.
- R. H. Purham, Petersburg, to grade entrance to filling station on Route 31, 3.5 miles N. of Petersburg.
- Petersburg, Town of, to lay 8" sewer through 4x9 culvert under Route 36.

Petersburg Gas Company, to excavate a 4x6 hole over 100 ft. main in Colonial Heights; and 21 ft. of ditch from concrete to property line on Route 31, to run service to residence.

Petersburg Gas Co., to run 3" gas main from Belmont Avenue to the Kings Highway on Suffolk Boulevard, Route 10, a distance of 2500 ft.

Lee Glass, Warrenton, to repair power connection on Route 32 in town of Warrenton at residence of Dr. Knight.

W. Q. Riddick, Suffolk, to construct entrance to filling station on Route 305, Gloucester County.

St. Paul Motor Co., to drive 3" pipe under Route 112 as conduit for power line and air line, M.P. 24.4 within the town.

H.R.C. Shockey, Vienna, to cross Route 28 with 3/4" water service pipe to connect residence, in Fairfax County.

E. M. Smith, Hampton, to break concrete curb in two places on entrance to filling station on Route 610, in Fox Hill.

Standard Oil Company of New Jersey, Fredericksburg, to put in 7" concrete pavement in front of service station #403 between Fredericksburg and Palmetto Bridge on Route 31.

W. L. Greenway, Warrenton, to build entrance to filling station on Route 404, Gloucester County.

S. S. Via, to grade entrance to filling station and lengthen eight feet culvert on Route 305, two miles south of Floyd.

Virginia East Coast Utilities Inc., Richmond, to erect part of the proposed electric line beginning at Madison P. C., on Route 38 and running along Route 629 towards Guyana's Island.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, to erect a crossing of 3 1/4 primary wires over Route 19 just west of intersection of Vinita Road, at present location of head guy.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Richmond, to erect a 3 1/4 service wire crossing over Route 31 just south of Belmont's Store.

Virginia Electric & Power Co., Fredericksburg, to erect 2-wire crossings, each being 3 1/4 B.M.B. 11.2 k.v. conductors, between Pennsylvania C.R. and the ridge south.

Virginia Public Service Co., Staunton, to cross Route 610 to home of William H. McGray with 2 1/2" wires.

Virginia Public Service Co., Charlottesville, to cross Route 33, 1/4 mile east of Ivy, with 3 #4 AWG wires, 110/120v secondary.

Virginia Public Service Co., Staunton, to cross Route 33 about 50 ft. beyond Valley Mills Creek with two 300ft wires.

Virginia Public Service Co., Alexandria, to install 1-3 wire 110/120v secondary crossing over Route 33 between Fairfax and Gunterville, from VPS pole #33 to pole on private property of Mrs. Smith Thompson.

Virginia Public Service Co., Clifton Forge, to make one crossing over Route 336 about 375 ft. from point of beginning of Route 336.

Virginia Public Service Co., South Boston, to construct power lines of 6000v on Routes 50 and 48 between Appomattox and Concord and south of Concord.

Virginia Public Service Co., Clifton Forge, to erect one primary crossing over Route 461 about 670 ft. east of highway crossing over N. & W.; near Natural Bridge Station.

Virginia Public Service Co., Leesburg, to install 1 - 3 wire 110v crossing between poles #32 and #31 over Aldie-Leesburg Pike, Route 33, about two miles from Leesburg.

Virginia Public Service Co., Alexandria, to install road crossing over Route 33 at junction of county road at Chantilly.

Virginia Public Service Co., Newport News, to push a 2" steel gas pipe under and across Route 33 at the intersection of Apple Avenue.

Virginia Public Service Co., Alexandria, to erect 1-3 wire, 110v crossing over Route 33 between VPS pole #33 and #35 - pole #178.

John R. Watson, Malvern, to lay 20 ft. of 12" pipe for road entrance to fruit stand on Route 33.

Edward Weideman, Fredericksburg, to build gravel entrance to filling station two miles south of Fredericksburg on Route 31.

Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Nassis, seconded by Mr. East, that the Commissioner be instructed to transfer all underruns to surpluses on all contracts finished and under way, and to use any surplus to balance all Districts as of June 30th, 1931. Motion carried.

Moved by Mr. Massie; seconded by Mr. Gilmer, that the allocation of the \$900,000.00 fund be as follows:

Moved by Mr. Gilmer, seconded by Mr. Massie, that Route 210 in Floyd and Patrick Counties, for temporary maintenance, be from Shelor's Mill, on Route 205, to a point at or near Edward's Store, to Route 1A near Meadow of Bang that this be marked as a temporary route and that no decision shall be made on the final location of this until surveys have been made of both this route and the Willis Route, previous to construction. Motion carried.
